UNH SWEEPS UMASS TO MOVE INTO SOLE POSSESSION OF FIRST ~ BC sweeps UVM; PC/UML split OT games; NU/Merrimack split; BU wins at Maine~

WAKEFIELD, Mass. – No. 8 ranked New Hampshire pulled off a weekend sweep of No. 5 Massachusetts, as the teams kicked off the Hockey East Friday Night package on NESN in Amherst at the Mullins Center. No. 12 Boston College took out Vermont in two games at Conte Forum to stay on pace with the top half of the league. No. 13 UMass-Lowell and Providence skated hard in two one-goal overtime games and Merrimack took one game from No. 7 Northeastern in the two-game home-and-home series. Boston University won at Maine on Saturday night in a single-game at Alford Arena.

The Wildcats pulled off three unanswered goals on Friday night to take a 3-2 win from the Minutemen and then were victorious on Saturday night, 5-3, at the Whittemore Center. Freshman James vanRiemsdyk (Middletown, N.J.) amassed four points (2g, 2a) in his return to the UNH lineup, after missing five straight games for the World Juniors. Senior goaltender Kevin Regan (South Boston, Mass.) had another strong weekend with 68 saves in two contests, including 37 stops on Saturday night. Regan tied Mike Ayers' school record of 58 wins on Saturday night at Towse Rink.

Boston College downed Vermont, 4-1 on Wednesday night and then defeated the Catamounts again at Conte Forum, 5-2 on Saturday. Junior forward Nathan Gerbe (Oxford, Mich.) extended his goal scoring streak to eight games and has amassed 25 points (12g, 13a) in that time. Gerbe leads the league in scoring with 34 points.

The Friars took the first game of the series from the River Hawks on Friday, 4-3, thanks to a overtime game-winner by senior captain Jon Rheault (Deering, N.H.), as he scored just 46 seconds into the extra session. On Saturday, UMass-Lowell evened up the weekend with a 3-2 overtime victory of its own at Tsongas Arena. Freshman forward Scott Campbell (Navan, Ont.) potted the overtime goals with just two seconds remaining on the clock.

Merrimack College took out Northeastern on Friday night, 4-2, at Lawler Arena and then Northeastern shutout Merrimack on Saturday night at Matthews Arena to get the split. The Warriors got two goals from J.C. Robitaille (Des Ruisseaux, Que.) in the victory, which included the game-winner. Sophomore goalie Brad Thiessen (Aldergrove, B.C.) recorded 22 saves in his first shutout of the season and with the win he earned his career-high 11th win of the season for the Huskies.

Boston University extended its unbeaten streak to four games (3-0-1) with a 3-1 win against Maine on Saturday night at Alford Arena. Senior captain Pete MacArthur (Clifton Park, N.Y.) had a game-high three points (3a) for the Terriers. Sophomore netminder Brett Bennett (Williamsville, N.Y.) picked up his fifth win of the season in 11 starts for BU.

Andrew Braithwaite, MC (So., Kingston, Ont.) Stopped 53 of 58 shots in two games against #7 Northeastern, improving his record to 4-3 on the season.

Scott Campbell, UML (Fr., F, Navan, Ont.) Had back-to-back two-point games over the weekend against Providence. Campbell was also a plus-2 with five shots on goal.

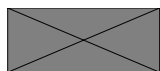

TEAM NOTES

Boston College: With two power-play goals against Vermont on Friday, BC recorded multiple man-advantage tallies for the eighth game this season and improved its overall conversion rate to 25.7 percent (27-for-105), which marks the No. 1 ranking in the nation...Junior Nathan Gerbe (Oxford, Mich.) has recorded 99 points – 54 goals and 45 assists – in 99 collegiate games. He leads the nation in points per game (1.79) and goals per game (0.95)...The Eagles have won seven of their last eight games and have outscored their opponents 42-16 during this stretch...Junior Benn Ferriero (Essex, Mass.) is tied for sixth among all players in the nation in assists per game (0.85)...Brock Bradford scored his first goal of the season on Wednesday and tallied his first career shorthanded goal on Friday.

Boston University: BU, which is undefeated since the holiday break (2-0-1), continues a stretch of four games in eight days when it wraps up its non-conference home schedule against Dartmouth on Tuesday before visiting Merrimack and Boston College next weekend...Senior forward Bryan Ewing has earned first-star honors in each of BU's last three contests...The Terriers now have a four-game win streak at Maine's Alford Arena for the first time since winning six straight there from January 1982 to February 1986...Senior Pete MacArthur has recorded at least one point in 11 of the last 12 games with seven goals and 14 assists during the stretch...Freshman Colin Wilson (Winnipeg, Man.) is riding a five-game point streak, during which he has tallied a pair of goals and five assists.

