**#26 BRANDEN GRACEL, MASSACHUSETTS** (Junior Forward; Calgary, Alta.)

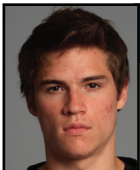

## TEAM NOTES

**BOSTON COLLEGE:** With two goals, senior Steven Whitney has 101 career points and joins his older brother, Joe Whitney, who recorded 142 points in 160 games from 2007-11, in Boston College's 100-point scoring club. The Whitneys the second set of 100-point-scoring siblings to play under the direction of head coach second set of 100-point-scoring siblings to play under Jerry York, joining Ben and Patrick Eaves. In addition to the Eaves', the Whitneys will also join another family, Doug Brown and assistant coach Greg Brown – in the 100-point-scoring sibling fraternity...The teams victory over UAH marked career win No. 925 for head coach Jerry York, who has surpassed Ron Mason to become college hockey's all-time wins leader...BC is without sophomore left wing Johnny Gaudreau who is representing the U.S. at the World Junior Championship in Russia. Gaudreau's selection marks the fifth straight season – and the 17th time in the last 18 years – that a Boston College player competed in the World Junior Championship. He joins current teammates Bill Arnold and Patrick Wey, both WJC participants in years past.

**BOSTON UNIVERSITY:** The Terriers opened up their second half with a visit to the Rocky Mountain State to take on then-No. 15 Denver in the U.S. Hockey Hall of Fame Game and dropped a 6-0 contest to the Pioneers...The result ended BU's streak of 125 straight games without being shut out – the longest such streak in the country – as Minnesota at 62 now lays stake to that claim...Junior Garrett Noonan (Norfolk, Mass.) has been named an assistant captain for the remainder of the season, as the Denver game was his first with an 'A' on his jersey...The Terriers have gone 14 months without having one of their games result in a tie, as the team's last draw occurred on Oct. 28, 2011, at UMass...Freshman Sean Maguire (Powell River, B.C.) is currently on a shutout skein of 131:19 and is the first goaltender in BU history to earn a shutout in each of his first two home starts...The Terriers played nine games against ranked opponents in the 2012 portion of its schedule but currently have no ranked squads on the remainder of their regular-season slate, except for a possible match-up with Boston College in the second round of the Beanpot.

**MAINE:** Maine won its second straight Florida College Classic Title with a 6-4 win over Cornell on Saturday night...The Black Bears becomes the first team in the 13-year history of the tournament to win back-to-back titles...Kyle Beattie was named the Shawn Walsh Most Valuable Player of the Tournament, while Devin Shore (Ajax, Ont.) and Matt Morris were each named to the All-Tournament Team...The Black Bears scored a season-high six goals in the title game and overcame a 3-0 deficit with five straight goals... Maine earned a 1-0 victory over Minnesota Duluth in the tournament opener to advance to the title game...The Minnesota Duluth game was a rematch of the 2012 NCAA Regional game against the two teams...Martin Ouellette (St.-Hippolyte, Que.) earned his second career shutout in the game...The two-goal win broke a streak of seven straight one-goal games or ties played in by the Black Bears...Maine is now 3-1-0 in games played on neutral ice this season...Eleven different Black Bears tallied at least a point in the Saturday night...Maine scored two power play goals on Saturday against Cornell, the first time this season that it has had more than one in a game.

**MASSACHUSETTS:** UMass defeated Bemidji State and #8 Dartmouth to capture the Ledyard Classic championship the first tournament title for the Minutemen since winning the Lightning College Hockey Tournament in 2007...Branden Gracel was named to the Ledyard Classic MVP and Kevin Boyle was tabbed the Goaltender of the Tournament, while Eddie Olczyk also earned all-tournament honors after snapping a 53-game scoreless streak with a shorthanded goal...UMass has now faced the top-three penalty units in the country (UNH, Dartmouth, Quinnipiac) and has gone a combined 4-for-16 (25%) on the power play against them. The Minutemen snapped Dartmouth's streak of 32 consecutive kills.

**UMASS-LOWELL:** UMass Lowell improved to 4-1 against non-conference opponents with Sunday's 3-2 victory over Bentley, in which sophomore Stephen Buco and freshman Ryan McGrath scored goals 11 seconds apart in the third period for the win. The River Hawks close out their non-conference schedule this weekend with a pair of games at Clarkson...UMass Lowell killed off both Bentley power plays to extend its penalty kill streak to 15 straight and 21 of opponents last 22...UMass Lowell's goal following consecutive losses to New Hampshire was to end the year at .500, and defeated Northeastern (2-0), Harvard (5-0) and Bentley (3-2) to do so...Sophomore Scott Wilson, who had a goal taken away in the first minute of the third period in the win over Bentley, had a six-game point streak snapped in the win.

