VOCE NAMED CCM PLAYER OF THE MONTH He and linemate Patrick Eaves lead BC to 14-game undefeated streak

Tony Voce and Patrick Eaves combined for 14 goals and 10 assists in the month of February to lead BC to a 7-1-1 record. Maine's Jim Howard had two shutouts in four games and is looking forward to facing Voce and Eaves next weekend.

Not missing a single step in the absence of captain and linemate Ben Eaves, Voce has teamed with Ben's brother Patrick to carry BC to a 14-game undefeated streak which ended at UNH on Feb. 28. He had seven goals in February, lifting his season total to 24 and leading BC to a 7-1-1 record in the month. He had two two-goal games and two three-point games as the catalyst for BC's incredible offense.




Jim Howard – Maine Sophomore; Ogdensburg, NY

Freshman Goaltender: Holyrood, NF

In the shadows on the Warrior depth chart at the start of the season, Healey has emerged as the team's No. 1 stopper down the stretch. He dealt BC its only blemish during the Eagles' 14-game undefeated streak, making 41 saves in a 4-4 tie at home on Feb. 5.
