## UNH TIGHTENS GRIP; NU TAKES TWO UVM splits; Maine, BC blank foes; UMass wins

The UNH Wildcats solidified their hold on first place with a decisive 4-1 home win against second-place Vermont on Sunday in a Hockey East week dominated by exceptional goaltending. Northeastern freshman Brad Thiessen (Aldergrove, BC) stopped 52 of 53 shots to lead the Huskies to a weekend sweep of Merrimack, which included the team's first league wins and Thiessen's first career shutout. Maine's Ben Bishop (Des Peres, MO) also recorded his first career shutout, a 3-0 whitewashing of Providence on Friday, while Boston College's Cory Schneider (Marblehead, MA) and UNH's Kevin Regan (South Boston, MA) also blanked foes during the week.

In Boston, BC and Boston University played the second half of a home-and-home series after Friday's game was cancelled due to poor ice and poor visibility (see box). On Saturday, Schneider outdueled BU's John Curry, 1-0, after a BU player accidentally banked the puck off of Curry's skate and into the Terrier net. It was Schneider's 12<sup>th</sup> career shutout, but the first 1-0 regular season loss in BU head coach Jack Parker's illustrious career.

Just north of Boston on Saturday, Thiessen slammed the door on the Warriors at Merrimack, 2-0, after the Huskies took the series opener at NU, 4-1, on Friday. It was the second time in three games that Merrimack was held scoreless, as UNH did the trick on Tuesday, 5-0. On Sunday, Regan made Mike Radja's (Yorkville, IL) second-period strike stand up as the Wildcats slipped past UVM, 4-1, in a highly anticipated match between the leagues first and second-ranked squads.

On Friday, the Catamounts got the key second goal, as freshman Brayden Irwin (Toronto, ON) broke a 1-1 tie by slapping a rebound past UMass Lowell goaltender Carter Hutton (Thunder Bay, ON), sealing UVM's 2-1 win over the River Hawks at Tsongas Arena. Both Hutton and UVM goaltender Joe Fallon (Bemidji, MN) played superbly, and UML's Jason Tejchma (Muskegon, MI) continued his solid play with his seventh goal of the season. In Amherst, UMass' Jon Quick (Hampden, CT) put on a goaltending clinic of his own, sparking the Minutemen to a 6-2 win over visiting Niagara University. UMass' Mark Matheson (Calgary, AB) erupted for three goals, while linemates Chris Capraro (Medford, MA) and Will Ortiz (Framingham, MA) tallied four points each.

## TEAM NOTES

**Boston College:** Boston College's 1-0 shutout over Boston University marked the team's eighth shutout in the 234-game history. It also marked the first time that either club has posted shutouts in consecutive meetings ... Cory Schneider got the 12th shutout of his career, one shutout shy of the BC record of 13 held by Scott Clemmesen.

**Boston University:** Saturday's loss to BC was the first time BU ever dropped a 1-0 contest on its campus ... The Terriers' defense ranks third in the country, allowing 1.85 goals per game ... All but one of BU's 13 contests have been decided by one goal or resulted in a tie ... With Friday's game at BC postponed, BU will be playing its sixth straight home game Friday versus Providence.

**University of Maine:** Maine is now 6-0-0 on Friday nights this season ... The Black Bears are 8-1-0 when scoring first and 9-1-0 when scoring three or more goals ... The shutout for Maine was the first since Jan. 6, 2006 against UMass Lowell (4-0 win) ... Ironically, the last team to shut-out Maine was Providence on January 20, 2006.

**University of Massachusetts:** UMass' 2-2 tie vs. BU marked its first point at Agganis Arena ... The Minutemen's game vs. BC on Friday marks the fourth-annual Mullet Night at the Mullins Center, in conjunction with the student Toy Drive for Shriners Hospital in Springfield. New, unwrapped toys will be collected at the game.

**UMass Lowell:** Lowell's penalty kill is 18-for-21 (85.7 percent) over the last six games, holding opponents without a power play goal in four of those contests ... The River Hawks have outshot opponents in nine of the last 11 games ... Head Coach Blaise MacDonald will coach his 200th game behind the UML bench Wednesday night.

**Merrimack College:** The Warriors have allowed five short-handed goals this season, including three in their last two games ... MC faces Massachusetts on Tuesday. The Warriors lost all three games to the Minutemen last season ... Andrew Braithwaite (Kingston, ON) made 37 saves against UNH last week.

**University of New Hampshire:** UNH has already posted 64 goals this season, a 32 percent increase in goal production from a season ago ... UNH remains the national leader in team offense at 4.57 goals per game and the Wildcat defense ranks fifth, allowing 2.07 goals per game.

**Northeastern University:** The Huskies swept a weekend series for the first time since March 5-6, 2004 ... Freshman Chad Costello (Johnston, Iowa) scored the game-winning goal on Saturday ... Northeastern held Merrimack to 1-for-17 on power plays over two games.

**Providence College:** The Friars had their streak of 31 consecutive penalty kills snapped Friday night when Maine scored a power-play goal late in the third period ... Junior Tyler Sims (Grand Blanc, MI) moved to No. 10 in PC's goalie career games played list with 66.

**University of Vermont:** Sunday's loss ended Vermont's seven-game winning streak ... UVM's penalty kill leads the nation at .925 percent, and the Catamounts have killed 40 of the last 42 opponent power play chances.
