BC, MAINE, UMASS SWEEP RESPECTIVE SERIES

~UNH takes three points from NU; BU takes Vermont; UML and UVM pickup non-league wins~

WAKEFIELD, Mass. – No. 3 Boston College and Massachusetts swept its respective league series against Merrimack and Providence over the weekend, while Maine continued Hockey's East dominance in non-conference play with two wins against Niagara. No. 7 New Hampshire also took three points from No. 9 Northeastern in two league games between nationally ranked opponents.

The weekend series between UMass and Providence began Friday night with a 9-4 victory for the Minutemen at home. CCM/RBK Player of the Week James Marcou (Kings Park, N.Y.) tallied a league-high five points on the night, while senior Alex Berry (Danvers, Mass.) scored twice and added an assist in the high-scoring game. The following night, UMass enjoyed another victory over while visiting the Friars, with a 5-1 final score that saw Marcou and Berry each tally another three points apiece.

Northeastern's Brad Thiessen (Aldergrove, B.C.) stopped 33 shots Friday night, in a 4-2 loss against UNH. James van Riemsdyk (Middletown, N.J.) and Bobby Butler (Marlboro, Mass.) each had two points on the night. UNH goaltender Brian Foster (Pembroke, N.H.) posted 27 saves on Friday, but did not play Saturday due to injury, giving way to freshman Matt DiGirolamo (Penilyn, Pa.) who made 22 saves in his first collegiate start. The Huskies battled to a 2-2 tie behind Thiessen's 43 saves at Matthews Arena, giving him a weekend total of 76, good for Pure Hockey Defensive Player of the Week honors.

BC hosted the Warriors on Thursday evening, enjoying a convincing 4-1 victory that saw freshman Jimmy Hayes (Dorchester, Mass.) earn his first and second collegiate goals. Junior Pat Kimball (Framingham, Mass.) scored Merrimack's lone goal of the night. The teams met again, battling into extra frames Friday night in North Andover. Kimball continued his steady offense, contributing two goals in the Warriors' losing effort. Senior Brock Bradford (Burnaby, B.C.) notched a power play goal and the game winner with 1:33 left in overtime.

No. 3 Boston U. traveled to Burlington on Saturday to a Hockey East Quarterfinal rematch against No. 15 Vermont. Eight Terriers recorded multi-point games, led by senior Chris Higgins (Lynnfield, Mass.) with four on the night and sophomore Nick Bonino (Unionville, Conn.) with three. Vermont bounced back to a 3-2 overtime victory over Dartmouth on Sunday. Sophomore Justin Milo (Edina, Minn.) scored the game-winning goal 2:12 into overtime to keep the Catamounts undefeated outside of league play with a 3-0-1 mark.

Quinnipiac traveled to Tsongas Arena on Thursday, as UMass-Lowell won 4-1 behind a three-point effort by junior Kory Falite (Billerica, Mass.). Netminder T.J. Massie stopped 27 shots by the Bobcats and the win marked Coach Blaise MacDonald's 200th career coaching victory. Also outside of league play, Maine enjoyed a weekend sweep of Niagara at home. Pro Ambitions Rookie of the Week Gustav Nyquist (Malmo, Sweden) earned six points on the weekend, notching a goal on Friday night and adding five more assists. Chris Hahn (Fort Qu'Appelle, Sask.) contributed four points (3g,1a) on the weekend for the Black Bears.

Nov. 3, 2002: Devin Rask scored four goals to lead the Friars to an 8-1 win over Princeton, helping PC jump out to 7-0 start for the first time in school history.

Nov. 5, 1994: Greg Bullock puts together his second five-point game in as many nights against No. 1 ranked BU in a 7-7 standoff at the Tully Forum.

Nov. 8, 2001: Eagles forward Tony Voce netted his second hat trick of the season and added one assist as BC defeated Merrimack, 6-4, at Kelley Rink.

Nov. 8, 1988: Mike Kelfer and David Tomlinson each broke a league record by both scoring seven points in a 12-3 home victory over Providence.

TEAM NOTES

BOSTON COLLEGE: Boston College extended its win streak over Merrimack to 19 games (16-0-3) and its home win streak over the Warriors to 21 games (19-0-2). The Eagles and Warriors will conclude the league regular-season series on Friday, Nov. 14 in North Andover...BC went 5-for-16 in power-play chances against Merrimack and has now scored multiple man-advantage goals in five of its six games this season. The team is converting its chances at a 27.1 percent rate (13-for-48), ranking sixth among national leaders...Sophomore defenseman Nick Petrecki (Clifton Park, N.Y.) registered his first multiple-assist effort of his career and second multiple-point performance...Freshman Paul Carey (Weymouth, Mass.) totaled two points (1g, 1a) at Merrimack, marking the first multiple-point performance of his five-game BC career...With three assists, Benn Ferriero (Essex, Mass.) has now registered 16 points (8g, 8a) in 11 career meetings against Merrimack.

BOSTON UNIVERSITY: For the first time in program history, BU has opened a season by holding its first six opponents to two goals or less...The Terriers have won their last two games by a score of 7-2, marking the first time since Nov. 16 & 22, 1996, that they have scored seven or more goals in consecutive games...Eight Terriers had a multi-point night in the 7-2 win over Vermont...In even-strength play, BU is outscoring its opponents by a 15-3 margin this season...The Terriers have scored on nine of their last 14 power-play chances, and on two of the other five, they have scored within two seconds of an expiring penalty...BU has allowed just 10 goals through six games while scoring 11 goals in the second period alone...Sophomore Nick Bonino is tied for the league high in points (11) and has already had three three-point games this season.

