BRADY LEISENRING NAMED PLAYER OF THE MONTH *Maine goaltender Ben Bishop tabbed for two October honors*

Leisenring has shown no rust from his redshirt season, averaging near two points per game during a six-game point streak in leading UVM to its best start ever at 6-0. He opened the season as the Most Outstanding Player at the Nye Frontier Classic in Alaska, netting two goals, including the overtime winner, in the opener against Michigan Tech. A week later, he led a sweep of Minnesota Duluth with a goal and four assists.

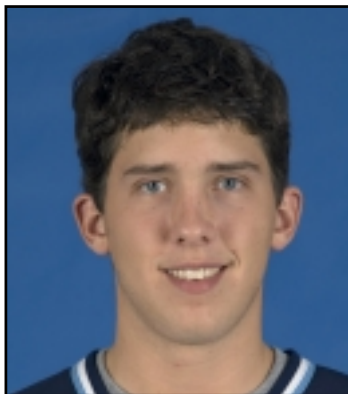
