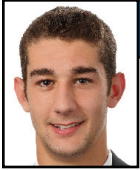


### ATHLETIC REPUBLIC PLAYER OF THE WEEK

**#10 BRIAN FLYNN, MAINE** (Junior Forward; Lynnfield, Mass.)

Flynn had four goals as the Black Bears split a pair of games on the weekend. He scored Maine's second goal in a game that it would drop to New Hampshire in overtime. Flynn had a hat trick in Maine's 4-1 victory over UMass on Sunday afternoon with a power play goal to go along with a pair of even strength goals, which included the

game-winning goal against UMass. Flynn finished the weekend with nine shots on goal and a +3 rating for the Black Bears.



### PRO AMBITIONS ROOKIE OF THE WEEK

**#18 JEFF SILENGO, NEW HAMPSHIRE** (Freshman Forward; Madison, Conn.)

Silengo scored the first two goals of his collegiate career including the game-winner at 1:26 of overtime in a 4-3 win at Maine. His first goal midway through the third period sparked the come-back. Silengo had three shots on

net and was a +2 overall vs. the Black Bears.



### PURE HOCKEY DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

**#35 ALEX BEAUDRY, PROVIDENCE** (Junior Goaltender; Scarborough, Ont.)

## TEAM NOTES

**BOSTON COLLEGE:** Four BC players - Brian Dumoulin, Chris Kreider, Philip Samuelsson and Patrick Wey were named to the 29-man preliminary roster for the 2011 U.S. Junior National Team last week. The players will participate in a pre-tournament camp beginning Dec. 17 in Troy, Rochester and Amherst, N. Y. The camp includes three exhibition games against Rensselaer's men's hockey team (Dec. 19), the Czech Republic (Dec. 21) and Norway (Dec. 23). Kreider is one of eight returning players from the gold-medal winning 2010 U.S. National Junior Team...Junior forward Cam Atkinson, who has 21 points (14g,7a) in 16 games this season, now has 93 points in 94 BC career contests...BC entered its semester break on a three-game win streak during which it outscored opponents 20-7...Senior alternate captain Brian Gibbons (2-4-6) and sophomore defenseman Brian Dumoulin (0-6-6) each averaged two points per game to lead all BC scorers in the last three games...Next for Boston College is competition in the Ledyard National Bank Classic at Dartmouth College. The Eagles return to action against Colgate on Dec. 30 at 4 p.m. and will play either Mercyhurst or the host Big Green on Dec. 31.

**BOSTON UNIVERSITY:** The Terriers split their two games on the week to close the first half with a record 8-4-5 (6-3-4 Hockey East)...After posting a 5-4 league victory over Northeastern on Wednesday, the Terriers fell, 4-1, at No. 15 Rensselaer Saturday in what will be their only non-conference game in an opposing rink this regular season...The triumph over the Huskies was BU's sixth come-from-behind victory of the season after having only five all of last season...BU is now 2-1-1 in non-conference play this season...A pair of significant point streaks came to an end on Saturday, as freshman Sahir Gill (Terrace, B.C.) had scored a point in eight straight games (1g,7a) and sophomore Alex Chiasson tallied 11 points (3g,8a) during a seven-game point streak... Freshman Matt Nieto (Long Beach, Calif.) extended his goal-scoring streak to three games with a tally against Northeastern but was held off the scoresheet in Saturday's loss...Junior David Warsofsky (Marshfield, Mass.) earned a pair of assists in the win over Northeastern...The Terriers have allowed a goal in each of their last 15 periods of play...Junior Kieran Millan made 37 saves in the victory over Northeastern to pick up the 50th victory of his collegiate career...Freshmen Adam Clendening (Wheatfield, N.Y.), Charlie Coyle and Nieto have been named to the U.S. National Junior Team's preliminary roster for the 2011 IIHF World Junior Championship.

**MAINE:** The University of Maine men's ice hockey team split a pair of games on the weekend...Maine fell to UNH in overtime, before rebounding to defeat UMass on Sunday...The Black Bears have a record of 26-5-1 all-time against UMass at Alford Arena...Maine is 6-1-1 at Alford Arena this season with the lone loss coming to New Hampshire last Friday night...There was a sell out crowd of 5,445 fans on hand to see the game against New Hampshire...It was the first sell out since Nov. 10, 2007 when the same number was on hand to see Maine play Providence...Junior Brian Flynn had a hat trick in the game on Sunday against UMass. It was the first Black Bear to have a hat trick since Flynn scored five goals against UMass Lowell on Feb. 19, 2010. Flynn has goals in three straight games and has five goals in that span. Flynn scored his 40th career goal against UMass and leads all Black Bears in career goals...Maine has allowed just one power play goal in its last four games and have killed off 17 of 18 opponent power plays...Six of Maine's first 16 games have gone to overtime... The Black Bears will now have 16 days off before returning to action when they face Miami in the first round of the Florida College Classic played in Estero, Fla.

