UMASS SHUTS OUT NO. 4 BC; NO. 6 BU, UNH PICK UP TWO VICTORIES ~ Eagles edge NU at Fenway; Merrimack takes three points; PC, Vermont earn wins ~



ATHLETIC REPUBLIC PLAYER OF THE WEEK

#22 STEVIE MOSES, NEW HAMPSHIRE (Senior Forward; Leominster, Mass.)

Moses scored all five of UNH's goals on the week leading the Wildcats to a pair of wins. He scored the game's lone goal in a 1-0 win over Providence on Wednesday and followed that up with a four-goal outburst vs. Dartmouth on Saturday. Moses had 14 shots on goal and was a +3 plus/minus rating on the week.



PRO AMBITIONS ROOKIE OF THE WEEK

#29 CASEY DESMITH, NEW HAMPSHIRE (Freshman Goaltender; Rochester, N.H.)

Desmith stopped 48-of-49 shots (.980 save%) on the week earning his first two collegiate wins and his first collegiate shutout. On Wednesday at Providence, he stopped all 26 shots he faced to earn a 1-0 win. On Saturday vs. Dartmouth, he stopped the final 21 Dartmouth shots, in the 4-1 victory.



HOCKEY EAST CO-DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

#35 JOE CANNATA, MERRIMACK (Senior Goaltender; Wakefield, Mass.)

Stopped 63 of 67 shots (.940 save%) on the weekend, including 39 stops in Saturday's tie with Maine. Allowed only two even strength goals all, becoming the program's all-time saves leader (2,698).



HOCKEY EAST CO-DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

#39 STEVE MASTALERZ, MASSACHUSETTS (Freshman Goaltender; N. Andover, Mass.)

Mastalerz made a career-high 35 saves in the 4-0 win over No. 4 Boston College – UMass' only game of the week. He helped the penalty kill unit go 6-for-6. Mastalerz made 14 of his 35 saves in the third period where he also helped kill off three penalties. His shutout made him the first-ever UMass goalie since 1920 to blank Boston College.



HOCKEY EAST TEAM OF THE WEEK

BOSTON UNIVERSITY TERRIERS

The Terriers took home a pair of one-goal road victories over the weekend, scoring four goals in each contest. BU went 3-for-14 on the power play over the weekend, including 2-for-6 in the Northeastern win on Friday night at Matthews Arena.

CASEY DESMITH, UNH (ROCHESTER, N.H.)

Earn his first collegiate win and shutout in a 1-0 win at Providence on Wednesday night

Tallied his first collegiate goal in Friday's win at Northeastern

CHAD RUHWEDEL, UML (SAN DIEGO, CALIF.)

Leads all Hockey East defensemen with 0.94 points per game

JAKE RUTT, MAINE (SCARBOROUGH, MAINE)

Tallied his first career point with an assist on Saturday night

SEBASTIAN STALBERG, UVM (GOTHENBURG, SWEDEN)

Has 15 points in his last 11 games (5g,10a)

KARL STOLLERY, MC (CAMROSE, ALTA.)

Moved into third all-time on Merrimack's scoring list among defensemen in Division I history with 77 career points

T.J. SYNER, UMASS (SPRINGFIELD, MASS.)

Has at least one point in 18 of 21 games this season

CHRIS VENTI, BC (NEEDHAM, MASS.)

Made his first career start on Saturday at Fenway Park vs. NU and notched his first collegiate victory

TEAM NOTES

BOSTON COLLEGE: Former Eagle Jimmy Hayes (2008-11) made his NHL debut with the Chicago Blackhawks on Friday, Dec. 30, 2011 to become the 18th BC hockey alum to have seen NHL action this season. Of the 18 former BC players that have seen NHL action, 11 played on teams that captured NCAA Championships at BC...BC's win over Northeastern completes a three-game league series sweep for BC and marked the third one-goal victory Boston College achieved over Northeastern this winter. The team captured a 4-3 overtime win on Oct. 22 in Matthews Arena and a 2-1 win on Nov. 11 in Kelley Rink on a last-second goal by captain Tommy Cross...Junior Pat Mullane's second-period goal marked his third of the season and first since a two-goal performance at North Dakota on Oct. 8...Chris Kreider's goal against the Huskies marked his second shorthanded score and the team's sixth of the season...Chris Venti saw his first action of the season at Massachusetts on Friday, recording five saves in the game's final 30:02 and recorded his first collegiate start the next night against Northeastern at Fenway Park where he backstopped Boston College to a 2-1 win over Northeastern.

