Reebok Co-Players of the Month

Viktor Stålberg – Vermont (Jr., F; Gothenburg, Sweden)

Stålberg recorded four goals and nine points in six games in March on his way to helping lead Vermont to the Frozen Four. Stålberg notched a goal and three points in a 6-4 win over New Hampshire on March 6 at Gutterson Fieldhouse. He scored a goal and had an assist at the NCAA East Regionals at Bridgeport Arena at Harbor Yard on March 27 and 28. Stålberg was named to the East Regional All-Tournament Team. He posted a +6 rating in the month and had 34 shots (5.67 shots per game).

Brandon Yip – Boston University (Sr., F; Maple Ridge, B.C.)

Yip tallied 10 points, including seven goals, and a plus-9 rating in nine games...Scored game's lone goal in Hockey East championship game to lead Terriers past UMass Lowell for their seventh league title...Recorded first career hat trick, including his 100th career point, in four-point effort in 8-2 win at Providence on March 6...Tallied a goal and an assist in 8-3 win over Ohio State in NCAA Northeast Regional semifinal...Registered a goal and an assist in 6-2 victory over Maine in third and decisive game of Hockey East quarterfinals.
