Kevin Regan, Chad Costello also honored for November achievements

Junior Forward; Mississauga, ON

Strong had six goals and four assists for 10 points in November, with eight points in league games. He also had four game-winning goals in November and is tied for first in the country in game-winning goals. Strong is also one of UVM's top penalty killers. Vermont is 8-1-1 when Strong records at least one point this year and was 6-0-0 in November when he recorded at least one point.

Regan posted a 7-0-1 record in November in eight starts, with a 1.98 GAA and .931 save percentage. He allowed two goals or fewer in five of his eight starts. Regan stopped 217 of 233 shots in the month, and twice amassed more than 30 saves in a game, including 33 against Maine.