Maine: Maine continued its penalty killing streak, holding Boston University scoreless in five power play chances on Saturday night...The Black Bears have now killed 28 straight penalties...Maine's freshmen Lem Randall (Snow Lake Man.), Keif Orsini and Robby Dee (Plymouth, Monn.) have combined to score three goals and add two assists for five points in the last three games for Maine...Maine has seven game-winning goals and all seven have been scored by different players...Ben Bishop (Des Peres, Mo.) had 27 saves against BU, giving him 1941 for his career, tying Jim Tortorella (1977-81) for fifth place on Maine's all-time saves list...Maine has had 18 different players scored a goal this season.

Massachusetts: UMass last loss back-to-back games last season on Feb. 3 and Feb. 9 against UMass Lowell and Boston University. Since that point UMass is 17-8-6 after Saturday night's loss...With the loss, UMass falls to 9-1-2 this year when scoring three or more goals in a game...UMass trailed by three goals after the second period for the first time this season...The five goals allowed was a season-high for UMass...After entering the weekend 6-for-17 (.353) on the power play, UMass has gone 1-for-11 (.091) in the two games this weekend.

UMass-Lowell: The River Hawks, ranked 13th in the nation, are 8-2-0 in their last 10 games...UML and PC split the weekend home-and-home series and the season series (1-1-1)...Each game of the season series, and six of the last 11 meeting between Providence and UMass Lowell have gone to overtime...UML's overtime victory Saturday was its first since January 15, 2006, also against Providence...Neither team was whistled for a penalty in Saturday's game, the first time in UML history where no penalties were called in a game...UML's line of Scott Campbell (2g, 2a), Mark Roebathan (1g, 2a) and Mike Potacco (1g, 2a) totaled 10 points (4g, 6a) in the two games against the Friars. In 10 games, the line has scored 34 points (16g, 18a). Campbell has three straight multiple point games. Roebathan has a nine-game point streak where he has 13 points (7g, 6a)...The River Hawks six-game home stand continues this weekend as they host Boston College Friday (7:30, NESN) and Massachusetts Saturday (7:00).

Merrimack: Merrimack's 4-2 victory over Northeastern on Friday marked the first time they beat the Huskies since Feb. 20, 2004, and it was just the Warriors' second victory over the Huskies in the last 11 outings...The victory was Merrimack's first win over an opponent ranked as high as seventh nationally since defeating then seventh-ranked Vermont 4-2 on January 27, 2006...Defenders Pat Bowen (Marshfield, Mass.) and Fraser Allan each notched their first collegiate goals in the win...Andrew Braithwaite has started four straight games, giving him seven on the season...The Warriors are 5-4-0 at home this season...Merrimack is outscoring its opponents 18-to-nine in the third period...Rob Ricci (Brampton, Ontario) was 17-for-25 on draws on Saturday.

New Hampshire: UNH and netminder Kevin Regan have won four-in-a-row in Hockey East play. On Saturday, Kevin Regan recorded 37 saves, including 17 in the third period, to tie the University of New Hampshire career victories benchmark of 58...A UNH freshman has scored in each of the last five games...James vanRiemsdyk made a memorable return from the World Juniors with two goals and two assists during the weekend...The Wildcats hand UMass its first loss at Mullins Center this season and back-to-back losses for the first time as well...UNH has sole possession of first place for the first time this season.

Northeastern: After scoring first only twice in their first 14 games of the season, the Huskies have scored first in each of their last four games...Northeastern scored two power-play goals in its 3-0 win over Merrimack on Saturday, ending a six-game power-play drought...Brad Thiessen posted his first shutout of the season with 22 saves against Merrimack on Saturday...Senior Jimmy Russo (So. Weymouth, Mass.) has eight points (5-3-8) over his last eight games...David Strathman (Tempe, Ariz.) scored his first goal of the season and the first game-winner of his career on Saturday against Merrimack...NU's loss to Merrimack on Friday ended the team's 11-game, 9-0-2 unbeaten streak, which was second-longest in school history. It was NU's first loss since Nov. 2.

Providence College: PC's overtime win over UMass Lowell on Friday was their first overtime win since January 13, 2007 when PC defeated the River Hawks at Tsongas Arena...The Friars' 17 power-play goals this season has already eclipsed last season's total of 16...The Friars' had no penalties in Saturday's game which marks the first time since January 5, 1988 that PC was not penalized...Senior Jon Rheault (Deering, N.H.) has 13 points (nine goals, four assists) in the last eight games...The Friars are 5-4-0 against ranked opponents this season.

Vermont: Including the two games against No. 11 Boston College last week, Vermont is in the midst of eight straight games against opponents ranked in the top-15 in the latest USCHO.com/CSTV poll (as of 1/14)...The Catamounts will also play No. 5 New Hampshire, No. 9 Northeastern, No. 10 Massachusetts and No. 15 UMass-Lowell in the stretch...Vermont has lost eight straight games at Kelley Rink against Boston College...Freshman Jack Downing (New Canaan, Conn.) has four goals in the last six games...Vermont hosts a two-game series against Northeastern at Gutterson Fieldhouse this weekend ... Kevin Sneddon is 6-2-2 against the Huskies since being named head coach at UVM...Senior goalie Joe Fallon (Bemidji, Minn.) has 1.22 goals against average and four shutouts in eight career starts against Northeastern.