**MERRIMACK:** Back on the ice after a 19-day layoff, Merrimack tied Princeton 2-2 before falling to #13/12 Union 4-1 at the Catamount Cup...Merrimack completed non-conference play with a 2-4-3 record, its worst record in non-conference game since 2006-07...The Warriors led Union 1-0 entering the third only to fall after being whistled for three straight minors. Merrimack had been 48-1-3 since 2009 when leading when entering the third period...Merrimack faced Union for the second time this season, marking the first time they played a non-conference team twice in separate venues in the same season since playing Dartmouth on 12/15/01 and 12/28/01. The Warriors defeated Union 4-1 to open the season in NY...Merrimack has at least two games in hand on every team above them in the league standings...The Warriors will bring a 10-game unbeaten streak (8-0-2) against Vermont into the game.

**NEW HAMPSHIRE:** UNH went 1-1-0 this week at the Ledyard National Bank Classic in Dartmouth...The Wildcats dropped Sunday's first round game against Dartmouth 4-1 and bounced back with a 3-2 overtime win over Bemidji State in the third-place game on Monday afternoon...Trevor van Riemsdyk netted the game-winning goal at 2:08 of overtime...UNH owns the nation's top penalty kill at 94.9 percent...Grayson Downing is first in the nation in short-handed goals with three...Kevin Goumas is first in Hockey East in points with 25, while his 1.47 ppg ranks fourth in the nation...Austin Block scored his 10th goal of the season in UNH's 4-1 loss at Dartmouth. Block had just 10 goals combined in his first three seasons at UNH. Additionally, all of last season the Wildcats had just two players with 10-plus goals: Stevie Moses (22) and Grayson Downing (10). He is one of just two players in the league with 10-plus goals joining BC's Johnny Gaudreau...UNH is 4-0-1 against the WCHA this season with wins over SCSU (2) and Denver and a tie at CC.

**NORTHEASTERN:** Saturday night marked Northeastern's first win in six trips to Harvard and its first since Jan. 12, 1978, when the Huskies won, 14-5. The game also marked the Huskies first journey to the Bright Hockey Center since Dec. 19, 1999. Cody Ferriero has now scored two natural hat tricks (three consecutive goals) twice in his two and half year career as a Husky. Ferriero also scored three-straight tallies at Vermont on Jan. 27, 2012. Ferriero's three power play goals in one period marks the first time that has happened in the NCAA all season long. It's the first time a Husky has scored four goals in a game since Dave Poile on Jan. 24, 1970 against Army...In addition to Ferriero's heroics, Kevin Roy's five-point performance (1-4-5) marks the first time a Husky's scored five points in a game since both Mike Morris (2-4-6) and Jason Guerriero (2-3-5) turned the trick against Massachusetts on March 5, 2005. The last time a Husky notched four assists in one game happened on Dec. 2, 2011, at Notre Dame (Ludwig Karlsson). Cody Ferriero owns just the third four-goal game across the entire NCAA this season.

**PROVIDENCE COLLEGE:** In Providence's 4-4 tie with Vermont, freshman Steven McParland netted Providence's first short-handed goal of the year...With two assists, senior Tim Schaller extended his point streak to four games (2-4-6)...Senior Russ Stein (Ridgefield, Conn.) made his first career start, recorded his third career appearance and had a career high 28 saves in the tie with UVM...The Friars have now played five overtime games this season, including two in a row (they are 1-1-3 in the five overtime games)...The Friars are now 7-1-1 on the year when scoring three or more goals and 3-0-1 when scoring at least four goals...Jon Gillies' streak of 15 consecutive starts in the Friar net to open the year was broken due to his U.S. World Junior Team participation...Derek Army has eight points over the last eight games (4-4-8).

**VERMONT:** Vermont captured the annual Sheraton/TD Bank Catamount Cup for the third time in the last five seasons and the fourth time overall with wins over No. 12 Union (2-1) and Princeton (6-3) over the weekend...Vermont has scored 17 goals during its four-game unbeaten streak (3-0-1)...The line of Anthony DeCenzo, Kyle Mountain, and Ryan Rosenthal combined for five points against Princeton...The Catamounts were contending for the Catamount Cup title on day two of the event for the sixth time in the last eight years...UVM is 13-4-1 in the Catamount Cup under Kevin Sneddon...Jacob Fallon was named the MVP of the tournament as he posted a goal and an assist on Sunday, while Robert Polesello and Brett Bruneteau were also named to the All-Tournament Team...Chris McCarthy has posted nine points over his last eight contests...Kyle Reynolds has six points in his last four games...The Cats are now 5-0-2 when leading after two periods this season.
