NO. 14 UNH DOWNS MAINE IN COMEBACK WIN AT ORONO

~BU wins Denver Cup; Vermont takes Catamount Cup in Burlington~

WAKEFIELD, Mass. – Hockey East was well represented in holiday tournaments across the nation over the weekend, while No. 14 New Hampshire defeated Maine, 5-4, in the first league game of 2009. No. 3 Boston University captured the Wells Fargo Denver Cup while, No. 13 Vermont hosted and won the Sheraton/TD Banknorth Catamount Cup for the second time.

UNH got on the board first, but Maine scored three times in the second stanza, prior to a four-goal third period by the Wildcats. UNH took a lead it would not relinquish, with under three minutes to go in regulation. Reebok Player of the Week Greg Collins (Fairport, N.Y.) tallied a career-high two goals for the 'Cats, while Bobby Butler (Marlboro, Mass.) notched the game-winner and added an assist in the victory. The Black Bears also saw action against the USA Under-18 Team on Friday night in Portland, where they earned a convincing 7-3 victory in the exhibition. Both Gustav Nyquist (Malmo, Sweden) and Brian Flynn (Lynnfield, Mass.) enjoyed three-point nights.

On its way to winning the Denver Cup, BU defeated Rensselaer 6-2 on Friday night. The Terriers owned a 38-15 shot advantage, while Jason Lawrence (Saugus, Mass.) earned two goals in the effort. BU went on to defeat No. 5 Denver, 4-1 on Saturday, behind rookie netminder Kieran Millan's (Edmonton, Alb.) 33-save performance, earning him Pure Hockey Defensive Player of the Week honors. Senior Matt Gilroy (North Bellmore, N.Y.) tallied the game-winner and earned tournament MVP honors.

Vermont's power play was four for eight on Friday night en route to a 6-4 victory over Colgate in the first round of the Catamount Cup. Peter Lenes (Shelburne, Vt.) netted two goals and added an assist, later earning tournament MVP honors. The Catamounts went on to shut out St. Lawrence, 4-0, in the championship game Saturday night. Pro Ambitions Rookie of the Week Rob Madore (Venetia, Pa.) recorded his first career shutout in the victory, while Justin Milo (Edina, Minn.) tallied four points on the weekend.

No. 6 Northeastern fell to No. 4 Minnesota in a 3-2 overtime heartbreaker at the Dodge Holiday Classic on Saturday night. The Huskies first defeated Western Michigan 3-1 on Friday in the first round of play, before taking on the Golden Gophers Saturday. Wade MacLeod (Coquitlam, B.C.) netted one goal each night of the tournament, while goaltender Brad Thiessen (Aldergrove, B.C.) stopped 51 shots on the weekend.

UMass-Lowell dropped a pair of games over the weekend in the first annual Shillelagh Tournament in Hoffman Estates, Ill. The River Hawks fell to Minnesota-Duluth, 2-1, on Friday and again to Union by the same score in the consolation game on Saturday. UML netminder Carter Hutton (Thunder Bay, Ont.) returned from injury to stop an impressive 44 shots on the weekend. Massachusetts dropped a 5-2 decision to No. 9 Cornell on Sunday at the Mullins Center. Both of the Minutemen goals were scored on the power play, netted by TJ Syner (Springfield, Mass.) and Chris Davis (Simsbury, Conn.). Merrimack also hosted the U-18 team, defeating USA 4-2 in an exhibition on Saturday. The Warriors outshot USA 40-21, while Jesse Todd (Calgary, Alta.) notched two goals in the victory. Fellow Calgary native Chris Barton (Calgary, Alb.) earned two assists on the night. In another pair of exhibition games, No. 7 Boston College split its weekend series at New Brunswick. The Eagles first fell to the Varsity Reds, 5-3, on Friday, before earning a 4-2 victory on Saturday.

All three of Team USA's top players at the World Junior Championships were from Hockey East Schools. Kevin Shattenkirk (New Rochelle, N.Y.) and Colin Wilson (Winnipeg, Man.) from BU and James van Riemsdyk (Middletown, N.J.) were honored for their efforts in Team USA's fifth place finish at the tournament.