BOSTON UNIVERSITY: The Terriers have won five of their last six contests - coming from behind in all five victories - and 10 of their last 12...BU is 7-4-1 this season when it allows the first goal...Sophomore Adam Clendening is on a four-game point streak with eight points (1g, 7a) during the stretch...Senior Chris Connolly now has nine points (5g, 4a) in five career games against Harvard...Sophomore Garrett Noonan (Norfolk, Mass.) scored the game-winner in overtime against Harvard and had a plus-4 rating on the weekend to raise his team-best rating to plus-13, which is tied for third in the league...The Terriers have scored at least four goals in each of their last four victories...BU is 10-3-16 in its last 29 overtime games following its triumph at Harvard...Senior Kieran Millan (Edmonton, Alta.) and sophomore Matt Nieto (Long Beach, Calif.) were among the preliminary candidates for online voting for this year's Hobey Baker Award...The Terriers and Friars are tied for first in the nation in shorthanded goals with eight each...BU enters the week ranked 2nd in the RPI and 3rd in the Pairwise.

MAINE: Maine saw its four-game winning streak snapped at Merrimack on Friday night...Maine skated to a 2-2 draw with the Warriors on Saturday night...The Black Bears are now 2-0-3 in overtime on the season...Maine finished the first semester with a 3.31 team GPA...It is the highest in program history and the ninth straight 3.0 semester...23 of Maine's 26 student-athletes posted a 3.0 GPA or higher...Maine is currently scoring at an 82.2 percent clip on the power play, which is among the national leaders...The Black Bears have scored at least one power play goal in 13 straight games...Brian Flynn (Lynnfield, Mass.) moved into a tie for 21st place on Maine's all-time scoring list on the weekend with his 140th career point. He has 66 goals and 77 assists...Maine has outscored its opponents 25-14 in the first period of games this season...Spencer Abbott (Hamilton, Ont.), Brian Flynn and Joey Diamond (Long Beach, N.Y.) all have six game points streaks.

MASSACHUSETTS: UMass is now 4-1-2 since the start of December with the win over No. 4 BC...The 4-0 shutout marked the first time since the series began in 1920 that UMass blanked Boston College...UMass won the season series vs. BC for the first time since 2006-07, the same season UMass made its first-ever NCAA Tournament appearance...The two wins this season came with Boston College ranked No. 1 in the country (W, 4-2) and No. 4 in the country (W, 4-0)...The win also improves UMass to 4-2-1 against ranked teams this season...UMass is now the only team in the country to be unbeaten at home this year at 6-0-3...UMass scored its first shorthanded goal in nearly two seasons on Friday night (the last was against Northeastern on Feb. 13, 2009)...When allowing four or more goals this year, UMass is 0-7-1, however, when cutting that to 3-or-fewer, UMass is 8-1-3...Holding a lead or being tied after 2 periods has also been a good omen for UMass this year as the Minutemen are 8-1-3 (0-7-1 when trailing).

UMASS-LOWELL: The River Hawks fell in overtime, 3-2, at Vermont on Friday night, the first UMass Lowell overtime loss to the Catamounts since Vermont joined Hockey East (1-1-4). The game marked UMass Lowell's first against a Hockey East opponent since Dec. 10, 2011. The River Hawks are now 1-2-0 in overtime contests this season. The loss snapped UMass Lowell's eight-game winning streak in games which it has scored first and 11-game streak when leading after two periods. The River Hawks have had at least four freshmen crack double-digit points in back-to-back seasons for the first time 2006-08...Doug Carr ranks third in the nation in GAA (1.96) and is tied for ninth in save percentage (.928). Despite the loss, UMass Lowell ranks fourth in the NCAA in team offense (3.56 gpg) and is tied for 16th in defense (2.56 gagg).

