NBCSN AND HOCKEY EAST SIGN MULTI-YEAR EXTENSION

~ NBCSN Will Televisе an average of Six Hockey East Games Annually ~

~ NBCSN's Live Coverage of Hockey East Begins on October 25 at 8 p.m. ET with Massachusetts at Maine ~

STAMFORD, Conn. - NBCSN and Hockey East announced a two-year extension to their national television rights agreement today. Beginning with the upcoming 2013-14 college hockey season and continuing through the 2014-15 season, NBCSN will annually televise an average of six Hockey East games and a minimum of 12 regular-season games over the next two years. The network's coverage of Hockey East begins on Friday, October 25 at 8 p.m. ET when Massachusetts travels to Alford Arena in Orono, Maine to take on Maine.

As part of the agreement, Boston University will appear three times on NBCSN and Massachusetts will appear twice. No. 4 Boston College, New Hampshire and Maine will also play games on the network this season.

NBCSN's 2013-14 Hockey East schedule includes Northeastern at No. 4 Boston College on Friday, November 1 at 8 p.m. ET, North Dakota at Boston University on Friday, November 22 at 7:30 p.m. ET, Boston University at Massachusetts on Friday, January 31 at 7:30 p.m. ET, and Boston University at New Hampshire on Friday, February 14 at 7 p.m. ET.

"We are delighted to renew our relationship with NBCSN, whose commitment to showcase both amateur and professional hockey is unparalleled," said Hockey East Commissioner Joe Bertagna. "Hockey East embraces and values this partnership at a time when college hockey is experiencing seismic changes across the country."

"We are pleased to continue our relationship with Hockey East and deliver live coverage of five Hockey East regular season games," said Jon Miller, President, Programming NBC Sports and NBCSN. "With this renewal, Hockey East will continue to provide quality content for NBCSN across the next two college hockey seasons."

Dave Strader and Dave Goucher, will split play-by-play duties for NBCSN's coverage of Hockey East. Ken Hodge will serve as an analyst for all Hockey East games on NBCSN.

NBCSN will televise more than 25 college hockey games this season. A complete list of the 2013-14 NBCSN college hockey schedule is forthcoming.