Jan. 5, 2007: Boston University scored on three of their first nine shots en route to a 5-1 win against Providence at Schneider Arena for the 1,300th win in the program's history and the 750th career victory for head coach Jack Parker.

Jan. 8, 1988: Senior Jon Morris becomes the third player in school history with 200 career points when he scores a goal against Colorado College.

Jan. 10, 2003: Maine's Martin Kariya tied school records for assists and points in a game when he scored a goal and dished out five assists in Maine's 7-1 win over Northeastern.

Jan. 11, 2006: UNH registers its 1,000 victory in the program's history with a 4-1 win at Yale at Ingalls Rink in New Haven, Conn.

TEAM NOTES

BOSTON COLLEGE: BC split two games with the UNB Varsity Reds. Junior Matt Lombardi (Milton, Mass.) earned BC's player-of-the-game award in the team's loss on Friday and captain Brock Bradford (Burnaby, B.C.) captured the honor in the team's 4-2 win on Saturday. The host Varsity Reds captured the Pete Kelly Cup following a best-of-three player shootout immediately following Saturday's game...Freshman Tommy Atkinson (Greenwich, Conn.) scored in his first career appearance. Classmate Malcolm Lyles (Miami Gardens, Fla.) recorded an assist in his first game...Goalies Alex Kremer and Chris Venti also saw their first career game action. Kremer played the second period of Saturday's victory and Venti played the third period and shootout for BC.

BOSTON UNIVERSITY: The Terriers' penalty kill has been successful 27 straight times and 34 of its last 35...BU has scored at least one goal in 12 straight periods...The Terriers are 7-0-0 in non-conference play, marking the first time that feat has been accomplished at BU since the 1991-92 squad went a perfect 12-0-0...BU's title at the Denver Cup marked just the fourth time in the 17-year history of the tournament that Denver was not the champion, and it was just the second time the Pioneers had fallen in the title game...Head coach Jack Parker is now 5-1 all-time in holiday tournament championship games against the host school...The Terriers have allowed just 37 goals through 18 games this season after giving up 63 in its first 18 contests last season...BU will put its seven-game unbeaten streak (6-0-1) on line when it plays host to Maine on Saturday (Jan. 10). The Terriers are 8-0-1 in their last nine contests against the Black Bears.

MAINE: Maine senior Chris Hahn (Fort Qu'Appelle, Sask.) has been named an official candidate for the Lowe's Senior CLASS Award...Maine tied its season-high with three power play goals on Sunday against New Hampshire...The Black Bears now have 19 power play goals on the season, the same number that it finished with all of last season...Maine freshman and sophomore class has combined to score 77.1 percent of the team's points this season...Maine lost on Sunday for the first time this season when scoring three or more goals...Rookie Gustav Nyquist (Malmo, Sweden) has scored a point in seven of Maine's last eight games...Three of Maine's four goals on Sunday were scored by defensemen.

MASSACHUSETTS: In the loss to #10 Cornell, UMass was 2-for-6 (.333) on the power play - the fifth time this season UMass has tallied two power play goals in a game...In games won this year, UMass is averaging 5.0 goals per game, is 8-for-38 on the power play, and allowing 1.4 goals per game, while in games lost, UMass is averaging 1.4 goals per game, is 4-for-36 on the power play, and is allowing 3.2 goals per game...UMass has scored 16 goals in the first period and 14 goals in the second period of games won, while just scoring three in the first period and four in the second period of games lost...UMass is 3-1-1 against teams ranked in the nation's top-5 this season...UMass is 9-1-0 when scoring three or more goals this year and 0-7-1 when scoring fewer than three goals.

UMASS-LOWELL: The River Hawks went 0-2 in a holiday tournament for the first time since the 1997-98 season...UML lost each game - to Minnesota Duluth and Union - by 2-1 scores...UML scored a power play goal in each game and still have not gone two games in a row without a man-advantage goal...Carter Hutton has not allowed more than two goals in any of his seven starts this season. He ranks ninth in the nation in goals-against average (1.72) and 11th in save percentage (.932)...UMass Lowell returns to Hockey East play Saturday at Providence...The River Hawks have out-scored the Friars 10-2 in the first two meetings this season.

