Boston University's Jack Eichel Named Warrior Hockey Player of the Month River Hawks' Smith Claims Rookie Honors; Providence's Gillies Named Best Goaltender



Warrior Hockey Player of the Month **Jack Eichel – Boston University**

Forward; North Chelmsford, Massachusetts

Eichel continued an impressive start to his career, scoring at least one point in each of the Terriers first six games of November and appearing on the scoresheet in seven of nine contests. The 6-2, 190 pound freshman scored the overtime winner and chipped in an assist in a 3-2 victory over Maine on Nov. 21 in one of five multi-point efforts in the month. Eichel led all Hockey East players in points (13), assists (9) and plus/minus (+7) in November en route to helping Boston University climb to the No. 1 ranking.

Pro Ambitions Rookie of the Month **C.J. Smith - UMass Lowell**

Forward; Des Moines, Iowa

In eight games in November, Smith notched nine points on four goals and five assists to help lead the No. 7 River Hawks to a 4-2-2 record on the month. Two of Smith's four tallies came on the power play. The Des Moines, Iowa native logged a point in seven and an even or plus rating in six contests while firing an average of 3.3 shots on net per game. Twice Smith recorded multi-point efforts, first on Nov. 14 against Penn State (1g, 1a) and then against then-No. 18 Harvard on Nov. 29 (2g).

Stop It Goaltender of the Month **Jon Gillies - Providence College**

Junior; South Portland, Maine

Gillies collected a 5-2-0 record over seven games in November, posting a nation-leading three shutouts. His 0.86 goals against average and .973 save percentage were tops in the NCAA for the month. In 417:18 of work, he kicked out 216 shots, allowing just six goals. He ended the month with back-to-back shutout performances to increase his shutout streak to 161:24. On Nov. 29, he posted 43 saves against then No. 11 Boston College to help the Friars to a 1-0 win.
