## NORTHEASTERN EXTENDS UNBEATEN STREAK TO 11 GAMES ~ Wildcats take out Merrimack; BU and UVM skate to 2-2 draw~

**WAKEFIELD, Mass.** – No. 11 Northeastern University continues to take its unbeaten streak up another notch, as they extended the school's second longest streak to 11 games (9-0-2) with the 7-3 victory against Maine on Friday night at Alfond Arena. No. 9 New Hampshire downed Merrimack College, 1-0, on Friday night at Lawler Arena, while Boston University and Vermont played to a 2-2 deadlock on Saturday night at Agganis Arena. In non-league action, the Black Bears defeated Rensselaer, 4-2, at the Portland Civic Center on Sunday, while the Warriors posted a 4-2 victory against Army on Sunday night in North Andover.

The Huskies were once again led by Hockey East Player of the Week Joe Vitale (St. Louis, Mo.), who tied a career-high with four points (1g, 3a) in NU's victory at Maine. Vitale won the award for a league-high third time this season. Sophomore netminder Brad Thiessen (Aldergrove, B.C.) picked up his 10th win of the season in his 16th start with a 20-save effort against the Black Bears. Huskies' freshman Wade MacLeod (Coquitlam, B.C.) tallied two third period goals, including the game-winner in NU's four goal third period. Maine came away with its fourth non-league win of the season on Sunday with the help of Rob Bellamy (Westfield, Mass.) and Jeff Marshall (Kyle, Sask.). Bellamy had two assists against the Engineers, while Marshall recorded the game-winning goal at the halfway mark of the final period.

UNH kept pace with NU in the conference standings on Friday night, picking up its seventh league win of the season, thanks to the first career goal by freshman forward Phil DeSimone (East Amherst, N.Y.) and a 34-save effort by senior goaltender Kevin Regan (South Boston, Mass.). The Wildcats are 8-1-1 in the last 10 games against the Warriors. New Hampshire lost a 6-5 decision to ECAC foe St. Lawrence at the Whittemore Center on Sunday afternoon, while No. 14 Boston College lost to No. 8 Clarkson, 4-2, at Cheel Arena. BC junior forward Nathan Gerbe (Oxford, Mich.) extended his point streak to six games with 20 points (11g, 9a) in that span.

Merrimack's Andrew Braithwaite (Kingston, Ont) had 25 stops on Friday vs. UNH and then turned away 19 shots by the Black Knights on Sunday. Sophomore forward J.C. Robitaille (Des Ruisseaux, Que.) potted a career-high two goals, including the game-winner for the Warriors seventh victory of the season. Merrimack College own unblemished 4-0-1 record in non-conference games this season.

Freshman forward Jack Downing (New Canaan, Conn.) helped get the Catamounts a point out of Saturday's contest with a two-goal effort on the night. Senior goalie Joe Fallon (Bemidji, Minn.) made 36 stops in the tie, including 17 stops in the final period against the Terriers. Senior forward Bryan Ewing (Plymouth, Mass.) scored his team leading ninth goal of the season for BU, while senior goaltender Karson Gillespie (Mankota, Sask.) played a solid game with a 22-save performance in his seventh start of the season.

## TEAM NOTES

**Boston College:** Boston College's 4-2 loss at Clarkson snapped the Eagles' five-game winning streak and extended the Golden Knights winning-streak against the Eagles to 10 games... BC's power play went 0-for-5, marking the first time in 15 games that the team failed to score a power play goal... Junior Nathan Gerbe (Oxford, Mich.) and freshman Brian Gibbons (Braintree, Mass.) both extended their point-scoring streaks to six games. Gerbe has registered 20 points (11g,9a). Gibbons has totaled seven points (1g,6a). Junior Benn Ferriero (Essex, Mass.) extended his point-scoring streak to five games (3-7-10)... Freshman forward Joe Whitney (Reading, Mass.) recorded his 20th assist (in 28 games) in the team's loss at Clarkson. Whitney is the nation's leader in assists per game (1.11) and owns a four-game scoring streak with nine points during that time (1g,8a).

**Boston University:** In its 12 conference games this season, BU has scored 15 first-period goals. This comes after recording only 14 tallies all of last season in the opening stanza during league play (27 games)... Freshman Colin Wilson (Winnipeg, Man.) tied for the tournament lead with six goals at the 2008 World Junior Championship. He scored his half-dozen goals on just 15 shots and led all players in power-play tallies with four... Wilson and sophomore Brian Strait (Waltham, Mass.) will return from the World Juniors to rejoin the Terrier lineup against Maine on Saturday (Jan. 12). BU boasts a six-game unbeaten streak (5-0-1) against the Black Bears.

