

SAVIANO NAMED CCM PLAYER OF THE MONTH Senior finisher records 10 goals in just eight games

The University of New Hampshire is still trying to find its 2003-04 identity, but senior forward Steve Saviano is leaving no doubts about who he is – one of the NCAA's most prolific goal-scorers.



<u>CCM Player of the Month</u> **Steve Saviano – New Hampshire** *Senior Forward; Reading, MA*

For most, scoring four goals in a game is a career accomplishment. For Steve Saviano, it's normal. Saviano recorded his second hat trick of the month and second four-goal game of the year on Jan. 23 at Merrimack, leading a 9-1 win for UNH. He also picked up a pair at Maine and finished the month with 10 goals in just eight games. He is now tied for the national lead in goals scored with 22 this season.

Superskills Hockey Rookie of the Month **Michel Leveille – Maine** Sophomore Forward: Levis, QC

Not lost in the shuffle of a strong Maine rookie class, Michel Leveille has starred above the rest. With nine more assists in the month of January, Leveille upped his season total to 23, tied for fourth best in the nation among all players. He was finally able to net his first career goal on Jan. 6 at Merrimack and followed that with three more goals over the next seven games, including a short-hander in an 8-4 win at Boston U. on Jan. 23. He also finished the month with a plus/minus of +12, second best in the conference behind senior linemate Colin Shields.
