EAGLES SWEEP TERRIERS TO MOVE INTO SECOND PLACE ~UML/UNH split weekend series; Friars shutout UVM at Gutterson~

WAKEFIELD, Mass. – With a weekend sweep of Boston University, the Boston College Eagles have vaulted into second place in the Hockey East standings with two strong showings against the Terriers. In other league action, UMass-Lowell split a home-and-home series with No. 6 New Hampshire, while Providence shutout Vermont on Saturday night.

Junior forward Nathan Gerbe (Oxford, Mich.) was outstanding with a seven-point (4g,3a) weekend for the Eagles. Gerbe notched his first collegiate hat trick in Friday night's 6-2 win and came back the next night, matching a career-high with four points (1g,3a) in the 4-3 victory at Agganis Arena. Freshman goalie John Muse (East Falmouth, Mass.) also had a solid effort over the weekend with 74 saves in the two game series. Muse notched a career-high 41 saves and sophomore Ben Smith (Avon, Conn.) tallied his first career hat trick on Saturday night. Terrier freshman Colin Wilson (Greenwich, Conn.), who ranks third among league rookies in scoring with 11 points, had three assists in the weekend series. Junior Brandon Yip (Maple Ridge, B.C.) scored a goal in each game for BU in the losing cause.

The River Hawks capped off the weekend with a 3-2 win over No. 6 New Hampshire on Saturday night at Tsongas Arena, after the Wildcats took two points from UMass-Lowell on Friday night, 3-2, at the Whittemore Center. Sophomore goaltender Nevin Hamilton (Ashland, Mass.) stopped 68 Wildcat shots, including a career-high 38 on Friday night in Durham. Senior Matt Fornataro (Calgary, Alb.) totaled three points (1g,2a) in the victory on Friday for UNH.

Providence College was paced by senior forward Jon Rheault (Deering, N.H.) in the 4-0 shutout of the Catamounts on Saturday with a two-goal effort for the Friars. PC senior netminder Tyler Sims (Fort Wayne, Ind.) made 20 saves in his sixth career shutout, which set a new Friar school record.

On Friday night in non-conference action, No. 12 Northeastern edged Brown, 4-3, at Matthews Arena, while No. 11 ranked Massachusetts skated to a scoreless tie with Cornell at Lynah Rink. Freshman forward Steve Silva (Tyngsboro, Mass.) recorded two goals in the win, while junior blueliner Denis Chisholm (Fox Valley, Sask.) scored the game-winner with only 5:32 remaining in the game. The Huskies extended the nation's longest unbeaten streak to seven games (6-0-1) with the victory. Freshman Paul Dainton (Genelle, B.C.) made 24 saves in the shutout against the Big Red to continue his strong play for the Minutemen.

In exhibition play, the Minutemen defeated the United States Under-18 Team, 5-2, on Sunday night at the Mullins Center, while Maine was defeated by New Brunswick, 2-1, on Saturday night at Alford Arena in Orono.

TEAM NOTES

Boston College: Sophomore center Ben Smith registered his first collegiate hat trick in leading Boston College to a 4-3 victory at Boston University on Saturday. Smith registered five points – four goals and one assist – in leading the Eagles to the two-game sweep of the Terriers...Freshman forward Brian Gibbons (Braintree, Mass.) tallied three assists and a team-high combined plus/minus rating of +7 in the two-game series sweep. Gibbons recorded two assists on Friday, marking the third multiple-point effort of his young career...BC scored one power-play goal in each of its two victories this weekend, extending the team's streak to 11 straight contests with a man-advantage tally. The team is converting 25% of its power-play chances (18 of 72)... It currently ranks tied for fourth (with three others) among all teams in the country.

Boston University: Despite the two losses, BU went 5-of-11 (.455) on the power play in its home-and-home series with BC... Senior Pete MacArthur (Clifton Park, N.Y.) had a seven-game point streak snapped on Saturday after tallying 14 points (7g, 7a) during the stretch...After recording 24 first-period goals all of last season, the Terriers have already put up 16 tallies in the opening stanza this year...BU is winless in its seven contests against ranked opponents this season (0-7-0).

