



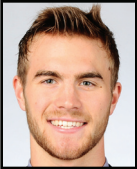

MICHAEL COLANTONE, UML (CAVE CREEK, ARIZ.)

Has three goals in his last four contests

MIKE COLLINS, MERRIMACK (BOSTON, MASS.)

Has 18 points in his last 13 games

KEVIN GOUMAS, UNH (LONG BEACH, N.Y.)

Is riding a 10-game point streak with 19 points (7g,12a).

He has points in 13-of-15 games this season

JOHN HENRION, UNH (HOLDEN, MASS.)

Has four points in the last three games with a pair of goals and assists and 19 shots on net in those three games

SEAN MAGUIRE, BU (POWELL RIVER, B.C.)

Is the first BU goalie to post back-to-back shutouts since John Curry in February of 2007

WADE MEGAN, BU (CANTON, N.Y.)

Played in his 100th consecutive game on Thursday at UNH

TOBIAS NILSSON-ROOS, VERMONT (MALMO, SWEDEN)

His next game played will be his 100th career

GARRETT NOONAN, BU (NORFOLK, MASS.)

His goal vs. Maine extended point streak to five games (1g,4a)

YVAN PATTYN, VERMONT (ST. ANNE, MAN.)

Scored three goals in last three games

NICK SARACINO, PC (ST. LOUIS, MO.)

Scored his first goal with game-tying tally vs. BC Friday

UNH PENALTY KILL

Has killed off 34-straight opponent power play opportunities. Overall, the 'Cats rank second nationally at 96.3% (52-54)

VERMONT PENALTY KILL

Has killed off 48 of the last 54 opponent power plays (88.9%)

SCOTT WILSON, UML (OAKVILLE, ONT.)

Has 10 points (1g,9a) in his last five games

TEAM NOTES

BOSTON COLLEGE: BC concluded the first half of the season at 11-2-1 and 9-2-1 in league play...The Eagles will have a 22-day break between for exams and Christmas before returning to action against Alabama-Huntsville at the Mariucci Classic in Minneapolis, Minn. on Dec. 29...The tie at Providence snapped a 12-game BC win streak against the Friars but extended the team's unbeaten streak against Providence to 17 games (14-0-3)...Senior forward Steven Whitney leads all BC players with a +16 rating through 14 games this season...Senior captain Pat Mullane extended his scoring stream to seven games during which he has registered 10 points – four goals and seven assists; Mullane ranks among the nation's leaders in points per game (9th; 1.36) and assists per game (tied-9th; 0.86)...With 23 points (11g,12a) in 14 games, sophomore forward Johnny Gaudreau ranks among the nation's leaders in points per game (2nd; 1.64), goals per game (2nd; 0.79), assists per game (tied-9th; 0.86) and game-winning goals (1st; five)...BC coach Jerry York is now 924-559-95 in his 41-year coaching career and is tied with Ron Mason for the most victories in NCAA hockey history.

BOSTON UNIVERSITY: The Terriers are 3-0-1 their last four times they have faced a UNH squad that was No. 1 in the rankings...BU enters the semester break having won seven of its last 10 games with the three losses coming against the teams currently ranked first (BC) and second (UNH) in the country. However, BU has a win against each of them during the stretch...Senior Sean Escobedo has a league-best 44 blocked shots and his d-partner, sophomore Alex Privitera, ranks second with 43...BU has allowed two or fewer goals in each of its 10 victories this season...Sophomore Cason Hohmann (Arlington, Texas) has a team-best 16 points, exactly twice as many as he had his entire rookie year...Over his last three starts, goaltender Sean Maguire has recorded a 0.67 goals-against average and a .975 save percentage...The team's sophomores hold a slim 36-35 lead over the freshmen in the race for scoring by class...The Terriers have given up two shorthanded goals in their last 50 regular-season games...BU's last two 1-0 home victories have both been against Maine, as Saturday's result was the first of its kind since a 1-0 overtime triumph versus the Black Bears on Feb. 16, 2008...BU's defensemen combined to tally 44 points (13g, 31a) in the 15 games during the first half.

MAINE: Maine dropped a 1-0 decision to Boston University in its lone game of the week...Goaltender Martin Ouellette (St.-Hippolyte, Quebec) stopped 20 shots in goal for the Black Bears to earn the third star of the game... He even stopped a BU penalty shot late in the second period... It was the fifth time in the last six games that Ouellette has been named one of the game's three stars. Ouellette has started a career-high six straight games for the Black Bears...Maine saw its streak of three straight games scoring a power play goal snapped on Saturday when it failed to convert against Boston University...Maine entered the game on Saturday having killed off 16-of-18 opponent power plays...After playing 14 straight games without taking a penalty, rookie defenseman Ben Hutton (Prescott, Ont.) was whistled for his first career penalty on Saturday night...Maine will now have a 19-day break before returning to action in the 2012 Florida College Classic.

MASSACHUSETTS: After ending a 30-game goal scoring draught last weekend at Northeastern, junior Adam Phillips scored in his second and third straight contests this past weekend against Colgate. On Saturday against the Raiders, Phillips had a four-point night with a goal and three assists for a career high, the first four-point game for a Minuteman this season...Junior Branden Gracel scored his sixth and seventh goals of the season in the weekend series vs. Colgate to already equal his career best for a single season. He finished his sophomore with seven goals and 14 assists for 21 points in 34 games...Junior Joel Hanley logged his third multi-point night in the past five games with a goal and an assist in Friday's meeting with the Raiders.