**MASSACHUSETTS:** The 4-1 loss at No. 8 Maine snapped UMass' four-game unbeaten streak and marked the third time this season UMass has lost by three goals...UMass did carry a 1-0 lead into the first intermission as the Minutemen have now outscored opponents 6-2 in the first period over the last five games...UMass' 22 shots for the game were its second fewest of the season...UMass was 0-for-4 on the power play dropping to 2-for-15 over the last three games (13.3%)...UMass was averaging four goals a game over the last four games prior to the Maine loss...The loss snapped a five-game win streak to the Black Bears...UMass allowed a player to score a hat trick for the second time this season (Flynn, Maine; Barriball, Minnesota)...UMass remains winless on the road this season at 0-5-2...UMass will head to Wisconsin on Dec. 30-31 - The Badgers were the first opponents UMass faced under head coach Don "Toot" Cahoon opening the 2000-01 season.

**UMASS-LOWELL:** Falling twice at Princeton this past weekend, the River Hawks' losing streak extends to nine games...On Friday, UMass Lowell led by one goal for over 33 minutes, the most amount of time the River Hawks have led in a game this season...David Vallorani's tally on Friday granted UMass Lowell a first period road lead for the first time since Oct. 19 against RIT...Doug Carr (Hanover, Mass.) made 40 saves in the loss, one shy of his career-high...For the weekend, Vallorani and Matt Ferreira each scored two goals...Freshman Derek Arnold assisted on all four tallies and was the primary assist on three of four...Sophomore Riley Wetmore (Swanton, Vt.) expanded his lead in the River Hawk scoring

race with 14 points on seven goals and seven assists...Now on holiday break, UMass Lowell will not return to action until Jan. 7 when it travels to New Hampshire for a clash in the Whittemore Center.

**MERRIMACK:** Merrimack was idle last week and is in the midst of 24 days without a game...The Warriors return to the ice at Army on Dec. 30 and at RIT on Jan. 1...Construction began on Monday to complete the Lawler Renovations. The final set of bleachers were removed and will be replaced by chair back seats and a tunnel to the opposing bench before Merrimack's next home game which is January 8 against Maine...The Warriors are ranked 17th nationally, its highest national ranking ever...Merrimack concludes its pre-holiday schedule with a 7-4-4 record, 5-4-3 in Hockey East, its best start in its Division I history...Senior Chris Barton (Calgary, Alta.) is on pace to become the first Merrimack player to reach 100 points since Anthony Aquino in 2002...Merrimack's penalty kill is first in the country at 89.8%...Karl Stollery (Camrose, Alta.) is tied for third among Hockey East defenders in scoring with 10 points, while Stephane Da Costa (Paris, France) is tied for first with three game-winning goals...Junior goaltender Joe Cannata (Wakefield, Mass.) ranks second in Hockey East in goals-against and save percentage.

**NEW HAMPSHIRE:** UNH is off to its best start at 10-2-4 (.750) since the 2006-07 season when it was 13-2-1 (.900)...The Wildcats own the nation's third-best winning percentage behind Yale and Minnesota-Duluth...New Hampshire is riding a five-game unbeaten streak (4-0-1; nation's second-longest streak) heading into a 23-game holiday break...Freshman Jeff Silengo scored the first two goals of his collegiate career including the game-winner at 1:26 of overtime in a 4-3 win at Maine...UNH's Dalton Speelman scored an extra-attacker goal with 18 seconds remaining in regulation, it marks the second time this season the 'Cats were successful in an extra-attacker situation...New Hampshire is now 10-0-0 in its last 10 games in December with its last loss in the month coming on Dec. 28, 2007 against North Dakota...UNH's top line of Mike Sislo, Paul Thompson and Phil DeSimone have been on a tear of late. Over the past nine games, the trio has combined for 53 points (5.89 ppg) on 15 goals (1.67 gpg) and 38 assists (4.22 apg). Sislo and Thompson have a point in nine-straight games.

