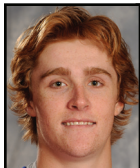

TEAM NOTES

BOSTON COLLEGE: BC has tallied its two highest shot totals this season against the Northeastern. It attempted a season-high 43 shots in a 4-3 overtime win on Oct. 22 and 36 in a 2-1 win on Nov. 11...Tommy Cross, who netted the game-winning goal with 2.8 seconds left in the third period, scored his first goal since a 5-4 win over the Huskies in the semifinals of the Hockey East Tournament in TD Garden last March... Sunday's 5-0 loss to Boston University marked just the eighth time in the 255-game series between the teams that the Terriers have shutout the Eagles. The previous shutouts occurred on March 1, 1983 (3-0), March 3, 1982 (5-0), Feb. 24, 1964 (1-0), Feb. 13, 1953 (3-0), and at one unknown date during each of three seasons - 1927-28, 1925-26 and 1924-25...Sophomore forward Kevin Hayes had his nine-game scoring streak snapped in Sunday's loss to Boston University. He had tallied all 13 of his points during this stretch...Junior left wing Chris Kreider was held from the scoresheet for just the second time in 12 games this season...BC surrendered its third shorthanded goal in 12 games this season; it gave up four shorthanded goals in 2010-11. Sunday's game against Boston University marked the last of nine straight league games for BC.

BOSTON UNIVERSITY: The Terriers' 5-0 victory at No. 2 Boston College on Sunday was the first BU shutout of the Eagles since March 1, 1983, when the teams were still in the ECAC...The result also marked the most decisive victory for the Terriers over BC since a 10-3 decision at Walter Brown Arena on Jan. 13, 1996...The Terriers already have as two shutouts this season, equaling their total from the past two seasons combined...Kieran Millan is the first-ever BU goaltender to earn shutouts vs. BC and UNH in the same season...The Terriers lead the nation in shorthanded goals with five and they have been scored by five different players...BU also leads the nation in penalty minutes per game at 23.8, nearly four more than Miami in second at 20.0...The 3-2 overtime loss to Merrimack on Friday was BU's first overtime defeat in Hockey East play since a 5-4 contest at Providence on Feb. 21, 2003...The triumph over BC snapped the Terriers' five-game losing streak in the rivals' series, which was the longest for BU since 1957...The Terriers are 3-1-0 against ranked teams this season, but just 1-3-1 against non-ranked squads.

MAINE: Maine dropped a pair of games against UMass Lowell...Brian Flynn (Lynnfield, Mass.) had a goal and three assists on the weekend. He has 10 goals and 12 assists for 22 points in 14 career games against the River Hawks. Flynn ranks 33rd on Maine's all-time scoring list with 122 career points...Joey Diamon scored three goals on the weekend, including a highlight reel goal on Friday when he scored with his back to the goal...Maine goalie Dan Sullivan (York, Pa.) picked up his first career assist on Friday night...Jake Rutt (Scarborough, Maine) made his collegiate debut on Saturday night against UMass Lowell...Will O'Neill (Salem, Mass.) scored his 75th career point on Saturday night against UMass Lowell...Spencer Abbott (Hamilton, Ont.) is just four points shy of the 100 point plateau... Maine tied its season-high with two power play goals on Saturday against UMass Lowell.

MASSACHUSETTS: UMass won three straight games for the first time since beating Vermont, Quinnipiac and UMass Lowell (11/23-12/4, 2010)...UMass 7 goals vs. Holy Cross was the most for the Minutemen since defeating Providence 9-4 on Oct. 31, 2008...A win over Maine would give UMass its first four-game win streak since Jan. 10-23, 2010...UMass is 5-2-1 against Maine in the last 8 games...UMass has beaten UMass Lowell in five straight games including all three games last year...At 3.80 goals per game, UMass now ranks 2nd in Hockey East for scoring...UMass is also tied for third in the league on the power play (13-of-57, 22.8%) after going 4-for-9 with the extra man over the weekend...UMass has a power play goal in six straight games...Through the first 10 games this season, UMass has increased scoring over last year's same time span. The Minutemen have 38 goals compared to 26 a year ago (+1.20g/game).

UMASS-LOWELL: The River Hawks swept the Black Bears in Orono, ME for the second time in program history. The last time it happened was Feb. 8-9, 1985. It was also the program's first four-point Hockey East weekend since Jan. 22-23, 2010. UMass Lowell is now 5-3-0 on the year, matching its win total from a season ago. The River Hawks recorded last season's fifth victory on Feb. 26, 2011. UMass Lowell has scored four or more goals in five of its first eight games after reaching that figure just seven times in 2010-11. Reigning HE Rookie of the Week Scott Wilson stayed hot, scoring two goals and an assist against the Black Bears. Senior Matt Ferreira is the first River Hawk to crack double-digits this season with 10 points on five goals and five assists. In Saturday's 4-3 win, UMass Lowell finished 3-for-5 on the power play,

recording three power play goals for the second time this season. With the four-goal third period on Saturday, the River Hawks have now outscored opponents 13-5 in the third period.

