

PATRICK EAVES NAMED CCM PLAYER OF THE MONTH Howard repeats as Goaltender of the Month as Maine wins nine straight

Hockey East's regular season champ (BC) and tournament champ (Maine) are two of only four teams still alive in the college hockey season, thanks largely to the efforts of the honorees below.



<u>CCM Player of the Month</u> Patrick Eaves – Boston College Senior Forward; Faribault, MN

The Eagles struggled a bit following an extended unbeaten streak, but Eaves was consistent, netting a goal and an assist in a 4-3 OT loss at Maine. The dymanic sophomore scorer brougt his "A" game to the NCAA Northeast Regional last week, scoring three goals and adding two assists to lead BC to the Frozen Four as the regional's Most Outstanding Player.
