VERMONT'S STÅLBERG NAMED REEBOK PLAYER OF THE MONTH FOR JANUARY ~BU's Millan and NU's Thiessen tabbed as Top Goalie; UMass' Wellman earns Rookie honors~



Reebok Player of the Month Viktor Stålberg – Vermont

Junior Forward: Gothenburg, Sweden

Stålberg led No. 7 Vermont to a 5-2-2 month while registering 12 points (8g,4a). Six of Vermont's nine games were against opponents ranked in the Top-18 of the latest PairWise Ratings. He recorded at least one point in eight of nine games and scored at least one goal in seven of nine contests. He finished the month with 51 shots on goal and averaged 5.67 shots per game. He had four points (3g) in a weekend split at No. 3 Northeastern on Jan. 16/17 on his way to being named HEA Player of the Week. Runner-up:


Brad Thiessen – Northeastern


6-3-0, 2.22 GAA, **Pro Ambitions Hockey Rookie of the Month Casey Wellman – Massachusetts**
