***General Thoughts***

"To get to the Garden we had to go through a pretty difficult opponent in UMass and I think Providence came out the same way they played us. There really was a lot of action with the four goals that were scored in the first period and there were no guarantees. Nate [Leaman] has really had that team improving and playing very very well so that was a pretty good obstacle for us to get through the Friars. I think Johnny's goal in the second period was pretty special and we've seen it during the course of the year. "

***On senior Paul Carey:***

"Paul Carey has been one of our staples right from day one. He has enjoyed a banner senior year, from practices to just being part of the team and there was a push to move him to Colorado last year, the NHL and he decided to stay back. We're so fortunate he did cause he's had an outstanding year for us."

***On how important Brian Dumoulin has been and what he has done to help make the defense and urgency in the second half:***

"I think he's certainly one of the top defensemen to play at the collegiate level and you gotta look at all the different leagues and probably a top defensemen. From my advantage point he has more impact on the game he defends and he's an offensive threat with the puck. He's been a terrific leader for us so we're excited about how well he's playing."

**Paul Carey (Senior, Forward)**

***On the bench's reaction on suddenly trailing in the last two games when BC had been ahead in about 11 games before that:***

"We try not to let it affect us. Parker was still strong in net I know he wanted those back but he played the rest of the game really good we just keep a positive attitude and just keep pushing because it's a long 60 minutes and you don't win in the first period."

***On his goal:***

"I think Pat Mullane (Junior Forward) made a nice play in deep that's what we try to do- try to get the puck down low. I got lucky. There were two Friars, and the puck just ended up on my stick and I just tried to wrap it around and it fell in the back of the cage."
