~BU, UML and UNH, UVM split series; UMass, Maine take two pts; NU, PC play to pair of ties~



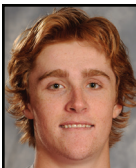
### ATHLETIC REPUBLIC PLAYER OF THE WEEK

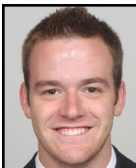

Skated in his 100th-career game on Feb. 17 and

**JERRY YORK, BOSTON COLLEGE**  
Captured his 899th, 900th and 901st career victories last week. York joins Ron Mason as the only two coaches in college hockey history to reach 900 career victories

## TEAM NOTES

**BOSTON COLLEGE:** Bill Arnold broke a 2-2 tie with 6.4 seconds left in overtime to lift Boston College past Boston University in the Beanpot championship game last Monday. It marked the third Beanpot championship in succession for the Eagles, a feat no other Eagles team had accomplished since 1963-65 and the fourth in the last five seasons. It was BC's 17th Beanpot title in all, including its sixth under Jerry York. Arnold's goal marked the ninth time BC (or its opponent) has scored in the game's final minute of play. Arnold has registered two overtime game-winning goals this winter...York captured his 899th, 900th and 901st career victories last week. Now in his 40th season, York joins Ron Mason as the only two coaches in college hockey history to reach 900 career victories. York won 125 games in seven years at Clarkson (1972-79), captured 342 wins in 15 years at Bowling Green (1979-94) and has won 434 games in 18 seasons at BC (1994 to present).

**BOSTON UNIVERSITY:** Since falling at UMass Lowell on Nov. 5 by a score of 7-1 in the team's most lopsided defeat in over 12 years, the Terriers have gone 8-0 on the road in Hockey East play...BU is 7-7 at home this season and 9-3-1 on the road...The Terriers have dropped four straight games at Agganis Arena...Since BU started playing on campus in 1971, there have been just three other times that the Terriers have dropped four in a row at home and the only time it happened in a single season was the 1979-80 campaign...BU allowed its first shorthanded goal of the season in the Beanpot championship game on Monday... Junior Alex Chiasson and sophomore Matt Nieto (Long Beach, Calif.) each had five-game point streaks come to an end on Saturday...The Terriers have scored at least one power-play goal in 13 straight games and are 24-of-68 (.358) with the man advantage since the turn of the new year...BU's fourth line of Ross Gaudet, Ryan Santana and Yasin Cisse combined for seven points (3g,4a) in the series vs. UML...Kieran Millan (Edmonton, Alta.) matched a career high with his 44-save performance in Monday's Beanpot championship game.

**MAINE:** Maine split a pair of games with UMass on the weekend...Maine tied its season-high with seven goals on Friday, before falling on Saturday night 4-1...Brian Flynn scored two goals on Friday to record his 150th career point. He becomes just the 14th player in Maine history to reach the 150 point milestone. He currently ranks tied for 13th on Maine's all-time scoring list with 151 career points...Maine extended its streak to five straight games without allowing a power play goal on Friday, before seeing that streak come to an end of Saturday night...The Black Bears killed off 19 straight opponent power plays in that span...Matt Mangene (Miller Place, N.Y.) scored a goal on Friday night to extend his scoring streak to six games, but that streak ended on Saturday when he was held without a goal. He was just two games shy of tying the school record for consecutive games with a goal.

**MASSACHUSETTS:** UMass is 4-6 over the last 10 games with seven of those contests against teams ranked in the top-11 nationally – two of those wins came on the road...Three of UMass' final four regular-season games will be at the Mullins Center where the Minutemen are 7-3-3 this year including next weekend's pair of games against New Hampshire which sits in 7th place in the Hockey East standings 4-points ahead of UMass...With the split at Maine, UMass is now 6-6-1 against ranked teams which includes a pair of wins against teams ranked No. 1 in the country...UMass holds the season series against the both Vermont and Boston College and split with NU (1-1-1), BU (1-1-1), and Maine (1-1-1)...Over the last 10 games, UMass has been strong on the penalty kill going 47-for-58 (81.0%) including a 5-5 effort vs. Providence and a 6-6 effort vs. BC...UMass has a power play goal in five of the last six games going 6-for-27 (22.2%).

