## BU Boasts Player, Rookie of the Month in Rodrigues and Eichel UNH Freshman Tirone Tabbed as Top Goaltender After Leading Wildcats to TD Garden



### Warrior Hockey Player of the Month **Evan Rodrigues - Boston University** Senior Forward; Etobicoke, Ontario

Rodrigues leads the nation in scoring since January, scoring 14 goals and 23 assists for 37 points in 18 games in 2015. In the month of March, Rodrigues has lead the charge for the Terriers as BU enters the Frozen Four, scoring four goals and eight assists en route to claiming the Hockey East Tournament and NCAA Northeast Regional crowns. His 12 points in the postseason tie for the lead among Hockey East skaters with teammate Jack Eichel. His 2.00 points per game in March also rank tied for first in the nation over that span. In the Northeast Regional, Rodrigues assisted on the overtime strike that sent BU into the finals, before netting two goals in the title game, including the game-winner. He was named Most Outstanding Player of the Northeast Region and to the Hockey East All-Tournament Team for his efforts.

### Pro Ambitions Rookie of the Month **Jack Eichel - Boston University** Forward; North Chelmsford, Massachusetts

Eichel helped lead Boston University to its 22nd Frozen Four and eighth Hockey East Tournament title in the month of March, pacing the Terriers with six goals and six assists for 12 points in six contests. Eichel tied for the lead among all skaters with 11 points (6g, 5a) in the Hockey East Tournament and was named to the All-Tournament Team and honored as the Tournament MVP for his role in helping BU capture the tournament crown. The rookie center tied for the nation's lead with 2.00 points per game and a plus-13 rating in March and was named a Hobey Hat Trick finalist for the Hobey Baker Award on April 2 as he seeks to become the first freshman to win the award since Paul Kariya in 1993.

### Stop It Goaltender of the Month **Danny Tirone - New Hampshire** Freshman; Trumbull, Connecticut

Tirone backboned New Hampshire to its second consecutive appearance in the Hockey East semifinals at TD Garden in his rookie campaign, after joining the Wildcats for the second semester in 2015. After sweeping UConn in two games at home, including a 2-0 shutout, Tirone won two 2-1 overtime contests on the road at Providence in the Hockey East Quarterfinals. He allowed just nine goals in 378:01 of work during the month, racking up a 1.44 goals against average and .950 save percentage.
