MERRIMACK SWEEPS MAINE FOR FIRST TIME IN SCHOOL HISTORY

~NU wins two, stays in first; UMass takes three points; UNH wins in OT vs. PC~

WAKEFIELD, Mass. – Merrimack College swept Maine in a two-game series for the first time in school history, while Northeastern won both of its games on the weekend and No. 14 Massachusetts took three points from No. 9 Boston College in the league's second full week of conference play.

The Warriors held the Black Bears to one goal each night with the help of goalie Patrick Watson (Waltham, Mass.) posting 53 saves on the weekend vs. the Black Bears. They scored a season-high five goals on the victory on Friday night at Lawler Arena. Merrimack has already doubled its win total from all of last season. The Minutemen kept pace in the league standings with the Huskies as they defeated BC, 3-2, on Saturday at Conte Forum, after a 1-1 tie on Friday night at the Mullins Center in Amherst. Jordan Virtue scored the game-winning goal with 4:33 remaining in the third period on Saturday.

Northeastern is currently in the midst of a five-game unbeaten streak (4-0-1) after two wins over the weekend, with victories at No. 6 New Hampshire and a 2-1 victory against UMass-Lowell on Saturday at Matthews Arena. It marked the first time since the 2000-2001 season that the Huskies won the season series with the Wildcats and it was the first time since 1992-1993 that NU won two games in a season at New Hampshire. Pure Hockey Defensive Player of the Week Brad Thiessen (Aldergrove, B.C.) backstopped the Huskies with two wins and 58 saves on the weekend.

In other action, No. 6 New Hampshire downed Providence in overtime on Saturday night at Schneider Arena and lost to Northeastern at home for the second time this season on Friday night. Wildcat Freshman forward Paul Thompson (Derry, N.H.) scored five points on Saturday night, including the overtime game-winner with 2:03 left in the extra frame vs. the Friars. Boston University and Vermont split the two-game set at Gutterson FieldHouse in Burlington. The Terriers scored nine goals in the Friday night game, while Vermont bounced back on Saturday and put up a season-high five goals on BU. Senior forward Bryan Ewing (Plymouth, Mass.) had a league-high seven points on the week in two games, while his linemates Chris Higgins (Lynnfield, Mass.) and Pete MacArthur (Clifton Park, N.Y.) each had a six-point weekends at UVM. Ewing took over the Hockey East scoring lead with his point total over the weekend vs. the Catamounts.

UMass-Lowell has quietly put together a nice string of defensive performances with the goaltending tandem of Carter Hutton (Thunder Bay, Ont.), who owns the lowest GAA and best save percentage among league netminders, and Nevin Hamilton (Ashland, Mass.). The River Hawks posted their fourth tie of the season in league play on Friday night against Providence (2-2) at Schneider Arena and then lost a tough game to Northeastern on Saturday at Matthews Arena, 2-1.

TEAM NOTES

Boston College: Friday's 1-1 tie at Massachusetts marked the first between the teams in 20 meetings in Amherst. BC is now 16-3-1 against Massachusetts in the Mullins Center...BC is winless in its last three trips to the Mullins Center...Sophomore forward Matt Lombardi (Milton, Mass.) recorded his first goal of the season in the team's 3-2 home loss to the Minutemen on Saturday...Freshman goaltender John Muse (East Falmouth, Mass.) recorded 63 saves, a 1.94 goals against average and a .940 save percentage in the team's weekend series vs. Massachusetts.

Boston University: All 20 skaters who have appeared in at least one of the Terriers' three wins this season have earned at least one point in one of those games...Fourteen different players have scored a goal in the three victories...BU has already scored 41 goals this season after waiting until Jan. 5 to score its 41st goal last season...The Terriers have outshot their opponent in all but one of their 11 games...BU is just 1-4-1 in games that it scores first...The 9-1 win at Vermont was the team's most decisive road victory since an 8-0 shutout at Merrimack on Nov. 4, 1989.

Maine: The University of Maine and Maine Athletics lost a wonderful friend Friday when Harold Alford passed away...Maine's Alford Arena is named for Harold Alford...Maine is 4-0-0 on the season when scoring three or more goals and 0-6-1 when scoring two goals or less...Maine captain Travis Ramsey (Lakewood, Calif.) has seen action in 107 consecutive games, the longest consecutive games played streak on the Maine team...Billy Ryan (Milton, Mass.), Keenan Hopson (Prince George, B.C.), Chris Hahn (Fort Qu'Appelle, Sask.) and Jeff Marshall (Kyle, Sask.) are Maine's lone forwards who have seen action in all 11 games this season.

