UMASS AND MERRIMACK SPLIT AT HOLIDAY TOURNAMENTS

~League teams play three OT games during holiday break~

WAKEFIELD, Mass. – In the final weekend of 2008, both Maine and Massachusetts represented Hockey East at two holiday tournaments, while Merrimack capped off the year playing at the UConn Tournament. The Black Bears traveled south to Estero, Fla., where they placed third in the Florida College Classic, extending both of their games to overtime. The Minutemen fell to Bemidji State in the first round of the Ledyard National Bank Classic on Sunday and knocked off Army in the final day of play in Hanover, N.H.

Merrimack lost a heartbreaker to Quinnipiac in the opening round of the UConn Tournament on Monday afternoon, 4-3 in overtime. Sophomore defenseman Fraser Allan (North Battleford, Sask.) recorded two points in the losing cause for the Warriors. Merrimack rebounded on Tuesday night, tying a season-high with five goals in the 5-2 win vs. host Connecticut. Junior forward Rob Ricci (Brampton, Ont.) tallied a game-high three points (1g,2a) for the Warriors.

The Minutemen opened the Ledyard National Bank Classic with a 4-2 loss against Bemidji State on Sunday afternoon. Cory Quirk (Brockton, Mass.) opened up scoring for Massachusetts, but were unable to capitalize, outshooting the Beavers 26-18. Blueliner Justin Braun (Vadnais Heights, Minn.) earned two points on the night, tallying Massachusetts' second goal and assisting on Quirk's.

Maine took Colgate to overtime on Saturday afternoon in the opening round of the Florida College Classic. The Black Bears held a 2-0 lead going into the second stanza, but Colgate came back with three unanswered goals, defeating Maine in 64:59 of play. Sophomore Lem Randall (Snow Lake, Man.) tallied a goal and added an assist in the losing effort. In the consolation game, the Black Bears came from behind to tie St. Cloud State at three goals apiece, behind a game-tying tally by Brian Flynn (Lynnfield, Mass.) in the third. To determine the final standings in the tournament, the teams went on to a shootout, where Josh Van Dyk's (Woodstock, Ont.) goal lifted Maine to a third-place finish.

TEAM NOTES

BOSTON COLLEGE: BC owns 9-5-2, as they headed into the holiday break, including a 7-2-0 record at Kelley Rink. It entered last year's break with a 6-4-5 record before capturing the Beanpot championship, the Hockey East Tournament title and the national championship...Through 16 games, three players - Brock Bradford (14-9-23), Brian Gibbons (6-13-19) and Benn Ferriero (2-9-11) have double-digit scoring outputs... Sophomore goalie John Muse has started all 60 games over the last two seasons. He is 34-16-10 with a 2.30 GAA and a .918 save percentage in 60 collegiate contests.

BOSTON UNIVERSITY: The Terriers went 11-4-1 in the first half after compiling a 4-10-2 record before the semester break in the 2007-08 campaign...Dating back to Feb. 8, BU is 22-7-1 in its last 30 games...The Terriers have 11 wins at the break for the first time since 1999-00 season...BU's penalty kill has been successful on 24 of its last 25 chances, including each of its last 17...The Terriers will make their first appearance at the Wells Fargo Denver Cup on Jan. 2-3, facing Rensselaer in the first round before taking on Holy Cross or the host Pioneers the following day...BU last traveled to Denver four seasons ago, dropping a 4-1 decision to the Pioneers on Nov. 26, 2004.

MAINE: Maine finished third in the 2008 Florida College Classic... The Black Bears fell in the first game to Colgate as the Raiders scored with just one second remaining in overtime... Maine then skated to a 3-3 tie with St. Cloud on Sunday and won the shootout to get third place...Maine's Matt Duffy (Windham, Maine) was named to the 2008 Florida College Classic All-Tournament Team...The games were the first back-to-back overtime games for the Black Bears since playing overtime back-to-back nights against Boston University on Feb. 15 and 16, 2008...Eight of Maine's top 10 scorers are either freshmen or sophomores...Maine is 7-0-1 on the season when scoring three or more goals...The lone tie was to St. Cloud on Sunday night...Maine has three short-handed goals on the season and has yet to allow one...Maine registered a season-high 43 shots on Sunday against St. Cloud.

MASSACHUSETTS: UMass' loss to Bemidji State snapped a two-game win streak, but rebounded for a 4-1 win over Army...UMass lost for the second time this season when limiting an opponent to under 20 shots in a game (1-2-0)...UMass held Army to just 17 shots - the second fewest opponent shots of the season...UMass has allowed under 20 shots in each of the last three games (2-1-0)...UMass is outscoring opponents 15-to-6 in the last four games...In games won this year, UMass is averaging 5.0 goals per game, is 8-for-38 on the power play, and allowing 1.4 goals per game, while in games lost, UMass is averaging 1.3 goals per game, is 2-for-30 on the power play, and is allowing 3.0 goals per game UMass has scored 16 goals in the first period and 14 goals in the second period of games won, while just scoring three in each of those periods of games lost...UMass is 3-1-1 against teams ranked in the nation's top-5 this season...UMass is 9-1-0 when scoring three or more goals this year and 0-6-1 when scoring fewer than three goals...UMass ranks 13th nationally in attendance (4,794).