MERRIMACK: Merrimack remained the only unbeaten team in the country with a come-from-behind 3-2 overtime victory over #16 Boston University Friday night at Agganis Arena...Connor Toomey (BillERICA, MA) tallied his first career goal 22 seconds into overtime for the game-winner after Brandon Brodhag (Brooklyn Park, Minn.) tied it with 1:56 to play in the third...Merrimack improved to 8-0-1 overall, 6-0-1 in Hockey East, continuing its best start in 25 years...The Warriors are ranked first in Pairwise and Krach...Merrimack's defense remained tops in the country. The win gave Merrimack two straight over BU for the first time in the 96-game history between the two teams...It was also the Warriors' first win at Agganis Arena in regular season history and marked the first time BU has dropped an overtime game in league action in nine years...Justin Mansfield (Arlington, MA) scored the first goal of the game, becoming the first Merrimack freshman to net a point this season...Ryan Flanigan (Rochester, NY) saw his 15-game point streak snapped in the win...Merrimack's penalty kill, second in the league and fifth nationally, killed eight-of-nine BU power plays in the win.

NEW HAMPSHIRE: UNH extended its unbeaten streak to six games with a 4-4 tie with Vermont on Saturday night in Burlington. The Wildcats hold the second-longest unbeaten streak in Hockey East and the fifth-longest streak in the nation...Sophomore Nick Sorkin extended his point scoring streak to eight games with an assist on Saturday night. He has a point in every game UNH has scored this season with 12 points on five goals and seven assists in that span...Stevie Moses registered a goal and two assists on Saturday night at Vermont. The senior is riding a four-game point scoring streak with seven points on three goals and four assist in that span...UNH's has scored a goal in each of the past five games and is operating at 21.6 percent.

NORTHEASTERN: Northeastern and No. 2 Boston College skated to yet another epic battle, but the Eagles prevailed in the final moments as BC scored with 2.8 seconds left to take the 2-1 victory on Friday night at Conte Forum. On Saturday night, the Huskies were bettered by Massachusetts in a 4-2 final. On Friday night, sophomore forward Cody Ferriero scored his first goal in 11 Huskies' contests. The Essex, Mass. native's last goal came in the quarterfinal round of the Hockey East Playoffs at Boston University on March 13. Ferriero was assisted by junior pairing Garrett Vermeersch and Alex Tuckerman, each securing their second assists of the season on Ferriero's tally. At the Mullins Center, Northeastern scored its second and third power play goals of the season at Massachusetts. It marks NU's first two-goal performance with the extra skater this season. All three Huskies' power play goals have come against UMass...Anthony Bitetto tallied his fourth-career power play goal at UMass. The last time he scored a power play goal came at Boston College on Feb. 18, 2011. All four goals Bitetto has accounted for at Northeastern have come on the power play.

PROVIDENCE COLLEGE: Providence has won four consecutive games for the first time since the 2008-09 season...The Friars improved to 6-1-1 at home with two wins over Alabama-Huntsville...Senior goalie Alex Beaudry earned his second career shutout on Friday as he stopped all 21 shots...Providence has scored a power-play goal in five consecutive games and have nine goals on the man advantage in that span...In all, the Friars have 12 power-play goals this season, three shy of last season's total...The Friars killed off 29 consecutive penalties before allowing a power-play goal late in the second period on Saturday night...In all, Providence went five straight games without allowing a power-play goal...Junior Tim Schaller has eight goals this season, one more than his first two seasons combined...Senior Myles Harvey's eight points this season are more than double the total from his first two seasons (three points)... After 10 games, the Friars are off to their best since the 2003-04 season when they started 6-2-2.

VERMONT: Vermont's last four games against New Hampshire have been decided by a total of three goals...The Catamounts are averaging 31 shots per game over their last three contests...Rob Madore made a season-high 36 saves against New Hampshire on Saturday night...Vermont will play five of its next seven games at home at Gutterson Fieldhouse, which includes a five-game homestand starting on November 22...UVM has two shorthanded goals in its last four games against UNH...Matt White has four points on three goals and one assist in his last four matchups with New Hampshire...Vermont took a season-low four penalties on Saturday against UNH, and only one resulted in a Wildcat power play.
