BC'S JOHNNY GAUDREAU TABBED AS PLAYER OF THE MONTH

- PC's Jon Gillies, UML's Connor Hellebuyck share Top Goalie; BC's Ryan Fitzgerald named Top Rookie -

Warrior Hockey Player of the Month Johnny Gaudreau – Boston College



Gaudreau scored a point in every game in the month of November, factoring 17 points (9g,8a) and 39 shots on goal (4.3 spg) during that stretch. The Carneys Point, N.J., native had a plus rating in every game except two, finishing with a +11 rating in November. He tallied a pair of game-winning goals and his first-ever short-handed goal against Northeastern on Nov. 1. He registered four multi-point efforts for the Eagles and was named Warrior Hockey Player of the Week on Nov. 11 for his seven-point (3g,4a) week vs. BU and Army.

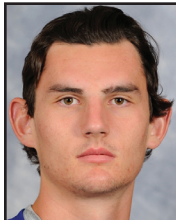

Stop It Co-Goaltender of the Month Jon Gillies – Providence College



Gillies went 7-1-1 in November with a 1.85 GAA and a .942 save percentage. Gillies, who made 294 saves in the month, recorded a pair of shutouts at Merrimack and at Vermont to become PC's all-time leader in career shutouts with eight. He also turned in a 45-save performance at No. 5 Quinnipiac on Nov. 27.

Connor Hellebuyck – UMass Lowell

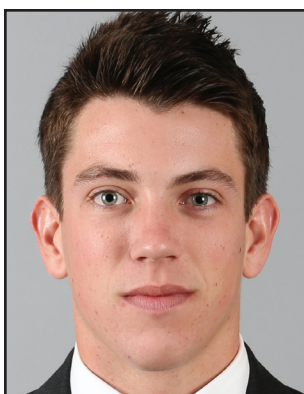


Hellebuyck went 4-1-0 with a 1.41 GAA and a .959 save percentage with two shutouts during the month of November including consecutive shutouts. His 179:21 scoreless streak in the month was the third longest in school history. Hellebuyck bested three Hockey East foes during the month including consecutive wins over No. 6 ranked Notre Dame at the Tsongas Center.

Pro Ambitions Rookie of the Month Ryan Fitzgerald – Boston College



Fitzgerald a league-high 11 points (6g,5a) among rookies in nine games in the month for the Eagles, helping the team to a 6-2-1 record. He notched 27 shots on goal (3.0 spg) with a +7 plus/minus rating in November. Fitzgerald registered a point in eight of the nine games, posted two multiple point performances. Fitzgerald was named Pro Ambitions Rookie of the Week in November 4th for his two goals in the series sweep of Northeastern.
