## UMASS-LOWELL SWEEPS NU TO STAY IN HOME ICE HUNT

### ~Two other series split to keep standings tight; UNH, PC take three points~

**WAKEFIELD, Mass.** – UMass-Lowell kept itself in the playoff home ice race with a weekend sweep of Northeastern, while No. 2 New Hampshire and Providence College took three points in their respective series over the weekend. Boston University and Massachusetts split their home-and-home set, while Maine and Vermont split their match up, as all four teams fight for playoff seedings.

The River Hawks remain three points behind fourth-place Boston College and Providence, after a 5-4 overtime win on Friday and a 3-2 victory on Saturday at Matthews Arena. Junior forward Mike Potacco (Kinnelon, N.J.) scored four goals in the weekend set, which included his first career hat trick on Friday night for UMass-Lowell. Sophomore forward Paul Worthington (Langhorne, Pa.) scored the overtime game-winner for the River Hawks on Friday with 1:34 remaining in the extra frame. NU freshman Wade MacLeod (Coquitlam, B.C.) amassed five points in series.

The Friars had a huge three-point weekend vs. No. 8 Boston College, to move even with the Eagles in the standings with 27 points apiece. Freshman Jordan Kreymr (Cloverdale, B.C.) had a career-high two goals in PC's triumph at Conte Forum.

Maine and Vermont ended the weekend with two points apiece, after the Catamounts took the series opener at Gutterson Fieldhouse on Friday, 2-0. The Black Bears rebounded the next night and shutout Vermont, 3-0, to remain in the mix for the final spot in the Hockey East playoffs. Maine junior goalie Ben Bishop (Des Peres, Mo.) made 30 saves in his second shutout of the season Saturday, while senior netminder Joe Fallon (Bemidji, Minn.) shutout the 'Cats with 23 saves on Friday.

Boston University remained in second place along with Vermont after a 3-0 shutout of Massachusetts on Friday night at Agganis Arena in Boston. The Minutemen rebounded the next night and put up five goals on the board against the Terriers at the Mullins Center. Terriers' rookie Nick Bonino (Unionville, Conn.) registered three points (2g,1a) in the win on Friday. Junior forward Cory Quirk (Brockton, Mass.) followed up that effort with a three-point night (2g,2a) on his own on Saturday in Amherst. The Minutemen cling to a two-point lead over the Black Bears for the eighth and final spot.

No. 2 New Hampshire took three points from Merrimack College with a 2-1 win on Friday at the Whittemore Center and a 1-1 deadlock on Saturday at Lawler Arena. The Warriors got two more outstanding efforts from sophomore goalie Andrew Braithwaite (Kingston, Ont.), who tallied 72 stops in the two contest, which included 37 on Friday and 35 on Saturday. Freshman forward Danny Dries scored the game-winner with 5:06 left in the game on Friday night for his 10th goal of the season for the Wildcats.

#### JOE FALLON, UVM (SR., G, BEMIDJI, MINN.)

Recorded the 19th shutout of his career with 23 saves in a 2-0 victory over Maine on Friday. That mark ranks second all-time in NCAA Division I history behind only former Michigan State goalie Ryan Miller, who had 26 shutouts in his career

#### P.J. FENTON, UMASS (LONGMEADOW, MASS.)

Has seven goals and 13 assists in the last 18 games

#### DAVID LEADERER, UMASS (ROCHESTER, N.Y.)

Will set the UMass all-time games played record on March 8. Leaderer will tie the record on Friday and will break Marvin Degon's (2002-06) record of 146 on Saturday

#### UNH'S DEFENSE

## TEAM NOTES

**Boston College:** Senior Joe Adams (Wayzata, Minn.) centered BC's fourth line at Providence on March 1 and totaled one shot. Adams' appearance marked his second appearance of the season, having previously played in a 5-2 loss at New Hampshire on Nov. 9...Saturday's 2-2 tie marked BC's school-record eighth tie of the season, surpassing the previous record of seven ties set during the 2004-05 season when the team finished 26-7-7. It also marked BC's 11th overtime game of the campaign. The Eagles are 2-2-7 in those 11 overtime contests...With one assist in each game, freshman forward Joe Whitney (Reading, Mass.) has registered 41 points (7g,34a). Whitney ranks third on BC's all-time freshman assist list, trailing only Brian Leetch (38; 1986-87) and Ken Hodge (44; 1984-85)...Junior forward Andrew Orpik (East Amherst, N.Y.) scored his sixth goal of the season against Providence on February 29, equaling his combined total of his freshman and sophomore campaigns.

**Boston University:** The Terriers honored former coach Jack Kelley prior to and during Friday's game at Agganis Arena. A bust depicting Kelley in a pose from the 1966 Beanpot was unveiled and will remain in the arena's main concourse. Kelley coached at BU from 1962-72, leading the Terriers to back-to-back national championships in his final two seasons at the helm...BU's seniors and freshmen are tied for the team lead in points by class with 99 each...The Terriers had eight wins in February, their most wins in a month since going a perfect 8-0-0 in February 2002...Junior Matt Gilroy (North Bellmore, N.Y.) posted a +11 rating in February...The Terriers are one win away from securing home ice in the league quarterfinals for the fourth straight season.

