NO. 8 MAINE COMPETES AT FLORIDA COLLEGE CLASSIC; NO. 4 BC AT DARTMOUTH TOURNEY \sim UMass plays pair at Wisconsin; Boston U. travels to Shillelagh Tournament \sim

No. 8 Maine vs. No. 6 Miami (Wed., Thurs. at Florida College Classic, Estero, Fla.)

- Maine has allowed just one power play goal in its last four games. The Black Bears have killed off 17 of the last 18 opponent power plays.
 - Maine is 5-0-0 against Miami all-time, which includes a 2-0-0 record in neutral site games.

Massachusetts at No. 15 Wisconsin Two-Game Series (Thurs, Fri. at the Kohl Center)

- Massachusetts returns from a 17-day break. The last game was a 4-1 setback against Maine that snapped a four game unbeaten streak.
