The River Hawks scored four goals in each of their first two games after reaching the mark just seven times in 2010-11

TEAM NOTES

BOSTON COLLEGE: With the team's 5-1 win at New Hampshire on Sat., Oct. 15, BC captured its third straight victory over the Wildcats. The Eagles beat New Hampshire 4-3 in its only trip to Durham, N.H., on March 5 last winter and is now unbeaten in its last six games in the Whittemore Center (4-0-2)...Parker Milner's 39-save performance marked a career high, surpassing his previous mark of 34 saves in a 2-1 overtime win over UMass on Feb. 26, 2010...Brian Dumoulin's first-period goal at New Hampshire marked the fifth of his career and first since the team's 5-3 win over Merrimack in the 2011 Hockey East Tournament championship game. Dumoulin finished Saturday's game in Durham with a +4 rating, a single-game career high...Freshman forward Cam Spiro (Hingham, Mass.) made his collegiate debut against the Wildcats and is the fourth BC freshman to see action this winter, joining Johnny Gaudreau, Danny Linell and Destry Straight...The team's 4-2 home loss to No. 3 Denver marked BC's first home-opening loss since a 2-1 loss to Maine in the 2005-06 season opener (Oct. 28)...The Eagles played before a sellout crowd of 7,884 fans, marking the fourth straight regular-season sellout in Kelley Rink.

BOSTON UNIVERSITY: Dating back to last season, five Terriers (Alex Chiasson, Chris Connolly, Wade Megan, Matt Nieto, Corey Trivino) are currently on five-game point streaks...Both Trivino and Nieto have scored a goal in all three contests this season...BU has successfully killed off 17 of its opponents' 18 power plays thus far this season and the penalty kill ranks fifth in the nation at 94.4 percent...Last season, BU ranked fourth in the nation in penalty killing at 86.6 percent...BU has now won its last three meetings with Denver following Saturday's 4-3 triumph over the third-ranked Pioneers...The last time the Terriers defeated a team ranked third or higher was the 2009 Beanpot championship game when they topped then-No. 3 Northeastern, 5-2...All four of the Terriers' goals against Denver came on special teams (4-on-4, power play, 2 shorthanded)...Sophomore Sahir Gill (Terrace, B.C.) has recorded at least one assist in each game this season...Dating back to last season's Beanpot consolation game, the Terriers have scored at least one power-play goal in 12 of its last 13 contests...Freshman Cason Hohmann (Plymouth, Mich.) recorded his first collegiate point when he assisted on Chiasson's goal that opened the scoring against the Pioneers...At least eight Terriers have recorded at least one point in all three games this season.

MAINE: The University of Maine (1-2-1, 1-1-0 HEA) traveled to North Dakota last weekend for a series with the Fighting Sioux...It was Maine's third trip to the impressive Ralph Engelstad Arena in Grand Forks, N.D...Maine's senior class tallied all four goals on the weekend and 10 of the 12 points on the weekend...Ryan Hegarty (Arlington, Mass.) tallied the game-tying goal midway through the third period on Saturday...Hegarty has three career goals and one is a game-winner and one is a game-tying goal...Brian Flynn (Lynnfield, Mass.) and Spencer Abbott (Hamilton, Ont.) have combined to score 14 of Maine's 31 points on the season...Two of the three goals that Maine allowed on Saturday night came when the Black Bears were down 5-on-3... Maine scored the first goal in each game over the weekend and has yet to allow a first period goal on the season... Nick Pryor (Woodbury, Minn.), who had played in just 11 total games his first two seasons after being hampered by injuries, has played in all four games this season.

MASSACHUSETTS: UMass had a season-high 47 shots in the win over Bentley, its most since 48 against Providence on Oct. 31, 2009...Averaging 4.00 goals per game, UMass is tied for third among Hockey East teams in scoring...UMass ranks 2nd among Hockey East teams in power play at 21.1 percent (4-of-19) after going 3-for-13 on the weekend... UMass has a league-high 57 penalty minutes despite taking six penalties for 12 minutes at Providence, UMass has lowered its total of PIM's in each game this season...Six different Minutemen had points in each game this weekend.

UMASS-LOWELL: The River Hawks swept Minnesota State in Mankato, MN by scores of 4-2 and 4-1 to start the season 2-0-0 for the first time since 2001-02. Norm Bazin became the third coach in program history to win his debut. The wins also marked the first time UMass Lowell has swept an opponent during opening weekend since 1993-94, when then-senior Norm Bazin and the River Hawks took two wins from Air Force in Colorado Springs, CO. In addition, the River Hawks won consecutive games for the first time since Feb. 20-26, 2010. UMass Lowell's Friday night victory was the program's 700th of all-time as the team has a 701-624-91 record in 1,426 games...Junior captain Riley Wetmore is now just one shy of reaching 50 career points. Up next, UMass Lowell has a quick turnaround, playing Connecticut in the Conway Arena in Nashua, NH on Tuesday before taking the rest of the week off.

