- Boston College leading scorer Johnny Gaudreau (Carneys Point, N.J.) is the only player in Division I with 30 goals this season, and he has ten more points (64) than any other skater in the country.

- The Irish enter this weekend 6-0-1 in their last seven games, including a 2-1 overtime win at BC on Mar. 1, when freshman Vince Hinostroza (Bartlett, III.) netted the GWG 1:56 into the extra frame.

- UML begins their title defense against their final regular season opponent, Vermont. Connor Hellebuyck (Commerce, Mich.) made 25 saves against UVM on Feb. 28 for his tenth career shutout. Vermont is looking to get back to the TD Garden for the first time since 2010, when they upset league regular season champion UNH in the quarterfinals, winning 1.0 in both games two and three.


