NO. 4 BU DOWNS UMASS-LOWELL IN LAST LEAGUE GAME OF 2008

~Cahoon becomes all-time winningest coach at UMass~

WAKEFIELD, Mass. – In the final weekend of play before the holiday hiatus, Hockey East teams wrapped up the first half of the season. In the only league game of the weekend, No. 4 Boston University topped UMass-Lowell on Friday, 3-2, while Maine swept Union and No. 15 New Hampshire scored nine in a victory over Holy Cross.

BU defeated UML for the second time this season Friday night at Agganis Arena. The Terriers scored once in each period, as sophomore Joe Pereira (West Haven, Conn.) notched a goal and added an assist in the victory. The Terriers enter the break riding a five-game unbeaten streak. BU's penalty kill stayed strong, stopping all six UML power plays, killing 24 of its last 25 penalties.

Maine swept ECAC foe Union in a two-game set in Orono over the weekend, first by a score of 3-1 on Friday night. Union opened scoring halfway through the first stanza, but Maine responded with three unanswered goals. Tanner House (Cochrane, Alb.) and Brian Flynn (Lynnfield, Mass.) each tallied a goal and an assist in the victory. When the teams returned to play on Saturday, Maine enjoyed another convincing win, this time 5-1. Gustav Nyquist (Malmo, Sweden) tallied two goals, bringing his weekend total to three points, while teammate Scott Darling (Lemont, Ill.) stopped 44 of 46 Dutchmen shots on the weekend, earning Pro Ambitions Rookie of the Week honors for his efforts. The Black Bears remain unbeaten in ten of their last 12 games and now own a 5-1-0 mark against non-league teams this season.

UNH hosted Holy Cross on Thursday evening at the Whittemore Center, breaking a 4-4 tie going into the third, scoring five in the final stanza for a final score of 9-4. The Wildcats' first line was explosive, as right wing Reebok Hockey Player of the Week Mike Siso (Superior Wis.) tallied six points, behind four goals and two assists, while linemates Jerry Pollastrone (Revere, Mass.) and James van Riemsdyk (Middletown, N.J.) each notched five points on the night.

In a midweek match up, Providence took the 23rd annual Mayor's Cup from cross-town rival Brown, in a 4-3 victory on Tuesday. The Friars capitalized on their 46 shots on net, while Pure Hockey Defensive Player of the Week Matt Taormina (Washington Township, Mich.) tallied three assists in the victory. Coach Don "Toot" Cahoon became the winningest coach in the Massachusetts' program history, earning his 121st win behind the Minuteman bench. Justin Braun (Vadnais Heights, Minn.) notched a shorthanded goal in the second while teammate Chris Davis (Simsbury, Conn.) potted a goal and added an assist on the night. No. 11 Vermont snapped its five-game win streak with a 4-3 loss to St. Lawrence on Saturday night. Captain Dean Strong (Mississauga, Ont.) earned two points on the night, while the Catamounts steadily scored a goal per period. It wasn't enough though, as the Saints broke a 3-3 tie with less than a second left in regulation, defeating the Catamounts in heartbreaking fashion.

TEAM NOTES

BOSTON COLLEGE: BC is 9-5-2 entering the Christmas break, including a 7-2-0 record at Kelley Rink. It entered last year's break with a 6-4-5 record before capturing the Beanpot championship, the Hockey East Tournament title and the national championship...Through 16 games, three players - Brock Bradford (14-9-23), Brian Gibbons (6-13-19) and Benn Ferriero (2-9-11) have double-digit scoring outputs... Sophomore goalie John Muse has started all 60 games over the last two seasons. He is 34-16-10 with a 2.30 GAA and a .918 save percentage in 60 collegiate contests.

BOSTON UNIVERSITY: The Terriers' penalty kill has been successful on 24 of its last 25 chances, including each of its last 17...BU completed its first undefeated month since December 2004 and will enter the second half on a five-game unbeaten streak (4-0-1)...Freshman goaltender Kieran Millan (Edmonton, Alb.) leads Hockey East in winning percentage (8-1-1, .850) and has not allowed more than one goal in any of his last 14 periods between the pipes...Junior Zach Cohen has scored a goal in three of the last five games...The Terriers' 3-2 victory over UMass Lowell was the 1,300th game of head coach Jack Parker's career...BU has scored exactly one goal in each of its last six periods.

MAINE: Maine completed a weekend sweep of Union on Saturday night by scoring a season-high five goals...The last time Maine scored five goals was on February 24, 2008 against Massachusetts...Maine is 7-0-0 all-time against Union...Gustav Nyquist has nine goals and seven assists for 17 points, averaging 1.00 points per game which is tied for third in the nation among rookies... Maine held Union scoreless on 14 power play chances on the weekend...Maine is 5-1-0 in non-conference games this season...Goalie Scott Darling has allowed one goal or less in seven of his 12 games this season...Maine has not allowed short-handed goal on the season...Maine, which finished with just 19 power play goals during the 2007-08 season, has 15 power play goals thus far this season...Seven of Maine's top eight scorers are either freshmen or sophomores.

