Boston University's Evan Rodrigues Named Warrior Hockey Player of the Month Minutemen's Montour Claims Rookie Honors; Northeastern's Roy Takes Best Goalie



Warrior Hockey Player of the Month Evan Rodrigues - Boston University Forward; Etobicoke, Ontario

Rodrigues continued his strong senior campaign as he tied for the national lead in points during the month of January, racking up 18 points on four goals and 14 assists. He notched at least one point in each of the eight games Boston University played, helping push David Quinn's squad to the number two spot in the national polls. Rodrigues wrapped January in spectacular fashion, scoring a Hockey East record six assists, including five in the third period, as he helped spark the Terriers to a 9-5 come-from-behind victory over Massachusetts Jan. 30.

Pro Ambitions Rookie of the Month Brandon Montour - Massachusetts Defenseman; Ohsweken, Ontario

Montour lead the Minutemen with 10 points (2g, 8a) and four multi-point outings in eight games over the course of January, his first full month with Massachusetts. The rookie collected seven of his points on special teams units, including four (1g, 3a) on the power play and three (1g, 2a) while shorthanded. Despite appearing in just 11 games this season, he sits eighth in scoring in the NCAA among freshmen with 12 points (2g, 10a).

Stop It Goaltender of the Month Derek Roy - Northeastern Sophomore; Lac-Beauport, Quebec

Roy compiled an unblemished 4-0-1 record in January, including wins over then-No.19 Yale and at then-No. 9 Vermont. The second-year netminder stopped allowed just nine goals to collect a 1.77 goals against average and .933 save percentage, tops in the league during the month for goaltenders who played at least 50 percent of his team's total minutes. Despite going winless in its first nine games of the season, Northeastern has since gone 11-3-3 thanks in part to the play of Roy and his batterymate Clay Witt.
