TERRIERS, HUSKIES, CATAMOUNTS EARN SWEEPS UNH and UMass hold serve at home; PC and Maine trade shutouts

The league matches this past weekend mirrored the tug-of-war that the Hockey East race is expected to engender from now to March.

UVM captain Torrey Mitchell (Greenfield Park, QC) and junior netminder Joe Fallon (Bemidji, MN) led Vermont to a crucial two-game home sweep of Boston College, allowing the Catamounts to catapult over the Eagles in the league standings. Mitchell had four points (two goals, two assists) on the weekend, including the game-winner on Friday, while teammate Corey Carlson (Two Harbors, MN) notched a pair. On Saturday, UVM freshman Brayden Irwin (Toronto, ON) got two goals, and the game-winner. Fallon finished with 52 saves in both wins, as the Catamounts snapped an 11-game winless streak against BC.

In Durham on Friday, the relentless attack of the high-powered Wildcats gave UNH a convincing 5-1 on NESN's Hockey East Friday Night showcase game. Freshman Peter LeBlanc (Hamilton, ON) got the game-winner with his first collegiate tally, and UNH goaltender Kevin Regan (South Boston, MA) not only stopped 27 shots, but also picked up an assist on Bobby Butler's (Marlborough, MA) insurance tally. But the next night, UMass goaltender Jon Quick (Hamden, CT) turned the tables on New Hampshire and pitched his first shutout of the season (27 saves) to propel the Minutemen to a 3-0 win at the Mullins Center in Amherst. UNH freshman goalie Brian Foster (Pembroke, NH) absorbed his first loss of the season, though he recorded a career-high 35 saves. UMass's Cory Quirk (Brockton, MA) got the game-winner, and freshman Will Ortiz (Framingham, MA) netted the next two to secure the win.

Boston University also gained four league points, taking both ends of a home-and-home series with Merrimack. BU senior John Curry (Shorewood, MN) recorded his fourth shutout of the year in the Terriers' 3-0 win at Merrimack. The next night, BU freshman goalie Brett Bennett (Williamsville, NY) backstopped the Terriers to a 2-1 victory in his first start, making 17 saves, while fellow freshman Eric Gryba (Saskatoon, SK) got the game-winner. Merrimack goalie Jim Healey played well, stopping 41 of 46 Terrier bids.

Northeastern also collected a pair of league wins, downing UMass Lowell on successive nights, 6-2 and 2-1 in overtime. Captain Mike Morris (Braintree, MA) set up four goals, including two by freshman Chad Costello (Johnston, IA) in the opener at Lowell. In the return match, NU's Jimmy Russo (South Weymouth, MA) struck with a minute gone in overtime to complete the sweep for the Huntington Hounds.

In Providence, the Friars blanked the visiting Black Bears on Friday, 3-0, behind two goals from PC's Jon Rheault (Deering, NH). But the Black Bears returned the favor Saturday, whitewashing the Friars, 2-0. Josh Soares (Hamilton, ON) potted the game-winner.

BEN BISHOP - Maine Sophomore Goaltender; Des Peres, MO

TYLER SIMS - Providence Junior Goaltender; Grand Blanc, MI

Bishop posted his second shutout of the season on Saturday night in a 2-0 win at Providence, and allowed only two goals all weekend, stopping 81 shots. Sims earned his first shutout of the season with a 28-save effort in a 3-0 win over No. 4 Maine, and then had 28 saves the following night in a 2-0 loss.

TEAM NOTES

Boston College: The Eagles suffered consecutive losses for the first time this season and for the first time since last February ... Vermont last defeated BC on Nov. 1, 1994, a 4-2 loss in Conte Forum during Coach Jerry York's first season at BC ... Sophomore Brock Bradford (Burnaby, BC), who scored a goal in each game against Vermont, has eight goals this season, surpassing his freshman total of six.

Boston University: The Terriers own a nation-high seven-game unbeaten streak (6-0-1) and are 10-2-2 in their last 14 games ... BU has outscored its opponents 22-7 in its last seven games and has earned four shutouts during the stretch ... The Terriers have allowed just six second-period goals ... The Terriers have won their last five road games and are 6-1-3 in opposing rinks.

University of Maine: Ben Bishop has posted 40+ saves in three of his last five games ... Maine is 7-2-1 this season in games where they have been outshot by the opponent, which includes the last two games at Providence ... Maine ended a streak of 160:13 without a goal when Josh Soares (Hamilton, ON) scored in the second period at Providence on Saturday night.

University of Massachusetts: The Minutemen took the season series with UNH. UMass is the only Hockey East team to defeat the Wildcats this season, ending their previously unblemished 10-0-0 road mark. UMass' home record improved to 9-1-1, which leads the league and is in the Top Five nationally ... Brett Watson (Media, PA) picked up his first points as a Minuteman, assisting on both Will Ortiz goals vs. UNH ... David Leaderer (Rochester, NY) has three points in his last three games.

UMass Lowell: The River Hawks' penalty kill had their second straight perfect weekend on the penalty kill and has killed off 28 of the last 32 opponent's power plays ... With freshman forward Jonathan Maniff's (Revere, MA) appearance Saturday night, all 15 freshman on the UML roster have suited up for at least one game this year.

Merrimack College: Merrimack has killed off 60 of its last 66 penalties, including 12 of 13 against BU this weekend ... Sophomore John Goebel (Parma, OH) scored his first PP goal of the season while sophomore Mickey Rego (Hudson, MA) picked up his first assist of the season Saturday night ... The Warriors went 1-2-0 against this weekend's opponent, Vermont, including a 4-2 win and a 4-3 OT loss in Burlington last January.

University of New Hampshire: UMass halted UNH's school record 10-game winning streak on the road ... The Wildcats lost their first season series of year ... Freshman Brian Foster (Pembroke, NH) totaled a career-high 35 saves in the 3-0 loss on Saturday. He had shutout his opponents in the first 172:22 of his career ... UNH is the No. 1 ranked team in the Pairwise Rankings, which mimics the NCAA selection process.

Northeastern University: Chad Costello (Johnston, IA) scored two goals and had two assists in Northeastern's 6-2 win over UMass Lowell, becoming NU's first freshman to put up four points in a game since March 2005 ... In his first game since an appendectomy, Mike Morris (Braintree, MA) had four assists, tying his career high, in a 6-2 NU win on Friday.

Providence College: Jon Rheault's league-leading three short-handed goals have all been game-winners ... The Friars have thwarted 54 of the last 58 opponent power play chances ... Tyler Sims' four career shutouts are one shy of tying a PC record for most shutouts, set by Mario Proulx (five from 1980-84).

University of Vermont: Vermont's win over Boston College on Friday night was its first against the Eagles since Nov. 11, 1994 ... The Catamounts are 7-6 against ranked opponents this season ... Vermont has won or is currently winning the season series against eight of nine Hockey East opponents.