MAINE: Maine swept a weekend series from Niagara, winning 4-2 and 4-1...Maine is a perfect 4-0-0 all-time against Niagara...The Black Bears were led by Chris Hahn who had three goals and one assist and rookie Gustav Nyquist who had a goal and five assists. Nyquist had a hand in six of Maine's eight goals on the weekend...Maine recorded its 700th win as a program on Friday night against Niagara...Maine, which had scored just two power play goals in 26 chances in its first four games, was 4-for-9 on the power play against Niagara this past weekend...Rookie Scott Darling has allowed just three goals in three career starts.

MASSACHUSETTS: The UMass penalty kill is 18-for-18 over the last four games...UMass is tied for the third longest unbeaten streak in the country at five games (4-0-1)...UMass is fifth nationally in scoring at 4.17 goals per game, while defensively they rank 11th at 1.83 goals per game...The 25 goals scored in the first six games are the most since the 1995-96 season when UMass netted 32 goals in the first six games...The 25 goals are the most in the first six games of any season of head coach Don Cahoon since scoring 22 in 2003-04, that same season UMass appeared in the Hockey East Championship game...UMass nine goals against Providence were its most ever in Hockey East play and the most in a game since defeating Air Force 10-2 on Nov. 30, 1996...UMass' nine goals against Providence are the most by any Hockey East team this season...The line of Alex Berry-Cory Quirk-James Marcou accounted for 19 points this weekend and for 28 of UMass' 65 total points, 43.1% of UMass' point total.

UMASS-LOWELL: Thursday's win over Quinnipiac marked head coach Blaise MacDonald's 200th career coaching victory...Freshman goalie T.J. Massie made 27 saves to earn his first career win in his first career start in the win over Quinnipiac...The River Hawks moved to 3-0-0 this season and 23-9-4 over the last three years when scoring three goals or more...UML's penalty kill has killed 13 straight power plays against...The River Hawks continued their run of not allow-

ing two goals or more in any game this season and improved to 3-0-0 when allowing one goal or less...Junior winger Paul Worthington has a three-game point streak...The River Hawks went 2-for-9 on the power play against Quinnipiac, marking the second time this season they had scored two power play goals in a game.

MERRIMACK: Merrimack was 4-0 on Halloween since joining Division I before losing to BC 4-3 on Friday...Joe Cannata's streak of not allowing an even-strength goal ended 228 minutes into his collegiate career when Brock Bradford score in overtime on Saturday...Cannata's .950 save percentage and 1.58 goals-against in all games rank fourth in Hockey East...Merrimack lost in overtime at home for the first time since losing to UMass Lowell on January 16, 2004...The Warriors average 33.5 shots per game at home...They are outshooting their opponents 73-52 (+21) in the first period.

NEW HAMPSHIRE: UNH remained unbeaten in Hockey East play (2-0-2) through four games for the first time since 2003-04...The Wildcats are 7-0-2 in their last nine games at Matthews Arena...UNH's 5-1-2 start is its best start since the 2003-04 season when it was 6-1-0 out of the gate...Bobby Butler (Marlboro, Mass.) scored three points over the last two games after having only one point in his first five games...UNH's 45 shots on net was the most its had since 49 shots in its triple overtime loss to BC in last year's Hockey East semifinals...The Wildcats, who are 6-1-0, in their last seven against WCHA schools look to continue that success next weekend at Minnesota.

NORTHEASTERN: The Huskies concluded October with a 5-1-1 record, the best October in team history...NU's 4-1-1 Hockey East start is its second-best in team history only to the 1985-86 team's 5-1-0 start...Northeastern's penalty kill held New Hampshire scoreless on 10 power plays Saturday night and killed off 15-of-16 power plays over two games this weekend. The Huskies lead Hockey East and rank ninth in the nation with a 92.7 percent penalty kill...Northeastern has had a lead or tie score at some point in the third period of every game this season...Brad Thiessen has 50 more saves than any other goalie in the nation. He leads the nation in saves (254), minutes (489:48), is tied for the lead in shutouts (two), is tied for second in wins (five) and ranks fifth in save percentage (.951) and 11th in goals against average (1.59)...David Strathman is tied for seventh, nationally, in defenseman scoring with seven points (1-6-7)...Northeastern has never played this weekend's opponent, Bentley, but is 51-16-1 all-time against current Atlantic Hockey Association member schools.

PROVIDENCE COLLEGE: Of the 16 goals scored by the Friars this season, nine have been scored by freshmen and sophomores...The Friars have tallied three power-play goals this season and two have come with less than 10 seconds left in a period...Freshman Matt Bergland (Faribault, Minn.) has three multiple-point games in his first three career contests...He leads the team with seven points and is looking to become the first Friar freshman to lead the team in scoring since Rob Gaudreau did it in the 1988-89 season...Junior co-captain John Cavanagh (Warwick, R.I.), who scored six goals in his first two years at PC, already has three goals this season.

Vermont: The Catamounts are 12-4 in their last 16 one-goal games dating back to the start of last season following a 3-2 overtime win at Dartmouth on Sunday...Vermont leads the all-time series against the Big Green 44-22-5...The Catamounts are 65-3-10 in their last 78 games when leading after two periods in the Kevin Sneddon era...Sophomore defenseman Dan Lawson (Oak Forest, Ill.) has a team best plus-7 rating...Junior Viktor Stålberg (Gothenburg, Sweden) has a team-high 25 shots...Senior captain Dean Strong (Mississauga, Ont.) had two assists on the weekend to move 12 points shy of 100 for his career (30g, 58a)...Strong is on track to become the 41st Catamount to reach the 100-point mark.
