The slick-skating center-turned-defenseman opened the month of November with two two-goal games in back-to-back Hockey East wins on the road. He failed to record a point in just one of the nine games UMass played in November (a 1-1 tie vs. Maine) and scored all the UMass goals in three different contests. He is leading the nation's blueliners with 19 points so far.



ITECH Goaltender of the Month Matti Kaltiainen, Boston College Junior; Espoo, Finland

The Finnish goaltender allowed more than two goals in just one contest in November, and allowed only one goal on four occasions as he compiled six wins and two ties. His peak performance came in a 2-2 tie vs. UNH in which he made an excellent save against sniper Steve Saviano on an odd-man rush in overtime. His only other non-victory came when he allowed no goals in a relief appearance against Merrimack.