Massachusetts: UMass is undefeated this season when scoring 3-or-more goals (5-0-2)...The Minutemen are 4-1-1 in the last six games against Boston College after posting an 0-10-1 record in the previous 11 games...Nine different players scored all nine of UMass' points in the weekend series against Boston College...UMass' attendance of 7,319 was the fourth-largest crowd of all time at the Mullins Center and the second-best all-time against Boston College...Four of UMass' seven power play goals have come in the last four games.

UMass-Lowell: The River Hawks earned their third straight tie at Providence on Friday night; the first time in program history that UML has recorded three consecutive draws...Scott Campbell (Navan, Ont.) scored his first career goal at Northeastern (11/17)...The River Hawks have scored 11 of their 15 Hockey East goals (73.3%) in the second period...Mike Potacco (Kinnelon, N.J.) has a three game point streak (1g, 2a)...Mark Roebathan (St. John's, N.F.) has a two-game point streak (1g, 1a)...The River Hawks are at Merrimack Tuesday and host the Warriors Saturday.



Merrimack: Merrimack swept Maine in a weekend series for the first-time in school history...The sweep was Merrimack's first against a Hockey Team since they swept Northeastern on February 18th and 19th of 2000...The Warriors snapped a 17-game winless streak (0-15-2) against Maine dating back to February 9, 2002...The five goals scored Friday are the most since defeating RPI 5-3 on October 29, 2005...Rob Ricci was 45 for 65 on faceoffs over the weekend...Matt Jones has six goals and seven points in his last six games and is tied for first in goals in Hockey East with seven...Kurtis Astle scored his first collegiate goal in the third period Friday...Tom DeRosa, playing in his first collegiate game on Friday, assisted on Merrimack's fourth goal...The Warriors have three short-handed goals, tied for first in HEA.

New Hampshire: UNH went 1-1-0 on the week rebounding from a 4-1 loss to Northeastern on Friday night with Saturday night's 5-4 overtime win at Providence...Although the Wildcats have now won three straight and eight of their last nine against the Friars, this marked their first win at Schneider since Jan. 7, 2005...Freshman Paul Thompson (Derry, N.H.) is the the nation's leader in goals per game for rookies (0.75)...Thompson became the first Wildcat to tally five points in a game since Justin Aikins on Feb. 11, 2005 against UMass...The one-two freshman combo rank third and fifth, respectively, in points per game nationally with 1.33 and 1.25 ppg.

Northeastern: Northeastern's 4-0-1 unbeaten streak is its best since a 4-0-1 run from Oct. 23-Nov. 14, 2004...The last time Northeastern had a longer unbeaten streak was six-games (5-0-1) Jan. 6-25, 2002...Northeastern's longest unbeaten streak ever was a 12-game winning streak from Nov. 25, 1980-Jan. 20, 1981...Northeastern's penalty kill was perfect this weekend, holding UNH to 0-8 and UMass Lowell to 0-7...Northeastern's penalty kill has been perfect in six of 10 games this season...The last time Northeastern had five Hockey East wins before Thanksgiving was 1989-90...Northeastern has outshot its opponent in eight of 10 games this season.

Providence College: The Friars' consecutive overtime games marked the first time since November of 2005 that they played in back-to-back overtime games...Pierce Norton has recorded a career-high seven goals this season, the same amount he scored in his first two seasons at Providence...The Friars have scored 12 power-play goals in 11 games this season after scoring 16 all of last season.

Vermont: Vermont head coach Kevin Sneddon has elevated junior Dean Strong (Mississauga, Ont.) to a co-captain along with senior Mark Lutz...Junior Peter Lenos (Shelburne, Vt.) also has been named an assistant captain...The Catamounts scored three power-play goals in Saturday's 5-4 win over the Terriers after starting the season 1-for-30 on the man advantage...The five goals were the most for Vermont since a 6-0 victory over Colgate in the season opener last year at the Ice Breaker Invitational...Junior assistant captain Corey Carlson scored two goals in a game for the fourth time in his career on Saturday...He now has nine multi-point games in his career...UVM hosts UMass on Tuesday and holds a 27-11-4 edge in the all-time series.
