Tiebreakers:

1. Head-to-Head.

2. Number of wins in conference play.

3. Best record against the first-place team(s), then the second-place team(s), then the third-place team(s), and so on.

4. Coin Flip.

Note: If more than two teams finish in a tie, the same criteria will be applied to reduce the number of teams tied, and then the process will commence again.

Potential Two-Way Tiebreakers:

UMass Lowell won the season series with Boston College, 2-0-0. Boston University won the season series with Providence, 1-0-1. Providence tied the season series with Vermont, 1-1-0.

- Providence wins tie breaker at 25 points with more wins in league play or at 26 points with a better record against first or second seed UMass Lowell. Both Providence and

Vermont went 0-1-1 against Notre Dame.

Northeastern won the season series with Merrimack, 2-0-0.

UConn tied the season series with Merrimack, 0-0-2.

- UConn wins the tie breaker at 20 points with more wins in league play. New Hampshire won the season series with Merrimack, 1-0-1.

UConn leads the season series with New Hampshire, 1-0-0, with one game left.

- UConn wins the season series with New Hampshire, 1-0-1, at 19 points. Otherwise, teams cannot finished tied.

Potential Three-Way Tiebreakers:

1. UML 2. BC 3. ND

UMass Lowell is 3-1-0 combined against Boston College and Notre Dame, is first seed. Notre Dame and Boston College split the season series, 1-1-0. Boston College finished regular season with 13 wins in leage play, Notre Dame finished with 12 wins in league play. Boston College is second seed, Notre Dame is third seed.

1. UML 2. BU 3. BC

UMass Lowell is 3-1-0 combined against Boston College and Boston University. Boston University is 3-1-0 combined against Boston College and UMass Lowell. Boston College is 0-4-0 against Boston University and UMass Lowell, is the third seed. UMass Lowell and Boston University split the season series, 1-1-0.

UMass Lowell is first seed with 14 wins in league play. Boston University is second seed with 13 wins in league play.

UMass Lowell (29 points)

Seeded #1 with a Boston University win or tie. Seeded #2 with a Notre Dame win.

Boston College (29 points)

Seeded #2 with a Boston University tie. Seeded #3 with a Notre Dame win or a Boston University win.

Notre Dame (28 points, at Boston University)

Seeded #1 with a win. Seeded #3 with a tie. Seeded #4 with a loss.

Boston University (27 points, vs. Notre Dame)

Seeded #2 with a win. Seeded #4 with a loss or a tie.

Providence (25 points, vs. Massachusetts)

Seeded #5 with a win or a tie. Seeded #5 with a loss and a Vermont loss or tie. Seeded #6 with a loss and a Vermont win.

Vermont (24 points, vs. Merrimack)

Seeded #5 with a win and a Providence loss. Seeded #6 with a win and a Providence win or tie. Seeded #6 with a loss or a tie.

Northeastern (21 points, at Maine)

Seeded #7 with a win or a tie. Seeded #7 with a loss and a Merrimack loss or tie. Seeded #8 with a loss and a Merrimack win.

Merrimack (20 points, at Vermont)

Seeded #7 with a win and a Northeastern loss. Seeded #8 with a win and a Northeastern win or tie. Seeded #8 with a tie. Seeded #8 with a loss and a UConn/New Hampshire tie. Seeded #9 with a loss and a UConn win or a New Hampshire win.

UConn (18 points, vs. New Hampshire)

Seeded #8 with a win and a Merrimack loss. Seeded #9 with a win and a Merrimack win or tie. Seeded #9 with a tie. Seeded #10 with a loss.

New Hampshire (18 points, at UConn)

Seeded #8 with a win and a Merrimack loss. Seeded #9 with a win and a Merrimack win or tie. Seeded #10 with a loss or a tie.

Maine (10 points, vs. Northeastern) Seeded #11.

Massachusetts (5 points, at Providence) Seeded #12.
