BC'S CHRIS COLLINS REPEATS AS PLAYER OF THE MONTH John Curry backstops Boston University to a seven-game win streak



CCM / RBK Player of the Month Chris Collins – Boston College Senior Forward; Fairport, NY

Running away with the 2005-06 scoring title, Collins added 15 points to his totals in the month of January and now has 20 goals and 20 assists in 24 games played overall. In 19 league games, he has a 14-16-30 line. It was a relatively quiet start to the month, as he notched just four points in the first four games. But of the 12 BC goals scored over the last four games, Collins scored three and set up all but one of the others.

Superskills Hockey Rookie of the Month Brandon Yip – Boston University Freshman Forward; Maple Ridge, BC

With eight assists in a span of four games, and a solid sixgame scoring streak, Yip has emerged as the leading scorer among Hockey East rookies. He led all Terriers with nine assists on the month, deftly setting up the scoring plays that yielded a seven-game win streak for Boston University.