UMASS-LOWELL: UMass Lowell plays Minnesota Duluth in the first day of the Shillelagh Tournament in Chicago...This is the third straight year the River Hawks and Bulldogs have met; Minnesota Duluth has won the last three meetings...Sophomore blueliner Maury Edwards (Rocky Rapids, Alb.) takes a two-game goal streak into the Shillelagh Tournament...Junior forward Kory Falite (Billerica, Mass.) has assists in his last two games...The River Hawks are unbeaten (2-1-1) in three of their last four holiday tournament games including winning the 2007 Florida College Classic.

MERRIMACK: Merrimack lost to Quinnipiac in overtime, 4-3, in the opening round of the UConn Holiday Classic on December 29 at the Freitas Ice Forum at the University of Connecticut...The Warriors will play either Air Force or Connecticut on December 30 in the championship or consolation game...Monday's game marks the first for the Warriors in 22 days and their first non-conference game since tying Canisius 1-1 on October 26...Karl Stollery (Camrose, Alb. continues to lead all Hockey East freshmen on defense in scoring with seven points...Rob Ricci (Brampton, Ont.) takes a three-game goal scoring streak into Monday's game...The Warriors will play their first game on a Monday since January 24, 2005 when they lost to Northeastern 4-3...The USA Under-18 Team will visit Merrimack for the first time ever on Saturday.

NEW HAMPSHIRE: With three goals and an assist through two games, James van Riemsdyk is tied for the lead in scoring at the 2009 Junior National Championship. van Riemsdyk, the nation's top scorer (1.53 ppg), van Riemsdyk has 19 points (5g,14a) during his current 10-game scoring streak...The Wildcats were perfect (3-0-0) in December for the first time since 1999 when they went 4-0-0...During the first half of the season, UNH went 7-1-1 at home and closed by winning three-straight for the first time since it open the season 3-0-0...The Wildcats are now off until their Jan. 4 (4 p.m.) game at Maine.

NORTHEASTERN: No. 6 Northeastern makes its second-ever appearance in the Dodge Holiday Classic this weekend when it takes on Western Michigan on Friday and No. 4 Minnesota or Brown on Saturday. The Huskies won the tournament in 1997-98 when it was known as the Marriucci Classic. The Huskies are 2-1-0 all-time against Western Michigan, with all three games coming in holiday tournaments...Northeastern won its holiday tournament last season, defeating Bowling Green and Colgate to win the Badger Hockey Showdown in Madison, Wis., Dec. 28-29, 2007. Goaltender Brad Thiessen (Aldergrove, B.C.) was named tournament MVP and Jimmy Russo and Louis Liotti (Westbury, N.Y.) were also named to the All-Tournament team...Northeastern is 37-68-3 all-time in holiday tournaments and has won nine. Northeastern's first-ever holiday tournament was the first Beanpot Dec. 26-27, 1952. The Beanpot was moved to January the following season, then February the season after.

PROVIDENCE COLLEGE: The Friars are in the midst of a 31-day layoff and they will return to action on January 10 at home against UMass Lowell...The Friars will open the second half of the season with four games in eight days, including three on the road...The Friars' freshman and sophomore classes has accounted for 17 of the team's 35 goals this season...Freshman Matt Bergland (Faribault, Minn.) lead PC in scoring with 16 points (5g, 11a) and is looking to become the first Friar freshman to lead the team in points since Rob Gaudreau did it during the 1988-89 season...The Friars have outshot their opponents in 10 of the 16 games, including a season-high 46 shots against Brown on December 9.

VERMONT: The Catamounts host the 13th Sheraton/TD Banknorth Catamount Cup at Gutterson on Friday and Saturday...Vermont has advanced to the championship game of its home holiday tournament in each of the last three years, and defeated Clarkson, 3-0, in 2005 to claim the title...Stanley Cup winners John LeClair and Martin St. Louis lead the list of former UVM players to be named to the Catamount Cup All-Tournament Team...Vermont meets Colgate in the opening round of this year's tournament. The Catamounts are 2-1 against ECAC opponents this season and 3-1-1 in non-conference matchups...Student-athletes and coaches from Colgate, Ferris State, St. Lawrence and Vermont will all make a visit to the Vermont Children's Hospital on Thursday...UVM's game on Saturday in the Catamount Cup will be televised on CN8.
