Ferreiro recorded five points (4g,1a) in the road sweep of Vermont, Northeastern's first hat trick in over two years on Friday and scored another goal on Saturday. He also added an assist on Friday. Ferreiro finished the weekend with five shots on goal and a +3 plus/minus rating.

#19 CHRIS KREIDER, BOSTON COLLEGE (Junior Forward; Boxford, Mass.)

Kreider registered team-high five points (2g,3a) in a two-game series sweep of New Hampshire over the weekend. He recorded three points (1g,2a) in the 4-3 win on Friday night at Conte Forum and followed that up with two points (1g,1a) in the 3-2 overtime victory on Saturday at the Whittemore Center. Kreider has 10 shots on goal on the weekend with a +2 rating.



PRO AMBITIONS ROOKIE OF THE WEEK

#9 TERENCE WALLIN, UMASS-LOWELL (Freshman Forward; Yardley, Pa.)

Wallin scored four points (1g,3a) and a +3 rating in a 2-1-0 week for the River Hawks. He registered two assists in the 4-2 triumph on Friday at the Mullins Center and then tallied two points (1g,1a) in the 5-2 victory Saturday at the Tsongas Center.

TEAM NOTES

BOSTON COLLEGE: Boston College captured two one-goal victories over New Hampshire this weekend, completing a three-game regular-season series sweep of the Wildcats for the first time since the 1989-90 season...BC scored the game-winning goal with less than one minute to play in the third period of Friday's 4-3 win at Kelley Rink, marking the sixth game this winter in which Boston College or its opponent has scored a decisive goal in the game's final minute of play. Bill Arnold (at Northeastern, Oct. 22), Tommy Cross (Northeastern, Nov. 11), Chris Kreider (at Yale, Nov. 26) and Steven Whitney (New Hampshire, Jan. 27) have each netted game-winning goals in a game's final minute thus far in 2011-12...With Saturday's 3-2 overtime win in Durham, N.H., BC improved to 5-0-2 in its last seven games at the Whittemore Center and its senior class improved to 9-3-2 in 14 previous meetings against New Hampshire in the last four years.

BOSTON UNIVERSITY: Boston University was swept by Maine over the weekend and lost its season series with the Black Bears for the first time since the 2003-04 campaign...Since the turn of the new year senior Chris Connolly has put together a seven-game point streak during which he has tallied 10 points (2g, 8a)...Junior Alex Chiasson (4g, 6a) and sophomore Adam Clendening (Wheatfield, N.Y.) (1g, 9a) also recorded 10 points during the month of January. Connolly ranks eighth among active Division I player in career scoring with 112 points (32g, 80a)...BU's power play was an incredible 15-of-39 (38.5%) during the month of January, helping the team win five of its seven games in the month...Sophomore Garrett Noonan (Norfolk, Mass.) is third in the nation amongst defensemen in goals scored with nine...Senior Kieran Millan put together a shutout skein of 116:16 that came to an end during the second period of Friday contest with Maine...Friday's 4-2 loss to the Black Bears marked the first time all season that BU fell when allowing fewer than 30 shots...The Terriers have scored four or more goals 14 times this season after achieving the feat 15 times all last season.

MAINE: Maine swept a weekend series at #2 Boston University...The Black Bears have now swept weekend series against #3 Boston College and #2 Boston University on back-to-back weekends...It was Maine's first weekend sweep at Boston University since Nov. 20 and 21, 1992...The Black Bears have now won 12 of their last 15 games...Maine goalie Dan Sullivan (York, Pa.) stopped a career-high 38 shots on Saturday night...Maine has played six straight games against top-10 teams...The Black Bears have scored a power play goal in 17 straight games...Mark Anthonio has nine goals on the season and eight have come on the power play...Maine has six wins in January. It is the most in a single month since starting the 2006-07 season 6-0-0 in October...Maine is 9-2-0 on the season when Joey Diamond is not whistled for a penalty...Maine is 11-0-0 when scoring four or more goals.

MASSACHUSETTS: UMass is now 5-2-2 since the start of December with the pair of losses over the weekend against No. 11 UMass Lowell...UMass will close out the season series on Friday against Northeastern (1-0-1) and begin the season series against Merrimack on Saturday...UMass holds the season series against the both Vermont and Boston College...UMass suffered its first loss at home (7-1-3) on Friday against UMass Lowell after being the only team in the country to be unbeaten at home heading into the game. That record marks UMass' best home start since going 9-1-2 in 2006-07...UMass' best home record for a season was 13-2-0 in 1993-94 (11-0-0 home start) which was the program's first year after being dormant since 1979...Over the last four games, UMass has been strong on the penalty kill going 29-for-35 (82.9%) including a 5-5 effort vs. Providence and a 6-6 effort against Boston College...Holding a lead or being tied after two periods has also been a good omen for UMass this year as the Minutemen are 9-1-3 (0-9-1 when trailing).

