VERMONT TAKES THREE POINTS FROM NO. 10 NORTHEASTERN

~ BC/BU earn three points; Maine shuts out Providence; Friars down UMass~

WAKEFIELD, Mass. – The Vermont Catamounts took three points from No. 10 Northeastern over the weekend with a 2-2 tie at Gutterson Fieldhouse on Friday and a 5-2 victory on Saturday in Burlington. No. 11 Boston College also continued to keep pace with New Hampshire at the top of the standings, as it took three points on the weekend. Maine also got back on the winning track with a 4-0 shutout of Providence on Saturday night. Boston University also evened its league record for the first time this season with a victory on Friday night at Merrimack.

The Catamounts were led by Peter Lenex (Shelburne, Vt.), who scored the game-winning goal in the third frame, as both teams combined to score five goals in the final period on Saturday night. Senior goalie Joe Fallon (Bemidji, Minn.) picked up his fourth victory of the season for UVM. On Friday, junior forward Dean Strong (Mississauga, Ont.) score the game-tying goal with 2:32 left in the game for Vermont. Mike Spillane (Bow, N.H.) made 25 stops in his fourth start of the season, while NU netminder Brad Thiessen (Aldergrove, B.C.) posted 62 saves in the weekend series, including 35 in Friday's tie.

The Eagles had another solid weekend with a 5-4 triumph at UMass-Lowell on Friday night on NESN and on Saturday, they battled to a 2-2 deadlock with arch rival Boston University. Freshman goalie John Muse (East Falmouth, Mass.) had a strong week in net for BC with 70 saves, including 32 saves on Friday and 26 saves vs. the Terriers on Saturday at Conte Forum. Boston University went 1-1-1 on the week and received five-point efforts from seniors Bryan Ewing (Plymouth, Mass.) and Pete MacArthur (Clifton Park, N.Y.). Freshman Colin Wilson (Winnipeg, Man.) notched a career-high four points (1g,3a) in the victory over the Warriors.

Providence earned its sixth league win of the year with a 3-2 victory against No. 9 Massachusetts on Friday at Schneider Arena, but Maine shutout the Friars the next night, 4-0. Sophomore Greg Collins (Hingham, Mass.) scored the shorthanded game-winner for Providence in the second period, while Tyler Sims (Fort Wayne, Ind.) picked up his eighth win of the season with 24 saves. The Black Bears got a 41-save shutout by Ben Bishop (Des Peres, Mo.) on Saturday for his first blanking of the season. Senior forward Wes Clark (Oakville, Ont.) also tallied two points (1g,1a) for Maine.

Merrimack College remained undefeated in non-conference play (5-0-1) with a 4-3 win at Brown on Sunday. Junior forward Rob Ricci (Brampton, Ont.) registered a league-high six points (2g,4a) on the week and freshman Chris Barton (Calgary, Alb.) added five points (2g,3a) over the weekend. No. 5 New Hampshire lost to Dartmouth, 5-3 on Saturday night at the Verizon Wireless Arena in Manchester, despite outshooting the Big Green, 57-26 for the game.

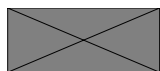

TEAM NOTES

Boston College: With two power-play goals against Boston University, BC improved its conversion percentage to 25.9 percent, which ranks No. 1 nationally. The Eagles' power-play unit has scored in 18-of-21 games and has registered two-man advantage tallies nine times...The Eagles are unbeaten in their last four games, all against Hockey East opponents and are 8-1-1 in their last 10 games...BC concluded the league regular-season series against BU with a 2-0-1 record. The BC senior class has faced off against BU 18 times and owns a record of 10-7-1...Freshman forward Joe Whitney (Reading, Mass.), who has tallied at least one point in 16 of BC's 21 games, has 30 points (6g) and a team-high 24 assists. He ranks No. 1 nationally in assists per game (1.09) and ranks second among all collegiate freshmen in points per game (1.36).

Boston University: The Terriers have scored at least one goal in 24 of their last 26 periods on the road (excluding overtimes)...BU and St. Lawrence are the only two sub-.500 teams in the country which have a positive scoring margin this season...The Terriers are just 1-11-4 on the year when they score four or fewer goals and last year they owned a 18-10-9 record scoring four goals or less...The road team in BU and New Hampshire's series is 8-0-4 in league play since the beginning of the 2003-04 season (excluding the Wildcats' 4-3 neutral-site victory at Verizon Wireless Arena on Nov. 5, 2004). The two teams close out their season series with a home-and-home set this weekend.

Maine: Ben Bishop made 41 saves on Saturday night at Providence to record his first shutout of the season and fourth of his career...Three of his four shutout have come against the Providence Friars...The win was the 50th of Bishop's career...He becomes just the fifth goalie in Maine history to win 50 games...Bishop also recorded his second assist of the season in the game...The shutout was Maine's first since blanking Merrimack 3-0 on February 23, 2007...Maine posted a 3.12 grade point average last semester, the highest in team history. Twenty players recorded a 3.0 or higher with six players having a 3.5 or higher...Maine is 7-0-0 this season when scoring the first goal of the game.