MERRIMACK: Merrimack scored three first-period goals in its 4-2 win over the U.S. Under-18 Team Saturday for the first time all season...Goaltender Joe Cannata (Wakefield, Mass.) stopped 19 shots against his former club. Cannata posted a 16-14-3 record with a 2.56 GAA (.899 save%) last season for the Under-18 team...Merrimack was the last Hockey East team to score a short-handed goal when Joe Loprieno (Bloomington, Ill.) scored Tuesday at Connecticut...The Warriors will play their next eight games against Hockey East opponents...They will host at least one home game every weekend through the end of the regular season...Chris Barton (Calgary, Alb.), who has a four-game point streak, leads Merrimack with 13 points, nine assists and three power-play goals...Merrimack snapped a six-game winless streak in December with a 5-2 win over UConn that dated back to December 5, 2006.

NEW HAMPSHIRE: UNH captured its five-straight win over Maine and fourth in a row at Alford Arena...The Wildcats own a season-best four-game winning streak and have won three-straight in Hockey East to move into second place...Greg Collins scored a career-high two goals, both in the third period, including the game-tying goal...Mike Sisko's (Superior, Wis.) short-handed goal got the Wildcats back into the game (4-3) and was his fifth goal in the last two games...UNH went 3-10 on the power play marking the first time it scored three power-play goals since March 9, 2007 against Providence...James van Riemsdyk (Middletown, N.J.) and Blake Kessel (Verona, Wis.) return to the Wildcat lineup after missing last weekend's game while participating in the Junior National Tournament. van Riemsdyk finished his career in World Juniors second all-time in the U.S. record book in both points (12-10-22) and goals (12).

NORTHEASTERN: The Dodge Holiday Classic was the Huskies' third of four in-season tournaments this season. Northeastern finished second in the Kendall Hockey Classic, third in the RPI Holiday Tournament and second in the Dodge Holiday Classic. NU plays in the Beanpot Feb. 2 and Feb. 9...Wade MacLeod, Louis Liotti (Westbury, N.Y.) and Brad Thiessen were named to the Dodge Holiday Classic All-Tournament team...MacLeod has scored in three straight games and has points in the last four. NU is 11-1-1 when MacLeod has a point...Northeastern's 3-2 OT loss to No. 4 Minnesota was the Huskies' eighth game against a ranked opponent this season. NU is 3-4-1 in those games...Northeastern is 2-1-1 against WCHA and CCHA teams...Northeastern is tied for its best winning percentage through 18 games at .722 (12-4-2). NU posted the same winning percentage through 18 games in 1980-81, when it started 13-5-0.

PROVIDENCE COLLEGE: The Friars will open the second half of the season with four games in eight days, including three on the road...Of the 35 goals score by PC this season, 16 have come in the third period...Junior defenseman Mark Fayne (Sagamore Beach, Mass.) who recorded one point in his first 10 games, has four points (2 g, 2 a) in the last five contests...Freshman Matt Bergland (Faribault, Minn.) is in the midst of a three-game point streak (2g,2a). Bergland leads PC in scoring with 16 points (5g,11a) and is looking to become the first Friar freshman to lead the team in points since Rob Gaudreau did it during the 1988-89 season.

VERMONT: Vermont won the 13th Sheraton/TD Banknorth Catamount Cup over the weekend with a 6-4 win over Colgate and a 4-0 win over St. Lawrence...Vermont has now won the Catamount Cup twice in school history (2005, 2009)...Senior Peter Lenas was named the Catamount Cup MVP while Jack Downing, Rob Madore and Justin Milo were each named to the all-tournament team...UVM is 7-2-1 in the Catamount Cup under head coach Kevin Sneddon...The Catamounts finished non-league play this season with a 5-1-1 mark...200 Teddy Bears were collected from the sixth annual Teddy Bear Toss sponsored by Vermont Teddy Bear on Saturday. Members of the UVM hockey team will deliver the Bears in January to local nursing homes and the Vermont Children's Hospital...Vermont jumped out to a pair of 3-0 leads over the weekend and is now 46-10-12 in its last 68 games when scoring first...Vermont has dropped four straight games against Boston College, including a 3-2 decision on Oct. 24 this season.
