

The loss of its top five scorers from last season has not seemed to hinder Maine much. Todd Jackson is off to an incredible start as the team's new finisher – he had a pair of goals in three of the first six games and is leading a counterpunching penalty kill.

Jackson averaged better than one goal per game in the month of October, and amazingly did most of his scoring while shorthanded. Four of his seven markers came on the penalty kill, while the unit allowed just three opposing power play goals over six games. Jackson also scored two power play goals and three game-winners, and finished the month at +8.






Frank Doyle - Maine Senior; Guelph, ON Jim Howard - Maine
