## NO. 10 UMASS WINS BATTLE WITH NO. 7 UNH ~Maine beats Merrimack; Lowell, Providence earn two wins~

**WAKEFIELD, Mass.** – The No. 10 Massachusetts Minutemen continued to keep pace with Northeastern at the top of the league standings as they defeated No. 7 New Hampshire, 4-1, on Saturday night at the Mullins Center. The Maine Black Bears got back on the winning track with a 3-1 win over Merrimack on Saturday, while UMass-Lowell won its second consecutive game with a 4-3 victory over Boston University on Friday night in Lowell.

The Minutemen, undefeated in their last four games (3-0-1), scoring four goals in the final two periods for the win. UMass was led by senior forward P.J. Fenton (Longmeadow, Mass.), who posted a career-high four points (1g,3a), while rookie goaltender Paul Dainton (Genelle, B.C.) continued his strong play with 32 saves against the nation's third ranked offense.

The Black Bears picked up their third win of the season on Matt Duffy's (Windham, Maine) first career hat trick. Junior goalie Ben Bishop (Des Peres, Mo.) tallied 26 stops in the victory in Orono for his 47th win of his Black Bear career, tying Jimmy Howard for fifth on the all-time school wins list.

UMass-Lowell evened its Hockey East record to move into a three-way tie for second place with a win against the Terriers. Sophomore forward Kory Falite (Billerica, Mass.) had two points, which included the game-winning goal with 8:25 left in the game. Sophomore Nevin Hamilton (Ashland, Mass.) earned his fourth win of the season with 22 saves in his fourth consecutive start for the River Hawks. Terrier freshman Adam Kraus (Irving, Texas) made 22 saves in his collegiate debut in the losing cause. UMass-Lowell also defeated Bentley, 4-1, in Lowell on Saturday, as sophomore goalie Jon Dryjowicz-Burek (Ludlow, Mass.) made 20 saves in his first his first collegiate start. Junior forward Mike Potacco (Kinneton, N.J.) also potted two goals in the win for the River Hawks. The Terriers also took out the U.S. Under-18 Team on Saturday, 3-2, at Agganis Arena.

Providence College earned two wins on the week, outscoring its opponents, 13-2, in two games. The Friars began the week with a 8-0 victory over Brown in the 22nd annual Mayor's Cup on Tuesday and closed the week with a 5-2 win against Union at Schneider Arena on Saturday. Senior forward Jon Rheault (Deering, N.H.) had a five-point week (2g,3a) for the Friars, with three points against the Bears and the game-winner against Union. Senior goalie Tyler Sims (Fort Wayne, Ind.) stopped 43 of 45 shots in two wins last week, including an 18-save performance in a shutout of Brown.

In other non-league action, Northeastern skated to a 1-1 tie with Union on Saturday, while Vermont and No. 12 Harvard also ended in a deadlock, 2-2, at Gutterson Fieldhouse. Earlier in the week Merrimack College tied Holy Cross, 2-2 in Worcester.

## TEAM NOTES

**Boston College:** With a league-high 18 points - 10 goals and eight assists - in 14 games this season, sophomore Ben Smith (Avon, Conn.) has matched his scoring output from his 42-game freshman campaign. Smith registered an identical 10 goals and eight assists in 2006-07...Senior alternate captain Dan Bertram (Calgary, Alberta) has recorded double-digit assists (10) for the third straight season...BC's power play is scoring on ¼ of its chances (18-for-72) and is third nationally behind Holy Cross (29.6%) and Bowling Green (25.3%)...BC's top two plus/minus leaders are Braintree, Mass. residents in freshman Brian Gibbons with a +8 and junior Anthony Aiello with a +5.

**Boston University:** In the Terriers' 3-2 exhibition win over the U.S. National Under-18 Team, senior Kevin Kielt (Brick, N.J.) and freshman Victor Saponari (Powder Springs, Ga.) both scored their first goal in a Terrier uniform...BU has recorded a power-play goal in 13 of its last 15 games...BU has given up four or more goals 10 times this season after having that happen only eight times during the 2006-07 campaign...Following junior Chris Higgins' (Lynnfield, Mass) tally 34 seconds into Friday's game at UMass Lowell, BU has scored on its opening shift three times this season, but is 0-2-1 in those games.

