## BU BREAKS OUT – HALTS UVM AND MAINE WIN STREAKS *Sweep of UMass places Providence atop the league standings*

A rather ordinary 1-2 start to the season had some wondering what kind of team BU was going to bring to the table this year. A week later, everyone knows they'll be the same old Terriers, likely contending for the league title all year long.

The Terriers had the toughest draw of any team this past weekend, facing Vermont and Maine, both on seven-game winning streaks. Undaunted, BU came out to deal the Catamounts their first loss of the season, 4-2 on Friday, and followed that up with a 2-1 win at Maine, where the Black Bears hadn't suffered a loss in over a year. Peter MacArthur did the honors Friday, scoring two goals to pace the win. On Sunday, it was John Curry's turn, as he stopped 37 of 38 shots faced, including all 19 in a furious third period. He finished with 56-for-59 over the two wins.

After getting nipped 3-2 by BC earlier in the week, the UNH Wildcats rebounded with back-to-back wins over Northeastern. Rookie Thomas Fortney led the way in Friday's 6-4 win at NU, scoring two goals including the game-winner, to counteract Husky rookie Ryan Ginand's second period hat trick. Goaltender Kevin Regan was perfect in the rematch back at UNH, stopping all 27 shots he faced for his first career shutout, 3-0. Daniel Winnik had seven points over three games on the week.

Providence also posted a weekend sweep, taking out UMass 4-2 and 3-2. Tyler Sims stopped 61 of 65 shots faced in the set, but was somewhat overshadowed by UMass rookie Jon Quick's 49-save gem on Friday. Nevertheless, the Friars came away with the two league wins and are perched atop the standings at 5-1, marking their best start ever in league play.

Merrimack suffered two 3-1 losses to visiting UMass Lowell and Maine on the week. The Warriors are still seeking their first league win since last November. Earlier in the week, UVM was successful in its first-ever Hockey East contest, scoring five first-period goals en route to a 5-3 win at Northeastern. The Catamounts will host their first Hockey East home game Friday vs. Providence.

## TEAM NOTES

**Boston College:** With a 3-2 win over UNH on Tuesday, Boston College remains undefeated in four games played at Verizon Wireless Arena (3-0-1). Freshman forward Brock Bradford broke the 2-2 tie late in the third period, notching his second consecutive game-winning goal.

**Boston University:** Jason Lawrence scored his first career goal on Sunday at Maine, ending goaltender Matt Lundin's shutout streak of 161:03. Lundin had allowed only one goal in three games before BU got two by him for a 2-1 win ... Jack Parker recorded Hockey East victory No. 300 Friday, beating previously undefeated Vermont 4-2.

**University of Maine:** Matt Lundin had a shutout streak of 161:03 ended in the second period against Boston University ... Sunday's loss ended an 18-game home unbeaten streak. The last loss at home was on November 5, 2004, a 3-1 loss vs. BC ... Maine is now 6-0 on the season when leading after two periods, a and 0-2 when trailing after two ... Maine's scoring defense is first in the nation, allowing just 12 goals in the first ten games of the season for a 1.20 GAA.

**University of Massachusetts:** UMass put an end to a scoreless drought of 117:35 when Marvin Degen came through with a power play goal early in Friday's game at Providence. The man-advantage tally also ended an 0-for-18 slump for UMass.

**UMass Lowell:** Elias Godoy has four points in his last three games and registered his 100th career point with an assist in Wednesday's 3-1 win at Merrimack. Mike Potacco, meanwhile, registered his first career point in the same game ... Bobby Robins has scored five points in his last three games and defenseman J.R. Bria has a three-game assist streak.

**Merrimack College:** Freshman Rob Ricci has a goal and five assists over the last three games ... Matt Johnson is tied for second nationally with five power play goals ... The Merrimack penalty kill is 24 for the last 25.

**University of New Hampshire:** Freshman forward Jerry Pollastrone tallied his first career goal in Friday's 6-4 win at Northeastern ... Eight of Daniel Winnik's 12 points have come in league play ... Brian Yandle's +8 rating in conference play is the best of any Hockey East player.

**Northeastern University:** The NU offense has combined for a total of 34 points this season and freshmen have accounted for 21 of those. Freshman Joe Vitale had a three-game goal-scoring streak broken on Saturday in NU's 3-0 loss to New Hampshire ... Ryan Ginand's second period hat trick vs. UNH Friday was the first hat trick by a rookie in a Hockey East game since BC's Kryz Kolanos did it way back in March of 2000 ... Goalie Adam Geragosian matched his career high with 38 saves at New Hampshire on Saturday.

**Providence College:** PC's 5-1 start in league play is its best ever ... Torry Gajda has recorded one point in seven of the first eight games this season ... Providence has three road wins this season, matching last season's win total on the road. The team is also now just one league win shy of tying last season's win total in Hockey East ... 13 of Providence's 26 goals this season have come in the third period.

**University of Vermont:** Friday's loss was Vermont's first defeat of the year after a school record seven straight wins to start the season. It was their first loss in 12 regular season games.

• **Chris Collins, BC** (Sr. F; Fairport, NY) – Has scored seven goals in six games, including two short-handers.

• **Brady Leisenring, UVM** (Sr. F; Stowe, VT) – Extended scoring streak to eight straight games (five goals, 10 assists) with two points in each contest last week.

• **Craig Switzer, UNH** (So. D; Peachland, BC) – Blueliner has two goals and five assists over his last four games.

• **Penalty-killing at Maine and Vermont** – Hockey East's two northern programs have combined to kill off 98 of 103 opposing power plays so far, boasting the two best ratios in the nation. Maine has a 96.4% kill and Vermont has a 93.6%.
