



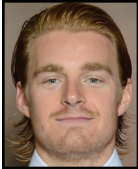

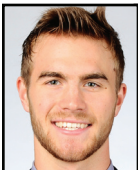

TEAM NOTES

BOSTON COLLEGE: BC has won six straight and 25 of the last 26 games dating into last winter...BC finished 4-for-8 with a man advantage over the weekend. The Eagles are converting 40.0 percent (10-for-25) of their power-play opportunities this season and lead the country in that category...BC is averaging 29 shots per game and its opponents are averaging 29 shots per game...With four power-play goals this season, junior Kevin Hayes leads the country in that category...The team scored seven goals by seven skaters over the weekend, including first career goals from Isaac MacLeod (at Maine) and Michael Matheson (against Massachusetts)...Steven Whitney and Johnny Gaudreau assisted on Matheson's goal to extend each of their scoring streaks to seven games. Whitney now has 90 career points (33g,57a) in 129 games...Senior defenseman Patrick Wey recorded three assists over the weekend and has five assists in eight games this season, matching his single-season career high registered as both a freshman and junior...With two victories this weekend, coach Jerry York has 919 career wins in 41 seasons...Johnny Gaudreau, who scored his third game-winning goal of the season in Friday's 4-2 win at Maine, leads the nation in decisive scores.

BOSTON UNIVERSITY: The Terriers opened up their November and non-conference schedules with a weekend split at No. 6 North Dakota, winning a 4-2 contest on Saturday after falling to UND by the same score on Friday...Saturday's result marked BU's first-ever win in Grand Forks in eight tries (1-6-1)...The victory ended UND's 12-game home unbeaten streak (10-0-2) and it was the first time since March 13, 2010, that it lost a home game in which it held a third-period lead...Freshman Matt O'Connor has won his first four collegiate starts in goal for the Terriers...Senior captain Wade Megan (Canton, N.Y.) has a goal in four of the last five games...Senior Sean Escobedo (Bayside, N.Y.), who has a team-best 17 blocked shots this season, assisted on the game-tying and game-winning goals on Saturday...All nine of BU's freshmen dressed for Friday's series opener in Grand Forks.

MAINE: Maine (1-8-0, 0-4-0) played a pair of top-10 teams on the week... A week after tying his career-high with 39 saves last weekend at Providence, junior goalie Dan Sullivan (York, Pa.) set a career-high with 41 saves on Sunday against New Hampshire...Rookie Will Merchant notched his first career goal on Friday night against Boston College...Connor Leen (Chester, N.Y.) became the first multi-goal scorer on the season when he notched his second on Friday against Boston College...Four Maine rookies have played in all nine games this season.

MASSACHUSETTS: With power-play goals against both UNH and Boston College, the Minutemen now have at least one power play goal in all six games this season, matching the longest streak since Nov.-Dec. 2003 when the squad notched power play tallies in seven straight contests...UMass continued its success in the faceoff circle this past weekend and is now 232-of-414 over the dots this season...Conor Sheary was a perfect 7-0 last Friday against the wildcats, including winning the offensive zone faceoff that set up the OT game-winner...50% of the Minutemen's goals this season have come in non-5x5 situations as seven of the squad's 16 goals thus far have been scored on the power play and one via penalty shot (an opportunity that resulted from a short-handed scoring chance)

UMASS-LOWELL: UMass Lowell will end a 12-day hiatus when it hosts Maine for a pair of games at the Tsongas Center Friday and Saturday. Last year, the River Hawks won both games in Orono (5-3, 4-3) – its first sweep at Maine since 1985 – before the Black Bears exacted revenge in Lowell on Feb. 11 (2-1).

MERRIMACK: Merrimack earned a weekend sweep of #15 Northeastern to give the Warriors the season-series 2-1 over the Huskies. It marked the third straight season that Merrimack has won the season-series over NU...Jordan Heywood and Mike Collins led the way combining for nine points. Heywood followed his first-career two-goal game by scoring the game-winner and adding an assist in Saturday's win...Collins leads Hockey East with 12 points, while Heywood is tied for second overall and first among defenders in scoring with eight points...In fact, Merrimack has three of the league's top four scorers on the blue line (Heywood, Dan Kolomatis (Basking Ridge, N.J.), and Brendan Ellis (Kelowna, B.C.)...For a team that struggled to score last year and lost four of its five top scorers from 2011-12, Merrimack leads Hockey East in scoring, averaging 3.50 goals per game...The Warriors are outscoring their opponents 15-5 in the third period this season...Against Northeastern, Merrimack had five third period goals to Northeastern's one.