**Maine:** Maine's Matt Duffy recorded his first career hat trick on Saturday night in Maine's 3-1 win over Merrimack...He becomes the first Maine player to score three goals in a game since January 13, 2007 when Josh Soares scored a hat trick against Boston University...Maine was whistled for just two penalties on Saturday night against Merrimack...Maine goalie Ben Bishop won his 47th career game on Saturday...The 47 career wins ties Jimmy Howard (2002-05) for fifth place on Maine's all-time wins list...Jeff Marshall recorded his first career multi-point game with a pair of assists on Saturday against Merrimack.

**Massachusetts:** UMass' scoring defense ranks eighth in the nation allowing only 2.07 goals per game...In their last 10 games the Minutemen own a 6-1-3 record and they have scored 4 or more goals in five of those games...Massachusetts owns a 4-0-3 record at home this season. They are the only league team with an undefeated record at home this season...UMass owns a 3-0-1 record this season against nationally ranked opponents.

**UMass-Lowell:** The River Hawks wrapped up their pre-Christmas schedule with wins over Boston University, 4-3 (12/7), and Bentley, 4-1 (12/8)...UML has won three straight and five of the last six...The River Hawks have won four in a row at home and are 6-1-1 at Tsongas Arena this season; UML won just three games at home in 2006-07 (3-9-3)...The River Hawks have killed 22 of the last 23 opponent power plays and are a Hockey East best 88.3% (53-of-60) on the penalty kill this season...UML's line of Mark Roebathan (St. John's, Nfld.), Scott Campbell (Navan, Ont.) and Mike Potacco combined for eight points (3g, 5a) in the last two games, and have 19 points (9g, 10a) since being put together (6 games)...Freshmen Todd Bartelson and Ryan Blair scored their first career goals in Friday's victory; Blair's was the game-winner...The River Hawks are off until Dec. 28 when they take on Cornell (4:00 p.m.) in the first day of the Florida College Classic in Estero, Florida.

**Merrimack:** Freshman Francois Ouimet's (Lorraine, Que.) goal Saturday night in a 3-1 loss to Maine snapped a six-game pointlessness streak...Rob Ricci posted his sixth multiple point game this season and first multi-goal game in Tuesday's 2-2 tie with Holy Cross. Ricci was 19-for-22 in the face-off circle at Maine...Freshman Fraser Allan (North Battleford, Sask.) notched his first collegiate multi-point game with two assists at Holy Cross.

**New Hampshire:** Junior defenseman Brad Flaishans (Glendale, Ariz.) now owns a four-game scoring streak...UNH has outshot its opponents in each of the past four games...The Wildcats dropped back-to-back games for the first time this season...UNH moves to 4-1-0 against nationally-ranked opponents...UNH scored on the power play for the second-straight game...Sophomore goalie Brian Foster (Pembroke, N.H.) lost his first decision of the season (2-1-1).

**Northeastern:** Northeastern extended its unbeaten streak to eight games (6-0-2) with the tie against Union. It's the team's longest since an identical 6-0-2 unbeaten streak from Nov. 22-Dec. 28, 1997. The last time NU had a longer unbeaten streak was a 12-game winning streak from Nov. 25, 1980-Jan. 20, 1981...With a goal against Union, sophomore Randy Guzior (Lemont, Ill.) has a 5-4-9 scoring line, surpassing his season point total of eight (6-2-8) from last season...NU goalie Brad Thiessen allowed just one goal on 27 shots against Union, marking the fourth time he has allowed just one goal this season. NU is 3-0-1 in those games...The Union game was Northeastern's eighth comeback of the season. The Huskies are 7-3-1 when their opponent scores first...Northeastern is 3-0-1 on the road this season.

**Providence College:** After starting the season with four consecutive losses, the Friars have gone 6-2-2 in their last 10 games, including three consecutive wins...PC's eight goals against Brown was its highest goal total since November 3, 2002 when the Friars posted an 8-1 win over Princeton...The win over Brown also marked the second consecutive shutout win for PC goalie Tyler Sims who has achieved the feat twice and is the only Friar goalie to do so...The Friars, who scored 16 power-play goals last season, have already scored 16 goals on the man advantage through 14 games this season.

**Vermont:** Vermont is 16-for-17 (.941) on the penalty kill during its last four games...The Catamounts are 0-0-3 in overtime this season following a 2-2 tie against No. 12 Harvard last Saturday. UVM is 6-3-17 in its last 26 overtime contests...Vermont has played a total of 27 ranked opponents since the start of last season...UVM continues a five-game home stand against St. Lawrence this weekend and has sold out 65 consecutive games at Gutterson Fieldhouse...The Catamounts and Saints will be meeting for the 83rd time. Vermont has faced St. Lawrence more than any school in program history.