MASSACHUSETTS: UMass snapped an 0-for-15 power play skid with an extra-man goal in the third period against AIC...The Minutemen also tallied their third short-handed goal in as many games...The UMass penalty kill has gone 21-for-22 over the last six games (11/21-12/12)...In games won this year, UMass is averaging 5.1 goals per game, is 8-for-35 on the power play, and allowing 1.5 goals per game, while in games lost, UMass is averaging 1.2 goals per game, is 2-for-27 on the power play, and is allowing 2.8 goals per game...UMass has scored 15 goals in the first period and 12 goals in the second period of games won, while just scoring two in each of those periods of games lost...UMass is 3-1-1 against teams ranked in the nation's top-5 this season...UMass is 8-1-0 when scoring three or more goals this year...UMass ranks 13th nationally in attendance (4,794).

UMASS-LOWELL: UMass Lowell has lost three straight and are 8-8-0 at the break...The River Hawks are averaging 3.2 goals per game, fifth in Hockey East, but have been held to two goals or less in each of the last three games (all losses)...UMass Lowell has a power play goal in 11 of 16 games this season, they are 0-5-0 when not scoring a power play goal...Maury Edwards scored his fifth goal of the season Friday night at BU. The goal was Edwards' sixth career goal in eight games against the Terriers...Junior winger Kory Falite (Billerica, Mass.) leads the River Hawks with 15 points in 16 games...Freshman David Vallorani is second on the team in scoring with 14 points in 16 games...The River Hawks are off until January 2 when they take on Minnesota Duluth in the first game of the Shillelagh Tournament in Hoffman Estates, Ill.

MERRIMACK: The Warriors were idle this week. They have 22 days off between games before taking on Quinnipiac on December 29th at the UConn Holiday Classic. Merrimack will play either Air Force or UConn on the 30th...The Warriors host the U.S. Under-18 Team on January 3 in their first of five January home games...Karl Stollery (Camrose, Alb.) continues to lead all Hockey East newcomers on defense in scoring with seven points...Rob Ricci (Brampton, Ont.) will take a three-game scoring streak into the Quinnipiac game on the 29th.

NEW HAMPSHIRE: UNH in a 9-4 win over Holy Cross posted nine goals for the first time since a 9-1 win over Merrimack on January 23, 2004...The Wildcats were perfect (3-0-0) in December for the first time since 1999 when they went 4-0-0...UNH's first line of Mike Sislo, Jerry Pollastrone and James van Riemsdyk combined for 16 points on the night (7g, 9a)... Freshman netminder Matt DiGirolamo stopped six shots during the final 26:25 to earn his first collegiate win during a relief performance...The third period against HC marked the first time the Wildcats scored five goals since the third period of a 7-4 come-from-behind win over North Dakota on December 29, 2007...van Riemsdyk has 19 points (5g, 14a) during his current 10-game scoring streak...Sislo becomes the first Wildcat to score four goals in a game since Steve Saviano on January 23, 2004 against Merrimack, record six points in a game since Darren Haydar had six points (3g, 3a) against Brown on Dec. 28, 2001, score a hat trick in a period (third period) since Lanny Gare scored three in the third against Merrimack on January 4, 2003...Kevin Kapstad has six points (1g, 5a) in an active five-game scoring streak...The Wildcats are now off until their Jan. 4 (4 p.m.) game at Maine.

NORTHEASTERN: At 11-3-2, Northeastern has tied its second best start through 16 games. Northeastern went 13-3-0 through 16 games in 1980-81 and 11-3-2 in 1993-94, the most recent season NU went to the NCAA Tournament...It's the second time NU has posted 11 wins before New Year's, matching 1985-86 when NU went 11-6 before New Year's...Northeastern next plays in the Dodge Holiday Classic, one of four in-season tournaments the Huskies play in this season. In Northeastern's only other appearance in the tournament, NU beat Notre Dame and Minnesota to win Dec. 27-28, 1997. NU opened the season at the Kendall Hockey Classic in Anchorage, Alaska, played in the RPI Holiday Tournament in November and plays in the 57th annual Beanpot in February.

PROVIDENCE COLLEGE: The Friars' 4-3 Mayor's Cup win over Brown on Tuesday ended their 11-game winless streak...It also marked the second consecutive season that the Friars captured the Mayor's Cup and their first win at Brown since 2003...The Friars improved to 13-8-2 all-time in the Mayor's Cup and evened the all-time series against Brown at 43-43-2...Senior Matt Taormina matched a career high with three assists. Taormina moved into 21st all-time at Providence in scoring among defenseman with 56 career points...In all, four Friars had multiple-point efforts against Brown...Freshman Matt Bergland is on a three-game point streak and leads the Friars in scoring with 16 points (five goals, 11 assists)...Junior Chris Eppich (Surrey, B.C.) has scored in two consecutive games after not scoring in his first 53 games.

VERMONT: The Catamounts had their five-game winning streak come to an end with a 4-3 loss at St. Lawrence on Saturday...Vermont dropped to 3-1-1 against non-conference opponents this season...Junior Viktor Stålberg (Gothenburg, Sweden) recorded his team-high seventh goal of the season in the loss against the Saints. It was also Stålberg's team leading fourth power-play goal...Vermont is 9-4-2 through 15 games this season after being 4-7-4 through 15 games last season...The Catamounts rank seventh in the country on the power play (.205) and first in Hockey East league games (.255) on the man advantage...Vermont has the eighth fewest penalty minutes per game in the country (13.2).