NEW HAMPSHIRE: UNH earned a split of a difficult two game road trip this weekend...The Wildcats dropped its first game of the season, 2-1, in overtime at UMass on Friday night and bounced back with a convincing 4-0 win at Maine on Sunday afternoon...New Hampshire's 5-1-1 start is the best since the 2007-08 season when the 'Cats had a matching 5-1-1 mark through seven games...On Friday night, Greg Burke put UNH ahead 1-0 after one, but a second period goal and an overtime power play tally lifted UMass past the Wildcats...Sunday's 4-0 win over the Black Bears was the team's first win since Dec. 10, 2010, while it was the first shutout at Maine since Jan. 17, 1998...Casey DeSmith stopped a season-high 42 shots en route to his second shutout of the season and third of his career...DeSmith posted 0.97 GAA and a .974 save percentage during the weekend. Overall, he stopped 76-of-78 shots on the weekend. DeSmith ranks first in Hockey East in GAA 1.54m save percentage .947 and is first in league play in those categories as well with a 1.17 GAA and a .962 save percentage...Austin Block netted a pair of goals including the game-winner on the power play. He ranks first in Hockey East in goal scoring with five goals in seven games...Connor Hardowa notched a pair of assists on Sunday against Maine. He now has eight assists in seven games and ranks first in Hockey East and sixth nationally in assists per game. Additionally, Hardowa ranks sixth nationally in defensive scoring at 1.14 gpg.

NORTHEASTERN: On Friday night at home against Merrimack, newcomer Kevin Roy notched his second-career multi-point game with a goal and an assist to overtake the team points lead (3-2-5). Roy's first two-point game also occurred against Merrimack in the season opener on Oct. 10. Sophomore assistant captain Ludwig Karlsson curbed his scoreless draught and scored his first goal since the outing at Boston University last season on March 2, 2012. Karlsson also secured an assist, marking his first multi-point game since playing at Vermont on Jan. 27. Senior goaltender Bryan Mountain started in net on Friday, earning his first consecutive starts for NU since Dec. 4-5, 2009. The following night at Merrimack, senior captain Vinny Saponari tallied his first goal since netting the game winner last season against Boston University in the final contest of the year. In that same game, newcomer Mike McMurtry scored his first collegiate goal and added an assist on Saponari's marker to post his first-career multi-point game as a Husky.

PROVIDENCE COLLEGE: With freshman Tom Parisi making his career debut, the Friar lineup featured nine freshmen on Saturday night at Vermont...With their 3-2 win on Friday, the Friars won their third in a row (all in Hockey East play) and posted their first road win of the season (which was also Jon Gillies' first career road win)...Prior to Friday's night's win, the last time the Friars won three straight games that were all in Hockey East play was in January of 2010 when Providence downed UMass Lowell (4-2 on Jan. 10), Boston University (4-2 on Jan. 13) and UMass (5-4 on Jan. 16)...Friday's win was the fourth in a row for the Friars over the Catamounts, which had only happened one other time in the all-time series (when Providence won four straight meetings from Jan. 20, 1980 - Nov. 13, 1982)...With freshman Brandon Tanev netting the first goal and assist of his career and Derek Army netting his first goal of the season on Friday, 14 different Friars have now scored at least one goal on the year and 18 Friars have notched at least one point.

VERMONT: Friday vs. Providence was "Jack Lyman Day" as the team dedicated the game to their new Team IMPACT teammate Jack Lyman, a 14-year-old from Shelburne, Vt. Jack was involved in a pre-game puck drop ceremony at center ice and his name appeared on the roster of the weekend program. Team IMPACT is a non-profit organization which improves the quality of life for children across the northeast who are facing life-threatening illnesses...Jacob Fallon picked up his first career goal in a Catamount jersey on Friday...Tobias Nilsson-Roos skated in his 90th career game, while Chris McCarthy played in his 80th career contest...Saturday night marked the 50th all-time meeting between Vermont and Providence...Nick Bruneteau skated in his 75th career game on Saturday, while Matt White played in his 70th career contest...Freshman forward Ryan Rosenthal made his Catamount debut on Saturday...Vermont entered the Saturday contest ranked 11th in the nation on the power play at 23.5%...UVM has had 10 different scorers on its 10 goals this season...The Cats blocked 18 shots in the win and had nine different players block at least one shot...Vermont allowed just seven shots on goal in the first 40 minutes of the win over Providence on Saturday.
