

PATRICK EAVES NAMED CCM PLAYER OF THE MONTH Sophomore John Curry emerges as Terriers' top 'tender

What offseason? March's Player of the Month Patrick Eaves is on top of the world again, leading top-ranked BC to a 3-1 start with 11 points in just four games. BU has rebounded from a rough start thanks to sophomore goalie John Curry.



CCM Player of the Month Patrick Eaves – Boston College Junior Forward; Faribault, MN

BC has scored 16 goals in four games so far this season, and junior Patrick Eaves has a hand in 11 of those, boasting an NCAA-best 2.75 points per game average. He hasn't shied from headline opponents, totalling seven of his 11 points against WCHA titans Denver and North Dakota, both BC victories, and led a Hockey East win at Lowell with two goals and one assist.
