JACOB MICFLIKIER NAMED CCM PLAYER OF THE MONTH NU's Keni Gibson beats out three others as top goaltender in February



CCM Player of the Month Jacob Micflikier – New Hampshire Sophomore Forward; Winnipeg, MB

Sophomore Jacob Micflikier emerged from the shadows to become UNH's most consistent scoring threat in February. His 13 points led a vibrant Wildcat offense that averaged over five goals per game during a 4-0-1 stretch. He posted two four-points games, including a hat trick and one assist in a 6-1 win at Merrimack.




ITECH Goaltender of the Month Keni Gibson – Northeastern Senior: Stittsville. ON

Superskills Hockey Rookie of the Month Kevin Regan – New Hampshire Freshman Goaltender; South Boston, MA

Cast in a protégé role for most of his freshman season, Regan was given the UNH starting duties full time in February, and greatly excelled. He opened the month with a 29-save 2-1 win vs. Maine and culminated it with a 34-save 3-3 tie at Boston College. In between, he posted a perfect 4-0 record, allowing just five goals over those four starts while racking up 123 saves. Prior to facing BC, Regan owned an enviable 9-0 mark in Hockey East play.
