
Reebok Player of the Month Brock Bradford – Boston College Senior Forward; Burnaby, B.C.

Bradford recorded 13 points (7g,6a) in eight games in the month 2 of November helping the Eagles to four victories. He posted 2. back-to-back four-point games against Merrimack and UNH. ## Pro Ambitions Hockey Rookie of the Month Scott Darling – Maine

Freshman Goaltender; Lemont, III.

Darling finished the month 4-1-1 with a 1.32 GAA and a .951 save percentage. He began the month with a 4-1 victory over Niagara (11/1) in which he made 29 saves. Darling stopped 24 of 25 shots in 2-1 victory over second-ranked Boston College (11/9) and then made a career-high 35 saves in 3-2 victory at Providence (11/14). He also recorded his second career shutout by stopping all 24 shots that he faced in 3-0 victory over the Friars the following night (11/15).