**UMASS-LOWELL:** The River Hawks notched its first 20-win season since 2008-09 and their eighth since the program was elevated to Division I in 1983-84...On Friday, UMass Lowell fell to BU 7-4, but the building was packed with the third largest crowd in program history (6,706). The next night, freshman Scott Wilson scored two goals to lead the River Hawks past BU, 4-2. The win marked UML's first at the Agganis since Oct. 31, 2009. Wilson now has 15 goals on his remarkable rookie campaign, his next goal will match Greg Koehler's freshman season in 1996-97. He is also two points shy of matching Laurent Meunier's 33-point rookie year in 2000-01. Saturday's victory marks the River Hawks' sixth season series win. UML improved to 7-5-0 against Hockey East's "Big Four" (BC, BU, Maine, UNH). The River Hawks have finished with an above .500 record against the "Big Four" just four times since the start of Hockey East, all three seasons UMass Lowell reached the NCAA Tournament. The River Hawks now have two scorers (Wilson, Derek Arnold) with 15 or more goals for just the third time in the last decade (2003-04, 2009-10).

**MERRIMACK:** Merrimack's winless streak slipped to four games after getting swept by Boston College...The Warriors will likely be out of the top-10 nationally for the first time in 17 weeks...Merrimack sits in fifth place, two points behind Maine for fourth and three behind BU for third. They have a game in hand and the season series on Maine...Merrimack lost for just the second time this season in the second game of a back to back. They are 6-2-2 this year...They also slipped to 7-3-3 on Saturday...Barring a playoff matchup at Chestnut Hill, Conte Forum will be the only arena the senior class will not win at in its career...Merrimack did clinch a playoff berth in the Hockey East Tournament for the third straight season despite losing twice over the weekend...Merrimack was on the other side of history against as Jerry York won his 900th career game on Friday. Jack Parker won his 800th career game against Merrimack in 2008.

**NEW HAMPSHIRE:** UNH split a weekend home series with Vermont. The Wildcats finished the 2011-12 home slate with a 9-7-0 record. New Hampshire remains in seventh place in the league standings one point behind sixth place Providence and four points ahead of Northeastern and UMass. All three teams have a game in hand against UNH. The Wildcats will play a critical two game road series at UMass this weekend. On Friday night Stevie Moses handed out his 50th career assist, he now has 95 points in his career. In addition, Eric Knodel matched a career high with a goal and an assist. On Saturday, UNH scored three unanswered goals to capture a 3-1 win over Vermont. Casey DeSmith turned aside 28 of 29 shots in a winning effort on Saturday. Additionally, the UNH power play scored on both nights of the weekend. Head coach Dick Umile captured his 497th win on Saturday night and is looking to become just the sixth active Division I coach with 500 wins and one of 14 all time.

**NORTHEASTERN:** Northeastern and Providence tied on consecutive nights, 1-1 and 2-2, for the first time since 2003-04. It marked the third time in series history that's occurred. On Saturday night, Chris Rawlings eclipsed his old mark of 43 and made a career-high 47 saves to anchor the Huskies' defense in the 2-2 tie. Alex Tuckerman registered his first power play goal of the season while rookie Adam Reid strung together his first-career point streak with an assist and a goal this weekend. Junior Drew Daniels assisted on Tuckerman's PPG in his 100th-career game while junior Garrett Vermeersch scored his first-career game-tying goal in his 100th-career game as a Husky. Northeastern is now unbeaten against Providence in its last five games (2-0-3), marking a program best against any other team in Hockey East.

**PROVIDENCE COLLEGE:** The Friars are on a four-game unbeaten streak (2-0-2), matching their longest this season...The back-to-back ties against Northeastern over the weekend marked the first time since the 2003-04 season (vs. Northeastern) that Providence has played in consecutive draws...The Friars are now 1-2-4 in overtime games this season...Providence's 23 league points this season are eight more than all of last season...The Friars have 11 players with 10 points or more...The 25 power-play goals this season are the most for a Friar team since the 2007-08 squad also had 25...Senior goalie Alex Beaudry played in his 109th game on Saturday, which is tied for second all-time at PC in career games played by a goalie. Beaudry also is 39 saves away from becoming the first Friar to record 3,000 stops...Myles Harvey's 14 points (6g,8a) are the most by a Friar defenseman since Mark Fayne had 22 points (5g,17a) during the 2009-10 season.

**VERMONT:** Saturday marked the 100th all-time meeting between Vermont and New Hampshire, the Catamounts' longest standing rival in men's hockey...Four of H.T. Lenz's five goals this season have been scored against UNH, and two of them have tied the game with less than 1:30 left in the third period...Rob Madore moved into sole possession of sixth place on the all-time wins list at UVM on Friday night with his 41st career victory...14 of the last 19 Vermont goals have been scored by underclassmen...Vermont entered the weekend 0-4-2 in its last six meetings with New Hampshire but snapped that winless streak on Friday...The two schools have now met 14 times in the last three seasons...The Catamounts close the season with four straight games against top-5 teams, with two each against Boston University and Boston College.