UMASS-LOWELL: The No. 11 ranked River Hawks recovered from a 1-0 loss at Providence on Tuesday with a weekend sweep of Massachusetts in a home-and-home series. The pair of victories over the Minutemen completed a season sweep for UMass Lowell, its first of Massachusetts since 1997-98. The weekend also ties the biggest turnaround in program history as the River Hawks have won 11 more games than in 2010-11, matching the improvement from 1985-86 to 1986-87. Goaltender Doug Carr continues to build upon his outstanding sophomore season. Carr (15-4-0), who stopped 82-of-87 shots on the weekend (.943), ranks tied for fourth in the NCAA in save percentage (.934) and fifth in GAA (1.82).

MERRIMACK: Back in the top-five nationally and tied for fifth in Pair-wise, Merrimack defeated Providence 4-2 in front of a sellout crowd at Lawler Arena Sunday and national audience on Fox College Sports Atlantic...The win moved Merrimack into fourth place with 23 points, two points out of first and one out of third. They own three games in hand on Maine and BC and two games in hand on BU...Led by Joe Cannata, Merrimack improved to 14-1-3 when they score two or more goals...Merrimack has allowed in each of the last seven games...Rhett Bly (Regina, SK) scored for the second straight game...Merrimack played the final 33:17 of the game with only four defensemen...Karl Stollery and Josh Myers each scored during the same five-minute power play...Stollery moved into a tie for second place all-time with Bobby Jay in Merrimack's Division I history in scoring among defensemen with 80 career points...Cannata, who earned an assist on the game-winner, moved up to seventh nationally in save percentage and GAA.

NEW HAMPSHIRE: UNH battled No. 7 Boston College in a home-and-home series this past weekend...The 'Cats dropped a pair of one-goal games to Boston College over the weekend...UNH held a one-goal lead with three minutes remaining on Friday only to see a pair of late goals, while Saturday night took an overtime power play tally...In January, UNH went 3-4-0 with all four losses coming by one-goal margins with three overtime losses...In net for the Wildcats, Casey DeSmith made 30-plus saves Friday and Saturday with 30 and 34 saves, respectively...Saturday night's 34 saves marked a career high for DeSmith... DeSmith is 3-5-0 with all five games lost by one-goal including three in overtime...Senior forward Stevie Moses potted a goal Friday night, but snapped his streak seven-game scoring streak on Saturday night. Moses remains first in goals in Hockey East with 18 and fifth in points with 29...Nick Sorkin extends his point streak to six games with two assists on the weekend. Sorkin is ranked third in assists in Hockey East with 21.

NORTHEASTERN: Northeastern swept its first Hockey East opponent of the season in Burlington, taking care of the Catamounts in 8-3 and 4-2 counts, respectively, in Gutterson Fieldhouse. Northeastern matched a program-best with its fourth-consecutive victory against Vermont on Jan. 28. On Friday, Northeastern ferried three power play goals for a season high in 2011-12. Cody Ferriero's hat trick was the first for Northeastern since Ryan Ginand recorded one against Providence on Jan. 24, 2009. The Essex, Mass. native is also the first Husky to tally four points in a game this season since Ludwig Karlsson did it against Notre Dame on Dec. 2 (0-4-4). Ferriero now has three multi-point games this season. Braden Pimm and Mike McLaughlin turned in back-to-back playmakers on Friday and Saturday. Robbie Vrolyk scored his first goal of the season and first since netting one at Boston College on Feb. 18, 2011. The goal curbed a 31-game goal scoring drought for the Boyston, Mass. native. Vrolyk also added an assist, marking his second career multi-point game and first since a pair of goals at UMass on Feb. 13, 2010.

PROVIDENCE COLLEGE: The Friars defeated #11 UMass Lowell, 1-0, on Tuesday...It marked Providence's first 1-0 shutout win since November 10, 2007...It also marked the first 1-0 home result for Providence since December 3, 2001...Senior Alex Beaudry made 29 saves to earn his second shutout of the season and third of his career...The two shutouts this season is one short of matching a Providence single season shutout record which has been set on four different occasions...The Friars just completed a stretch of four consecutive games against ranked teams...Providence has played against 10 ranked opponents and has four wins over ranked teams this season...The Friars earned their eighth Hockey East win on Tuesday, doubling the amount of league wins from all of last season...Alex Beaudry climbed into third all-time at Providence with 2,806 saves, 42 stops shy of tying the school record which is held by Nolan Schaefer.

VERMONT: Saturday night was the annual Hockey East Skating Strides Against Breast Cancer game, as Vermont wore special edition pink jerseys to raise money for the Vermont Cancer Center...The Catamounts have scored at least one power play goal in 10 of their last 11 games...After taking a season-high 13 penalties on Friday night, Vermont was called for just three minors on Saturday and only gave up one power play to Northeastern...Alex Vazzano made his first start since Nov. 27, 2011 against Dartmouth...Seven of the last eight Catamount goals have been scored by underclassmen...On Friday night, Kyle Mountain became the seventh different player to score his first career goal in a Vermont jersey this season...With his next win, Rob Madore will pass Tom McNamara '77 and Sylvain Turcotte '81 for sole possession of sixth place on the all-time wins list at UVM.