**NORTHEASTERN:** Northeastern met up with #7 Boston University for the first time this season on a rare Wednesday night game at Agganis Arena, dropping a 5-4 nail biter. The Huskies had their hands full against the Terriers after they scored the first goal because BU is 5-1-2 this season when the opponent scores first. Boston University is also 11-2-4 in its last 17 games at home, but Northeastern did its best to topple BU...Sophomore Chris Rawlings started for the Huskies in net, but newcomer Clay Witt saw action in his second-career game and the first time he came in for relief of Rawlings this season. Witt was charged with his second loss of the season while making six saves and surrendering NU's power play tally. The Huskies outshot BU by an astounding 41-20 total, marking the second-highest shot total for Northeastern in its first half of the season. Wade MacLeod continues to lead the Huskies with 14 points (6-8-14) and moved up another spot in the NU annals for career points. MacLeod surpassed Gerry Cronin (1958-61) and is now in a three-way tie with Larry Bone (1963-66) and Matt Saunders (1988-92). The Coquitlam, B.C. native has tallied 106 points (45-61-106) in 127 career contests.

**PROVIDENCE COLLEGE:** Providence College finished the first half of the season with a 7-6-5 overall record, the first time that the Friars have been over .500 at the Christmas break since the 2005-06 season...PC finished its non-conference schedule with a 4-2-1 mark, including a 4-0-1 record in the last five non-league games...Providence tied Brown (4-4) on Tuesday and retained the Mayor's Cup by virtue of winning the cup last season...The Friars had four different goal scorers in a tie at Brown and a five different goal scorers in a 5-2 win over Quinnipiac...The five goals vs. Quinnipiac were a season high...PC improved to 4-1-3 at Schneider Arena...The Friar third line of seniors Matt Germain (Rockland, Mass.) and Jordan Kremyr as well as freshman Derek Army accounted for five of the team's nine goals last week, including two by Army and Kremyr...The Friars, who did not score any short-handed goals last season, have three short-handed goals this season...The Friars senior class has scored 29 of the team's 47 goals (62%).

**VERMONT:** Vermont played its fourth straight team ranked in the top-20 and ended a three game skid with a 6-5 victory over No. 19 Dartmouth...Sebastian Stålberg tallied a pair of goals and his team leading sixth assist of the year in the Dartmouth win...Wahsontio Stacey (Kahnawake, Que.) added a goal and two assists to help lead Vermont over the 19th ranked Big Green...Vermont's fourth line of Marshall (2g), Brett Leonard (South Burlington, Vt.) (2a) and Matt White (McMurray, Pa.) (1g) combined for five points and a +9 rating in the Dartmouth win...Lance Herrington (Bow, N.H.) picked up a pair of assists for UVM in Vermont's third straight win over the Big Green...Rob Madore stopped 32 shots in between the pipes for the Catamounts.

## COMMISSIONER'S CORNER by Joe Bertagna

On Friday night, I drove to Brunswick, Maine, and caught the 194th edition of Bowdoin-Colby hockey. It was a non-Hockey East night in the beautiful Sid Watson Arena but there was some Hockey East flavor in the fact that the two coaches, Bowdoin's Terry Meagher and Colby's Jim Tortorella, are graduates of Boston University and Maine, respectively. Sid himself was a graduate of Northeastern University.

As is often the case, rivalries bring out the best in each opponent, and such was the case that night when the host Polar Bears won a close 3-2 game over the Mules. At Colby the next night, the visitors spotted their hosts a 5-1 lead and stormed back for a stunning 6-5 win and a weekend sweep. Both games were sold out.

A couple of hours to the North, one of Hockey East's best rivalries was on display Friday night when another sellout crowd filled Alford Arena in Orono to see Maine host New Hampshire. Equally dramatic was this UNH win as the Wildcats tied the game with 18 seconds to go and won it at 1:26 of overtime. Both of these teams are ranked in the Top Ten nationally and this nationally televised game (CBS College Sports) had that "big game" feel to it.

"Rivalry Weekend" also included the Michigan - Michigan State game played outdoors at "The Big House," the Wolverines football stadium, before the largest crowd to ever watch a hockey game, 113,411. This one didn't quite have the drama of the aforementioned games played in the state of Maine as Michigan dominated its guests, 5-0. But the magic of that particular rivalry went a long way in drawing that historic crowd to Ann Arbor.