MERRIMACK: Ranked 13th nationally, Merrimack defeated Army 3-2 in the home opener at Lawler Arena in front of a sellout crowd of 2,489...It was the sixth straight sellout at Lawler and ninth straight home win dating back to last year...Merrimack is 27-5-2 at home since the start of 2009-10...John Heffernan and Rhett Bly both had multi-point efforts in the win, as the Warriors have defeated Army in each of the last 13 meetings...The Warriors have won 10 straight non-conference games at home and are 20-6-3 in their last 29 non-conference games...Merrimack and WBIN-TV announced a partnership to televise at least three games live from Lawler Arena beginning December 17 against Union. This marks the first TV contract for Merrimack in school history...Merrimack hosts a pair of games next weekend for Homecoming. The Warriors take on Northeastern at 7:30 p.m. on Friday and Connecticut Saturday at 7 p.m. NU handed Merrimack one of its two home losses last season and split a pair of games at Lawler in 2009-10.

NEW HAMPSHIRE: The Wildcats will leave Hockey East play for the first time when they head to St. Cloud State for a two-game set... UNH is playing the Huskies for just the second and third games lifetime... On March 28, 2003, the Cats captured a 5-2 win over St. Cloud at the NCAA regionals in Worcester, Mass en route to the Frozen Four... The Huskies and Wildcats are both trying to snap a three-game losing streaking with SCSU owning a 1-3 record... Nick Sorkin scored a power play goal on Saturday night to snap a 122 minute scoreless streak to start the season... UNH is winless in it's first three games for the first time since 2009-10 (0-2-1) and 0-3 for the first time since 1988-89... New Hampshire has played seven players for the first time this season including sophomores Jeff Wyer, Justin Agosta and Eric Knodel as well as Grayson Downing, Trevor van Riemsdyk, Casey Thrush and Jay Camper... UNH owned a 40-25 shot edge Saturday night against BC, while the also outshot Northeastern 27-21 on Friday night.

NORTHEASTERN: Northeastern head coach Jim Madigan earned his first career victory thanks to a 4-0 shutout over No. 15 New Hampshire on Friday night at Matthews Arena as junior netminder Chris Rawlings tied the school record in career shutouts. Rawlings matched Brad Thiessen's (2006-09) benchmark of nine career shutouts in just 69 appearances. Four different Huskies (Braden Pimm, Zak Stone, Justin Daniels, Mike McLaughlin) found the back of the net in Northeastern's first shutout of the season and third-ever shutout over New Hampshire in program history. There have been 130 games between the two clubs since the Huskies blanked New Hampshire. The last occurrence transpired at home on Jan. 10, 1961 (2-0). Sophomore Zak Stone netted his first-career goal on Friday night while three Huskies gained their first-career points, including rookies Adam Reid, Josh Manson and Ludwig Karlsson. Braden Pimm leads Northeastern with five points (2-3-5) and is one of two Huskies to have scored in every contest this season. Mike McLaughlin is the other. Jim Madigan is just the second Northeastern coach in program history to win his third game behind the bench. Jim Bell was the other after defeating Brown on Dec. 7, 1955.

PROVIDENCE COLLEGE: Providence College has won three consecutive season openers...Providence's win on Friday night was the first over Boston University since February 19, 2010...Nate Leaman posted his first win as Friar Head Coach...Four freshmen scored in the win over BU...Myles Harvey, who had not scored a goal in his first 53 career games, has three goals in the last two games, including two on the power play...The last time that Providence won its first two league games was during the 2005-06 season...PC is also off to its first 2-0 start since the 2009-10 season...The Friars have scored five goals or more in consecutive games for the first time since the 2007-08 season...In addition, it's the first time that Providence has scored five goals or more in its first two games since the start of the 2003-04 season...PC goalie Alex Beaudry is on pace to break the school record for career saves. He currently has 2326 stops, 522 saves away from matching the record of 2,848 that was set by Nolan Schaefer (1999-2003)...The Friars will play the defending national champion for the sixth consecutive season as they will host Minnesota-Duluth for the games this weekend.

VERMONT: Vermont returns 78% of its scoring and four of its top five overall scorers from last year...Three of Vermont's newcomers in 2011-12 have been selected in the NHL draft: graduate student Brett Bruneteau (Washington) and freshmen Michael Paliotta (Chicago) and Nick Luukko (Philadelphia)...The Catamounts are seeking their third NCAA Tournament appearance in the last four seasons...Vermont begins the regular season with its first-ever trip to Mariucci Arena for a two-game series against Minnesota on Oct. 21 and 23.