**Maine:** Ben Bishop recorded his second shutout of the season on Saturday night with a 3-0 blanking of Vermont...It was the fifth career shutout for Bishop...Billy Ryan recorded his 90th career point on Saturday night at Vermont...Maine seniors scored six of nine points on the weekend at Vermont...The Black Bears are 9-0-0 this season when leading after two periods... Ben Bishop has played 5544:30 minutes in his career which ranks third all-time behind Scott King (5792) and Blair Allison (5789)...Bishop has played in all 32 games for the Black Bears this season...Wes Clark (Oakville, Ont.) has scored Maine's last two game-winning goals.

**Massachusetts:** UMass improves to 42-2-1 in the last 45 games where the Minutemen score four-or-more goals in a game...UMass is now 12-3-2 when scoring 3-or-more goals in a game this season...Saturday's night five-goal explosion was the sixth time UMass has done so this season...Massachusetts is 6-for-29 (.207) on the power play in the last five games and have at least one power play goal in four of the last five games...UMass' win on Saturday night gave the Minutemen their first season series in Hockey East play and marked the first time since joining Hockey East that UMass had won the season series against Boston University.

**UMass-Lowell:** UML's line of Scott Campbell, Mike Potacco and Mark Roebbothan (St. John's, Nfld.) combined for seven points (4g, 3a) in the weekend sweep of Northeastern. Potacco scored all four goals for the line, including netting his first career hat trick in Friday's overtime victory...Friday's overtime win was the River Hawks' second of the season (2-1-4) and just second since January 2006. Lowell was 0-2-7 in overtime last season...UML improved to 15-3-1 when scoring three goals or more and 10-1-0 when leading after two periods with its two victories over the weekend...The River Hawks power play went 2-for-8 against the Huskies and has goals in six of the last eight games.

**Merrimack:** Merrimack must sweep Massachusetts next weekend, while Maine can pick up no more than two points, for the Warriors to make the Hockey East playoffs for the first time since 2003-04...The Warriors became the first team to lead UNH since January 26th after Rob Ricci's first-period goal gave his team the 1-0 lead...Ricci was 25-for-35 on faceoffs Saturday and led all skaters with seven shots...Merrimack surrendered just four goals and one even strength tally in three games this season against UNH, going 0-2-1...Making 16 straight starts, Andrew Braithwaite has a 2.11 goals-against, a .933 save percentage and two shutouts. Braithwaite has stopped 161 of 166 shots in the last four games...Matt Jones (Kentwood, Mich.) is the first Warrior to score 15 goals since the 2003-04 season...The Warriors are 7-6-2 at home and are assured of a .500 record for the first time at home since 2002-03

**New Hampshire:** UNH extended its season-best unbeaten streak to 12 games (9-0-2) with a win and a tie against Merrimack...The Wildcats finished February 8-0-1...It marks the first time the Wildcats have accomplished this feat in over 80 years...While 1926-27 team was 3-0, while the 1927-28 team was 2-0-1 no team in the last 80 years went unbeaten in February until this year...Last year, UNH was 4-3-1 in February last year...The Wildcats have 18 wins with two games to play in Hockey East...The most wins by a UNH team in Hockey East play is 18, which they won during the 1996-97, 1998-99 and 2006-07 seasons...By virtue of its win over Merrimack on Friday, UNH captured its sixth-straight season series victory in Hockey East play...The Wildcats have an 11 game unbeaten streak (9-0-2) the best unbeaten streak in Hockey East this year and the program's best since Nov. 2006.

**Northeastern:** Junior captain Joe Vitale (St. Louis, Mo.) had a goal and an assist on Friday night and two assists on Saturday, giving him 10 multi-point games this season. He leads Northeastern with 34 points (12-22-34) and his 11-21-32 Hockey East scoring line is tied for the league lead...Freshman Wade MacLeod had his third three-point game of the season with a 1-2-3 line at UMass Lowell on Friday night. He has 25 points (9-16-25), which is tops among NU rookies...Junior defenseman Louis Liotti (Westbury, N.Y.) played his 100th career game on Friday night...Northeastern's 5-4 overtime loss to UMass Lowell on Friday was the team's first OT loss of the season. NU is now 2-1-3 in overtime this season. The Huskies are 5-2-7 over their last 14 overtime games dating back to a 3-3 tie with Boston College on Nov. 17, 2006.

**Providence College:** PC's two wins at Boston College this season marks the first time since the 1995-96 season that the Friars have posted two victories at Kelley Rink...The Friars also captured their first regular season series against the Eagles since the 2001-02 season...All three PC's goals in Friday night's win at BC were scored by freshmen, including two by Jordan Kremyr...The Friars had a penalty shot on Friday night marking their first one since December 21, 1991...In the last eight games against ranked teams, the Friars are 5-1-2...Senior goalie Tyler Sims (2,765 career saves) surpassed former Friar Chris Terreri for fifth on the school's all-time list for most career saves...The Friars have played in 10 overtime games (2-3-5) this season, which ties a school record that was set during the 1984-85 season (4-1-5).

**Vermont:** The Catamounts are 9-3-2 in their last 14 games...Senior Joe Fallon (Bemidji, Minn.) made 23 saves in a 2-0 win over Maine on Friday to post the 19th shutout of his career...His 19 shutouts rank second all-time in NCAA Division I history behind only former Michigan State goalie Ryan Miller, who finished his career with 26 shutouts...Fallon has posted back-to-back shutouts on four occasions in his career...His scoreless streak reached 140:13 before giving up a goal in the first period on Saturday against Maine...Fallon has recorded shutouts against 15 different teams in his career...Vermont guarantees itself home ice in the Hockey East Quarterfinals with at least two points at New Hampshire this weekend in the final two games of the regular season. The Catamounts can finish no lower than fifth in the standings.
