NESN Tabs Boston University at Northeastern as February 28 Flex Game Viewers to See Top-Ranked Terriers Take on Huskies in Historic Matthews Arena

WAKEFIELD, Mass. - The New England Sports Network (NESN) announced today that the Saturday, Feb. 28 contest between No. 2 Boston University and Northeastern University game will be broadcast live on NESN and NESNplus.

Coverage of the game will begin at 8:00 p.m. on NESNplus before NESN picks up the action upon the conclusion of the Boston Bruins postgame show. Following the Hockey East matchup at Northeastern's Matthews Arena, Hockey East Overtime LIVE will air on NESN.

The game will take place on the final day of the Hockey East regular-season schedule and will mark the third time the Terriers and Huskies will meet in just five days, as the two programs will clash Monday, Feb. 23 for the 63rd Beanpot championship and Friday, Feb. 27 at Boston University. The Beanpot final will also air live on NESN.

ABOUT HOCKEY EAST: The Hockey East Association is a 12-team Division I college men's hockey conference founded in 1984 and an eight team Division I women's league which began play in 2002-03. The men's league has won eight NCAA championships in the past 21 years. Since 1999, Hockey East has won six NCAA Championships with 13 NCAA Championship Game appearances, while placing 21 teams in the Frozen Four and 52 teams in the NCAA Tournament during that time.
