Milner went 8-0-0 with a 0.88 goals against average and



Held opponents to two goals or fewer in all eight games and held opponents to one goal or fewer six times. Milner was the first goaltender since Cory Schneider in 2006 to post back-to-back shutouts in the NCAA regionals.

Sophomore Goaltender; Hanover, Mass.

Carr went 3-3-0 in six starts for the River Hawks. Totaled a .932 save percentage and 2.27 goals against average, while backstopping UMass Lowell to its first NCAA Tournament win since 1996. Carr allowed two goals or less in three of his six starts.

Gaudreau recorded a team-high 10 points (4g,6a) with a +8 plus/minus rating in eight games. Gaudreau earned Hockey East playoff MVP honors with a tournament-high seven points (3g,4a) in four games. He also tallied two game-winning goals and one power-play goal. Gaudreau tallied at least one point in six of eight games and notched multiple points three times.