Maine: Maine's Dave Wilson (Caldeon East, Ont.) got the start in goal against New Brunswick, his first start since March 10 in the Hockey East quarterfinals against Massachusetts. Wilson stopped 26 of 28 shots, including five shots on the power play... Maine and New Brunswick combined to take just six penalties on Saturday, yet each team managed a power play goal. Just one penalty was called through two periods...Maine is in the midst of a stretch where it will play just one game for four straight weekends.

Massachusetts: UMass is undefeated this season when scoring 3-or-more goals (6-0-2) and are undefeated at home (3-0-3)...UMass has not lost at home in the last 12 games (8-0-4) dating back to last season...Three times this season UMass has scored five goals...For the season, 21-of-22 skaters who have dressed for games have scored at least one point...UMass had its first 0-0 tie at Cornell since Jan. 22, 2000 at Merrimack.

UMass-Lowell: The River Hawks went 1-1 against New Hampshire over the weekend and split the season series (1-1-1) with the Wildcats for the first time since the 2004-05 season...UML has won three of four, and improved to 5-1-1 when scoring three or more goals in a game with Saturday's 3-2 victory...The River Hawks' penalty kill, first in Hockey East and 18th in the nation at 87.0%, had their streak of 14 straight penalties killed snapped Saturday night, but went 8-for-9 over the weekend...Mark Roebothan (St. John's, Nfld.) has five goals during a current three-game goal streak...Nevin Hamilton made 68 saves in the two games, including a career-high 38 saves Friday night...The River Hawks wrap up their pre-Christmas schedule with home games against Boston University (Friday) and Bentley College (Saturday).

Merrimack: The Warriors were idle this week and return to action Tuesday at Holy Cross...Matt Jones is second among Hockey East scorers with nine goals...Merrimack will go for its first-ever season-series sweep at Maine Saturday. The Warriors defeated the Black Bears twice in North Andover earlier this season...Merrimack has surrendered just six third-period goals, fewest in Hockey East.

New Hampshire: UNH has captured at least two points in all five Hockey East weekends this season...The Wildcats are 7-0-0 when captain Matt Fornataro tallies a point and 4-0-1 when freshman Paul Thompson (Derry, N.H.) registers a point...UNH has the best offense in Hockey East 3.67 goals per game...Senior netminder Kevin Regan has the top winning percentage in the league (6-3-0, .667)...Freshman Phil DeSimone matched a career high with a pair of assists including a helper on the game-winner on Friday night in a win over UMass-Lowell.

Northeastern: Northeastern's seven-game unbeaten streak (6-0-1) is tied with Notre Dame for the longest current streak in the country. The last time Northeastern had a longer unbeaten streak was an eight-game, 6-0-2 unbeaten streak from Nov. 22-Dec. 28, 1997...Since Hockey East went to its current regular season format in 1989-90, this is the first time Northeastern had six Hockey East wins before December. Seven total wins before December is the most Northeastern has had since joining Hockey East in 1984-85. Including this season, Northeastern has done that three times...After just one assist in his first seven games, Jimmy Russo (Weymouth, Mass.) has two goals and an assist over his last two games...Denis Chisholm has just three collegiate goals, but two of them are game-winners.

Providence College: Senior Tyler Sims set a new PC record with his sixth career shutout on Saturday, December 1 at Vermont. Prior to this season, the record was held by Mario Proulx (1980-84)...The 4-0 victory against Vermont marked the Friars' first ever shutout win over the Catamounts...Three of the Friars' four wins this season have come on the road...Junior Pierce Norton (South Boston, Mass.) is on a five-game point streak (5 g, 3 a).

Vermont: Vermont was shutout for the first time this season in a 4-0 loss to Providence last Saturday...Junior assistant captain Corey Carlson (Two Harbors, Minn.) is tied for second in Hockey East in power-play goals with three...The Catamounts rank second in Hockey East in combined special teams at 57.8-percent (37/64)...Vermont continues a five-game homestand in the month of December against Harvard on Saturday. Head coach Kevin Sneddon won a national championship as a player for the Crimson in 1989 and was named to the NCAA All-Tournament Team. Harvard head coach Ted Donato was a teammate of Sneddon's and was named the Most Outstanding Player of the 1989 Frozen Four...Saturday's game will be televised on CN8 and marks the third of 14 television appearances for the Catamounts this season.
