## PROVIDENCE TAKES THREE MORE POINTS IN LEAGUE PLAY ~BU, UNH, NU, UML, UVM earn wins; 56th Beanpot opens Monday~

**WAKEFIELD, Mass.** – No. 13 Providence College gained ground on New Hampshire and Boston College atop the league standings, as it took three points over the weekend. The Friars downed No. 9 Boston College, 3-2 on Friday night at Conte Forum and then tied Merrimack, 1-1, on Saturday night at Lawler Arena in North Andover.

Junior defenseman Matt Taormina (Washington Township, Mich.) scored the game-winner for the Friars in the third period against the Eagles, while senior goalie Tyler Sims (Fort Wayne, Ind.) made 36 stops in the victory. Sophomore goalie Andrew Brathwaite (Kingston, Ont.) turned away a career-high 50 shots on Saturday for the Warriors.

No. 7 New Hampshire earned a 5-1 win at Vermont on Friday night, creating a three-point cushion ahead of the Eagles. Senior Matt Fornataro (Calgary, Alb.) scored two goals for the Wildcats, including the game-winner, while classmate Kevin Regan (South Boston, Mass.) earned his 14th win of the season in goal. UVM freshman blueliner Kyle Medvec (Burnsville, Md.) tallied his first career goal on Friday night vs. the Wildcats.

The Catamounts picked up a 3-2 win against UMass-Lowell on Sunday afternoon at Gutterson Fieldhouse. Senior goalie Joe Fallon (Bemidji, Minn.) stopped 31 shots, including 14 shots by the River Hawks in the second period. Sophomore Viktor Stålberg (Gothenburg, Sweden) scored the game clinching goal for UVM. UMass-Lowell opened the weekend with a 3-2 win against the Black Bears at Tsongas Arena on Friday night. Sophomore forward Ben Holmstrom (Colorado Springs, Colo.) had a four-point weekend (1g,3a) for the River Hawks, while Jonathan Maniff (Revere, Mass.) had the game-winning goal with 23 seconds left in regulation on Friday vs. the Black Bears. Senior Wes Clark (Oakville, Ont.) totaled both goals for the Black Bears on Friday vs. UML.

Boston University and Northeastern headed into the Beanpot on a winning note with victories on Friday. The Huskies shut out UMass, 1-0 at Matthews Arena on a goal by sophomore forward Randy Guzior (Lemont, Ill.) and a 22-save effort from Brad Thiessen (Aldergrove, B.C.). The Terriers downed Merrimack, 4-1, at Agganis Arena. Freshman Nick Bonino (Unionville, Conn.) had two points (1g,1a) in the game, while Brett Bennett (Williamsville, N.Y.) registered his seventh win of the season.

Freshman forward James Marcou (Kings Park, N.Y.) scored three points (1g,2a) in the 5-3 win over Maine on Saturday night at the Mullins Center. Junior goalie Ben Bishop (Des Peres, Mo.) made 49 saves for the Black Bears in the losing cause.

Tonight's opening round of the 56th annual Beanpot Tournament features three Hockey East schools at the TD Banknorth Garden, with Northeastern and ECAC foe Harvard pairing off in the first match up at 5 p.m., while Boston College and Boston University meet in the nightcap (8 p.m.). Both games will be televised live on NESN.

## TEAM NOTES

**Boston College:** BC's 3-2 home loss to Providence on Friday marked the first PC victory over BC in Kelley Rink since Jan. 24, 2003. With two league contests against Providence remaining, BC's senior class is 5-2-3 against the Friars...Senior alternate captain Matt Greene (Plymouth, Mass.) scored his career-high eighth goal of the season against Providence. He has scored one goal in each of the last three games and has scored four times in the last five games...Junior Kyle Kucharski (Saugus, Mass.) scored his first goal of the season against Providence (2/1). Kucharski's goal marked his first since March 25, 2007 when he scored BC's third goal in a 4-0 win over Miami in the NCAA Tournament quarterfinal-round in Manchester, N.H...Senior captain Mike Brennan (Smithtown, N.Y.) played in his 149th collegiate game and is tied with Andrew Alberts, Bill Cass, Chris Masters, Scott Harlow and Ken Hemenway for 29th on the school's all-time list...Junior forward Benn Ferriero (Essex, Mass.) enter's Monday's first-round Beanpot game with 98 career points (48g,50a) in 109 career games.

**Boston University:** The Terriers swept Merrimack for the fourth straight season...Five of BU's last seven goals have come from the freshman class, as the group has now accumulated 68 points (22g, 46a) so far this season...BU has scored 30 second-period goals this season, already matching its middle-stanza output from last year...The Terriers, who have won 11 of the last 13 Beanpots, will aim for their fourth straight title at the annual tournament, beginning with a first-round match-up against Boston College. BU is 25-2 in the first round when it comes in as the defending champion.

