This will direct a user to the mobile home page of the Hockey East men's league. To access the Hockey East women's league mobile home page, simply scroll to the bottom of the page for a link to the women's mobile home page. The new mobile website features the league's top stories, schedules and results, statistics, standings and access to live game statistics.

"We are excited to offer Hockey East fans a new way to follow the league online with all of the new technology," said Bertagna. "Tim Danehy, Dan Parkhurst and Mike Machnik have all worked hard to get all of these features in place over the past couple of months."

The new live stats platform can be accessed on game days from the men's or women's Hockey East home pages at [HockeyEastOnline.com](http://HockeyEastOnline.com). The live box scores come directly from feeds at game sites. With multiple leagues using the same live stats platform, even many non-conference road games will be included in the new live scoreboard.

The Hockey East Association is a 10-team Division I college men's hockey conference and an eight-team Division I women's league which began play in 2002-03. Founded in 1983, the men's league has won six NCAA championships in the past 17 years.