Massachusetts: UMass fell for the fourth consecutive game with Saturday's loss. It's the longest streak since UMass lost six straight from Oct. 21, 2005 to Nov. 11, 2005...With UMass scoring the first goal of the game at UMass Lowell, the Minutemen fall to 5-2-1 when scoring first...The UMass power play was held scoreless against Providence/UMass Lowell going 0-for-10...UMass had killed 14-of-15 power plays until UMass Lowell scored twice in the third period on extra-man opportunities...UMass' nine points over the weekend were scored by nine different skaters.

UMass-Lowell: The River Hawks are 7-3-0 over their last 10 games overall and have garnered points in six of their last nine Hockey East games...UML is unbeaten in 10 of 16 games when trailing at any point during the game over the last two years (6-6-4) and is 4-2-3 this year when allowing the game's first goal...Last season Lowell was 1-15-3 when surrendering the first goal...The River Hawks are 13-4-2 over their last 18 games when scoring three goals or more, and 15-1-3 over the last 19 games when allowing two goals or less...UML's penalty kill, ranked first in Hockey East and seventh in the nation, has killed 40 of 43 over the last 12 games...The PK hasn't allowed more than one power play goal in a game this season...The River Hawks scored two power play goals in each game over the weekend, the first back-to-back multiple power play goal games for UML since a home-and-home series with Merrimack on February 17-18, 2006...Maury Edwards had a goal in each game over the weekend, and is the first River Hawks defenseman to score five goals in a season since Cleve Kinley netted eight in the 2004-05 season.

Merrimack: Chris Barton tallied two goals in a 6-4 loss to BU Friday for his first career multi-goal game and followed up with three assists, a career high on Sunday at Brown. Barton's power-play goal snapped a 0-for-14 drought dating back to December 30th when the Warriors scored two power-play goals at BU...Rob Ricci posted points on six of Merrimack's eight goals this week...The Warriors scored four or more goals in two straight games for the first time since November 6th and 12th of 2004 (5-4 win over UMass, 6-4 loss at BU)...Merrimack is 5-0-1 in non-conference games this season, with one game remaining...Defenseman Joe Loprieno (Bloomingdale, Ill.) scored a goal in his last two games for his first two of the season.

New Hampshire: The Wildcats had a season-high 57 shots vs. Dartmouth, including 29 shots in the second period. Defensemen Craig Switzer (Peachland, B.C.) and Kevin Kapstad (Boxboro, Mass.) each tallied goals for the Wildcats on Saturday night. Kapstad has scored goals in back-to-back games...Freshman forward James vanRiemsdyk (Middletown, N.J.) scored a goal for the third-straight game. Since his return to the line up, vanRiemsdyk has three goals and two assists (five points) in three games...UNH finished non-conference play 4-3 overall, but just 1-2 against ECAC foes.

Northeastern: Northeastern split the season series with Vermont, 1-1-1. It's the second Hockey East series Northeastern has completed after going 2-1-0 against New Hampshire...Northeastern was outshot in back-to-back games for just the second time this season against Vermont (37-27 on Friday and 32-18 on Saturday). The only other time that happened was against Boston University on Nov. 10 (37-23) and New Hampshire on Nov. 16 (38-23). This season, Northeastern has outshot its opponent 12 times, been outshot five times and had equal shots three times. Last season, Northeastern was outshot in 28 of 36 games...Goalie Brad Thiessen (Aldergrove, B.C.) is undefeated at 7-0-3 when allowing two goals or less...Northeastern is 10-2-3 over its last 15 games.

Providence College: - Tyler Sims' start in net on Friday was the 100th appearance of his career. He now has 101 career appearances, eight shy of tying a school mark, which was set by Dan Dennis (1993-97)...Sophomore Greg Collins scored his first career short-handed goal, which proved to be the game winner versus UMass on Friday. In all, the Friars have seven short-handed tallies, which is tied for the national lead...Freshman Matt Germain (Rockland, Mass.) scored his first career goal in the win over UMass.

Vermont: Vermont matched a season-high five goals in Saturday's victory against Northeastern...The Catamounts are unbeaten in 34 straight games when registering at least four goals...UVM also tied NU on Friday to earn three points in a weekend series for the first time since sweeping Boston College at Gutterson Fieldhouse last season (Jan 19 & 20)...Brayden Irwin's short-handed goal on Saturday was the first for the Catamounts since Torrey Mitchell had one at St. Lawrence last season (Dec. 16, 2006)...Senior Joe Fallon made 16 saves on Saturday to pick up his first win since Nov. 20 in a 4-2 win against UMass. Fallon is 6-1-2 with a 1.31 goals against average in his career against the Huskies...Sophomore goalie Mike Spillane started in net in Friday's tie and made 25 saves...Only UNH and Boston College, who are tied for first-place in Hockey East, have fewer losses than Vermont in league play...Vermont travels to UMass for a two-game series this weekend...Junior co-captain Dean Strong had a goal and three assists in UVM's 4-2 win over UMass earlier this season.