**Maine:** Maine's Ben Bishop made a career-high 49 saves on Saturday night at UMass, three more than his previous high of 46 set earlier this season at Denver. Bishop currently has 2,115 career saves which ranks third on Maine's all-time saves list behind just Scott King (2,463) and Blair Allison (2,213)...Maine defenseman Bret Tyler (Maynard, Mass.) is leading the team in scoring. The last time a Maine defenseman led the team in scoring was during the 1994-95 season when Jeff Tory led Maine in points...For the first time this season on Saturday at UMass, Maine scored first and lost the game. Maine is 7-1-1 this season when scoring first...The Black Bears have scored a pair of power play goals in two of its last four games. Prior to that, Maine had two power play goals in a game just once in its first 20 games of the season.

**Massachusetts:** Massachusetts scored five goals against Maine, the first time since defeating Colorado College on Dec. 30 that UMass had scored five goals in a game...It marked the fifth time that the Minutemen had scored five goals in a game this season and UMass is now 5-0-0 in those games...UMass committed just five penalties for the weekend...UMass' 54 shots against Maine were the second-most of the season...The Minutemen are now 41-1-1 in the last 43 games where the Minutemen score four or more goals.

**UMass-Lowell:** The River Hawks have garnered points in seven of their last 11 Hockey East games after going 1-1-0 over the weekend...UML snapped an 0-for-21 skid on the power play with a man-advantage marker in the second period against Vermont Sunday afternoon...Friday's victory over Maine marked the first time since the 1985-86 season (excluding forfeits - UML won two games in Feb. 1994 via forfeit)...Jonathan Maniff's game-winning goal at 19:37 of the third period Friday night was the second time this season the River Hawks have won a game in the closing seconds of a period. Scott Campbell (Navan, Ont.) netted the game-winner against Providence with 1.3

seconds remaining in overtime on Jan. 12...Ben Holmstrom extend his point streak to three games over the weekend.

**Merrimack:** Andrew Braithwaite became the first Hockey East goaltender to make 50 saves this season in a 1-1 tie against Providence...Braithwaite has started nine straight games, posting a 4-4-1 record, a 2.21 goals-against and a .925 save percentage...Merrimack was outshot 83-36 in two games this week...Chris Kane (Irvine, Calif.) picked up his first assist this season on Francois Ouimet's (Lorraine, Que.) goal against PC...The Warriors are 3-1-1 in their last five home games...The 1-1 tie with Providence was Merrimack's first home overtime game this season...Defenseman Grant Farrell (Calgary, Alb.), who earned his ninth assist Saturday, is third on the Warriors in assists and tops in assists and points among blueliners.

**New Hampshire:** Since Dec. 1, Kevin Regan is 7-0-0 against Hockey East foes with a 1.57 GAA, two shutouts and no more than three goals allowed in a single contest...The Wildcats become the first team in Hockey East to record wins over all other conference foes...UNH has 39 third period goals, which is nine more than their next closest competitor in Hockey East. Overall UNH has scored 45.3 percent of its goals in the third period...UNH has scored three or more goals in the last seven games including five goals on three different occasions...With a pair of points on Friday night, Mike Radja (Yorkville, Ill.) now sits just one point away from becoming the 67th member of the century club...UNH has potted six power-play goals in the last five games...Matt Fornataro has scored in four-straight games with seven points (3g, 4a) during that stretch.

**Northeastern:** Northeastern plays Harvard in the Beanpot Tournament semifinals on Monday. NU has beaten Harvard in its last four Beanpot semifinals meetings for each of the Huskies' last four Beanpot final appearances. Northeastern is 9-3-0 in its last 12 Beanpot games against Harvard. The Huskies last won the Beanpot in 1988...Northeastern topped Massachusetts, 1-0, on Friday night for its first win since shutting out Merrimack, 3-0, on Jan. 12...Brad Thiessen's shutout on Friday gave him six in his collegiate career, just one shy of Keni Gibson's NU-record seven career shutouts...Sophomore Randy Guzior scored his team-leading ninth goal of the season on Friday. His 9-5-14 scoring line this season has already surpassed his 6-2-8 line from his freshman year.

**Providence College:** The Friars are on a season best four-game unbeaten streak...The Friars posted their first win at BC's Kelley Rink since January 24, 2003...Nine of PC's 12 wins this season have come against ranked opponents...Junior defenseman Matt Taormina is on a four-game point streak (3g,3a). Taormina's goal against BC was his career-high eighth of the season, which leads the nation among defensemen...The Friars, who had three players reach the 20-point mark last season, already have three players with 20 points or more this season...PC has been outshot in just five of the 24 games this season.

**Vermont:** The Catamounts are 3-1-2 in their last six games...Junior assistant captain Peter Lenes (Shelburne, Vt.) scored his team-high seventh goal of the season in a win on Sunday and he is the team's active career leader in goals scored with 28...Sophomore Viktor Stålberg has recorded a point in five of the last six games and has three goals and seven points in that span...Vermont continues a stretch of 10 straight games against opponents ranked in the top-16 of the USCHO.com/CSTV poll this weekend at No. 13 Providence...Kevin Sneddon is 5-2-1 against the Friars since being named head coach at UVM...Friday's Vermont and Providence game will be televised on CN8 and Saturday's game will be televised on Cox.