**Maine:** Maine has currently killed off 23 straight penalties... Maine's defeated Rensselaer on Sunday afternoon in a game played at the Cumberland County Civic Center in Portland, Maine... The Black Bears are currently undefeated in their last 11 games played Portland... Maine scored a pair of short-handed goals on Sunday against RPI... Tim Whitehead's team is 6-0-0 this season when scoring the first goal of the game and they own a 7-1-1 record when scoring three or more goals.

**Massachusetts:** UMass has won three of the last five meetings against UNH... The power play has been clicking over the last 3 games converting 6-of-17 chances (.353)... UMass ranks No. 2 in Hockey East in scoring defense and No. 11 nationally (2.24 g/game)... James Marcou (King Park, N.Y.) ranks second in HEA and sixth nationally in rookie scoring (1.06 pts/game)... UMass is 5-1-1 this year vs. ranked teams and 4-0-1 against Top-10 teams... UMass is 4-0-3 this year at home and unbeaten in the last 13 home games (9-0-4) dating back to last season. The Minutemen are 22-7-6 in their last 35 home games... UMass is undefeated this season when scoring three or more goals (9-0-2)... Massachusetts owns a 40-0-1 in the last 41 games when scoring 4+ goals... Massachusetts received its highest ever ranking in a national poll last week with a No. 5 ranking.

**UMass-Lowell:** Ranked 14th in the nation, the River Hawks have won five straight and seven of eight... UML's 9-4-4 record is the fifth best record for the program through 17 games since becoming a Division I program in 1983-84... The River Hawks penalty kill has killed 18 straight, 29 of the last 30, and ranks first in Hockey East (fifth in the nation) at 90%... UML plays 11 of its next 13 games at the Tsongas Arena, where it is 6-1-1 on the season... The River Hawks return to action January 11

at Providence for the first of a home-and-home with the Friars. Saturday's River Hawk-Friar game at the Tsongas Arena has been moved to 4:00 p.m.

**Merrimack:** Merrimack improved to 4-0-1 against non-conference opponents this season with a 4-1 win over Army... The Warriors snapped a six-game winless streak (0-5-1) with Sunday's win... Joe Cucci made his collegiate debut Friday, tallying his first goal and adding an assist against Army Sunday... Francois Ouimet's (Lorraine, Que.) goal on Sunday marked the 38th of the season for Merrimack, one more than they scored all of last season... The win over Army was the first game all season the Warriors earned at least a point that neither Rob Ricci (Brampton, Ont.), nor Matt Jones (Kentwood, Mich.) scored or assisted on a goal... Merrimack dominated in the face-off circle against the Black Knights, winning 44 of 62 draws... Playing Army for the first time since Nov. 13, 1998, the Warriors have won nine straight dating back to Dec. 6, 1991.

**New Hampshire:** Senior goalie Kevin Regan (South Boston, Mass.) notched his second consecutive shutout against a Hockey East foe stopping 34 shots in a win over Merrimack on Friday night. The senior netminder has not allowed a goal in league play in 135:39... The Wildcats have scored a power-play goal in each of the last three games... UNH is trying to win three consecutive league games for the first time this season... Freshmen Danny Vranek and Phil DeSimone each netted their first collegiate goals over the weekend... The Wildcats have earned at least two points in league play in all but one weekend this season.

**Northeastern:** The Huskies' 11-game unbeaten streak (9-0-2) is the second longest in school history behind a 12-game unbeaten streak from Nov. 25, 1980-Jan. 20, 1981... Joe Vitale earned the second four-point game of his career on Jan. 4. He also registered four points (1g,3a) on Jan. 23, 2007 at Boston College... The most recent Huskies to have more than four points in a game, were Mike Morris (2-4-6) and Jason Guerriero (2-3-5), who accomplished the feat on March 5, 2005 at Massachusetts... The Huskies' 7-3 win over Maine on Jan. 4 marked only the fourth time all season the Huskies have scored first. The team is 8-3-1 when its opponent scores first.

**Providence College:** The Friars have averaged 49.5 shots per game over the last four games, while holding opponents to 24.0 shots per contest... Providence College owns a 7-3-2 record over their last 12 games after starting the season with a 0-4 record... Junior defenseman Matt Taormina (Washington Township, Mich.) has 17 points this season (5g,12a) is one shy of matching the total from his first two seasons at Providence College.

**Vermont:** Vermont finished the regular season series 1-1-1 against Boston University... Four of the last five games for the Catamounts have gone to overtime. UVM is 1-0-5 in overtime this season and 7-3-19 in its last 29 overtime contests... Senior Joe Fallon has a 2.21 goals against average and 71 saves in the last three games after going 28 days between starts... UVM has gone 36-for-39 (.923) on the penalty kill in the last eight games... BC will host UVM for a two-game series on Wednesday and Friday at Conte Forum. Vermont tied Boston College 3-3 in this season's first meeting at Gutterson Fieldhouse on Oct. 21... The Catamounts are 2-0-1 in the last three meetings with the Eagles.