UMASS-LOWELL: Freshman G Connor Hellebuyck, who stopped all 25 shots in Saturday's 2-0 victory over Northeastern, has halted 55 of 57 shots on goal (.965) in his last three appearances...Sophomore Scott Wilson has 1-9-10 in his last five games...UMass Lowell has killed off 14 of opponents last 15 power plays, including eight straight...Freshman F Michael Colantone has three goals in his last four games...Three River Hawks – Scott Wilson, Terrence Wallin and Jake Suter – made their 50th appearances for UMass Lowell with Saturday's home game against Northeastern...Ten UMass Lowell players have at least four points.

MERRIMACK: Merrimack overcame a 2-0 deficit to tie #20 Harvard 2-2 Friday...Rhett Bly (Regina, Sask.) and Mike Collins scored in the second for the Warriors...Bly's goal was shorthanded and was Merrimack's first shorthanded goal in exactly one year since Jeff Velleca scored on 12/7/11 against Vermont...Merrimack had a five-minute power play in overtime but failed to convert...It marked the first time ever that Harvard played at Lawler Arena...With the tie, Merrimack is 1-0-2 against ECAC teams this year and 3-21 against ranked teams...Merrimack is in the midst of its longest home winless streak since January of 2009 and is 0-3-2 in its last five at Lawler...Collins now has 18 points in his last 13 games with points of 12 of 13 and is fourth in Hockey East in scoring...In Saturday's 3-1 defeat to the U.S. Under-18 National Team, Nick Drew (Andover, Mass.) made his first career start and nine stops on 11 shots in 20 minutes of action. Drew has played just over two minutes in his collegiate career.

NEW HAMPSHIRE: The Wildcats ascended to the number 1 spot both college hockey national polls for the first time since Jan. 29, 2007...UNH saw its eight-game unbeaten streak come to an end of Thursday night as the seventh-ranked BU Terriers jumped out to a 3-0 lead and held off a late surge in a 3-2 win at Whittemore Center. It was the team's first loss in over a month and the first home loss of the season...The Wildcats return to action on Sunday, Dec. 30 (7 p.m.) at Dartmouth College for game one of the Ledyard National Bank Classic. The Big Green are off to one of their best starts in program history at 7-2-2 and are ranked 10th nationally. This will put even more pressure on the game for New Hampshire hockey bragging rights...The Wildcats will play either UMass or Bemidji State the following night...The Wildcats were four-of-four on the penalty kill and have now killed off 34-straight opponent power plays dating back to Nov. 2 against UMass. Overall, the 'Cats rank second nationally with a 96.3% kill rate (52-54) with four shorthanded goals this season.

NORTHEASTERN: On Saturday, Dec. 8, Northeastern closed out the 2012 Hockey East portion of its schedule with a 2-0 loss at UMass Lowell. The Huskies have been shut out at Lowell the last two trips to the Tsongas Center. On Saturday, Connor Hellebuyck shutout NU in just his third-career start with 27 stops. Newcomer Kevin Roy registered a team-high five shots on net in the setback. Senior goaltender is now just 165 saves shy of tying Brad Thiessen for second place all-time in the Northeastern hockey annals. Rawlings has stopped 3,101-of-3,381 shots throughout his career. Thiessen's mark of 3,166 is well off Northeastern record holder Bruce Racine. Racine is NU's career record holder with 3,557 saves all-time.

PROVIDENCE COLLEGE: Schneider Arena was sold out for the first time since Feb. 24, 2012 (also against Boston College) ... Jon Gillies made his 15th consecutive start in goal...The last time that Providence and Boston College played to a tie was on Jan. 30, 2009 at Schneider Arena (2-2 final) ...Providence snapped a 12-game losing streak against the Eagles...The last overtime game between the two teams was on Feb. 28, 2009 when BC defeated Providence, 4-3...Derek Army now has seven points in his last six games...Nick Saracino scored his first collegiate point, with his first collegiate goal. Saracino became the 17th Friar to score a goal this season...Tim Schaller now has a three-game point streak...The Friar PK unit held BC to a 1-for-6 mark (16.7%) while on the power-play (entered the game No. 1 in the nation at 28.6%). Saracino's goal with 10 seconds to play was Providence's third game-tying goal scored with under a minute to play in a game this season (Acciari netted a game-tying goal at Miami with 48 seconds to play on Oct. 20 to send the game to OT and Schaller netted the game-winning goal at Merrimack on Nov. 30 with 37 seconds to play in overtime).

VERMONT: Vermont and Dartmouth met for the 75th time in the all-time series on Wednesday...The two schools have met every year since 1977...The Catamounts and Big Green were travel partners in the ECAC before UVM joined Hockey East prior to the 2005-06 season...Each of the last 11 meetings in the series have been decided by two goals or less...The Catamounts had won four straight meetings before Wednesday's 4-2 loss on the road...Tobias Nilsson-Roos skated in his 99th career game, while Brett Bruneteau played in his 75th contest...Yvan Pattyn collected his first career multi-goal game on Wednesday with a pair of tallies and has now scored three goals in his last three games...Ben Albertson and Mike Montagna picked up their first points of the season with assists ...The Catamounts wrapped up a stretch of eight games in 20 days on Wednesday and don't play again until they visit St. Lawrence on Saturday, Dec. 15th.