MERRIMACK: Merrimack picked up a win and a tie against Maine at Lawler Arena, concluding a season series without a loss to Maine for the first time ever. Merrimack is 4-0-1 in its last five against Maine at Lawler and has scored 26 goals in those games...The Warriors remain in third place, three points behind first place BU with a game in hand...Hobey Baker nominee Joe Cannata led the way with 63 saves on the weekend. Bryan Schmidt is the all-time leader with 90 points...The senior class led the way totaling six goals and 16 points on the weekend, led by three power play goals from Jesse Todd and four assists from Ryan Flanigan...Merrimack is now 12-1-3 when scoring two or more goals and is 10-1-3 when outshooting its opponent...Merrimack improved to 14-2-2 in its last 18 at home and is 32-7-4 since the start of 2009-10...The Warriors have won three of four season series...A late scratch Saturday due to illness, Brendan Ellis (Kelowna, B.C.), missed the first game of his collegiate career, snapping a 59-game streak.

NEW HAMPSHIRE: UNH snapped a five-game losing streak with a pair of wins during the week over Providence (1-0) and Dartmouth (4-1)...Freshman goalie Casey DeSmith stopped all 26 shots he faced to register his first collegiate win and shutout, lifting UNH to a 1-0 win at PC. He became the first Wildcat freshman goalie to earn a shutout since Brian Foster did so on Dec. 8, 2006 against St. Lawrence...With the win over PC, UNH captures its first road win since Feb. 26, 2011 at Northeastern, a span of 318 days, and extends its unbeaten streak against the Friars to 15 games at 13-0-2...On Saturday, Stevie Moses registered his second career hat trick, potting four goals and earning Most Valuable Player honors in UNH's 4-1 win over Dartmouth in the Battle for the RiverStone Cup XI at Verizon Wireless Arena...For Moses, the four goals match a career high he netted previously against Alabama-Huntsville on Nov. 26, 2011, at the Whittemore Center Arena. Moses, who scored all five of UNH's goals during the week, is riding a four-game point scoring streak with five goals and two assists in that span.

NORTHEASTERN: Northeastern was swept this weekend with a 4-3 loss to No. 6 Boston University followed by a 2-1 setback against No. 4 Boston College as part of the Sun Life Frozen Fenway weekend at Fenway Park. Against Boston University, rookie Ludwig Karlsson continued on his tear with his second-career two-goal outing to put himself in a tie with Braden Pimm for the team goals lead (8). Karlsson is tied with Denver's Joey LaLeggia in the rookie points race across the entire NCAA with 1.00 points per game. Junior Steve Quailer's 10-game point streak came to an end after being shut out against Boston College. Quailer's 10-game tear accounted for 15 points (6-9-15) and was the longest career point streak of any Husky on the roster. Junior Garrett Vermeersch is riding his third-career four-game point streak, with two goals and three assists.

PROVIDENCE COLLEGE: Providence posted a 1-1 record last week as it suffered its first shutout loss of the season (1-0 versus UNH) and recorded its first win of 2012 (5-2 at Vermont)...The win at Vermont marked the Friars' first triumph at the Gutterson Fieldhouse since December 1, 2007...Providence also completed its first ever three-game season-sweep against the Catamounts...The Friars have won two of their last three road games after going 0-10-3 in their previous 13 road contests dating back to last season...The Friars have scored one short-handed goal in three of the first four games of 2012...Providence has a total of eight short-handed goals which is tied for the national lead...The Friars have killed off 16 of the last 17 opponent power plays...Senior goalie Alex Beaudry has climbed into sixth all-time in Providence's career saves list with 2,741 saves ahead of former Friar great Chris Terrier...With the Friars' ninth win on Sunday, they have surpassed last-season's win total of eight...The seven Hockey East wins are three more than last season.

VERMONT: Three of Vermont's wins this season have come against nationally ranked teams, and two are upsets over top-10 teams...The Catamounts have scored at least one power play goal in seven of their last eight games...UVM became the first team this year to beat UMass Lowell when leading after two periods, as the River Hawks were previously 11-0-0 in that situation...Drew MacKenzie extended his season-high point streak to eight games on Sunday against Providence with a third period assist, and now has a point in 10 of his last 11 games...The Catamounts out-shot the Friars 30-17, as they averaged nearly 32 shots per game in three meetings with PC this season and won the shot battle in all three games...Vermont outshot UMass Lowell and Providence by a combined total of 29-8 in the third period last weekend...The Cats took a total of six penalties against the River Hawks and Friars and remain the least penalized team in Hockey East with 11.7 minutes per game.
