SPLIT TREND CONTINUES IN LEAGUE PLAY; UMASS-LOWELL SWEEPS UAH ~PC faces Brown Tuesday in Mayor's Cup; UMass travels to Yale Thursday~

WAKEFIELD, Mass. – All four Hockey East series over the weekend were splits, while No. 5 ranked UMass-Lowell came away with a two-game sweep at Alabama-Huntsville.

Merrimack College opened the weekend with a 6-3 win vs. Boston University of Friday night at a soldout Lawler Arena. Warriors' rookie Stephane Da Costa (Paris, France) continues to impress, putting up another four-point weekend with 10 shots on goal in the series. The Terriers came back the next night and got two points back with a 6-4 win of their own at Agganis Arena. BU was paced by Co-Player of the Week Chris Connolly (Duluth, Minn.) who notched a four-point weekend of his own.

Massachusetts pulled out a 4-3 overtime victory on Friday at the Mullins Center. Sophomore forward Casey Wellman (Brentwood, Calif.) evened the game with 11 seconds left and freshman David Boehm (Naples, Fla.) registered the game-winner just 2+ minutes into the extra frame. Junior goalie Paul Dainton (Genelle, B.C.) stopped a career-high 42 shots in Friday's win for the Minutemen. Co-Player of the Week Bobby Butler (Marlboro, Mass.) notched a three-goal effort on the weekend for the Wildcats, including a two-goal performance in the 4-2 victory on Saturday.

Maine exploded for a six-goal output on Friday night at Matthews Arena and then Northeastern returned the favor the next night putting up five goals on the scoreboard. Freshman Matt Mangene (Manorville, N.Y.) chipped in with a career-high three assists and a +4 rating in Friday's 6-3 win for the Black Bears. The Huskies scored four third period goals on Saturday and went an impressive 3-for-8 with a man advantage. Freshman goaltender Chris Rawlings (North Delta, B.C.) amassed 34 saves in his fourth victory of the season for the Huntingtoun Hounds.

The Eagles dominated Vermont on Saturday night by a 7-1 score, thanks to a three-point night from freshman Steve Whitney (Reading, Mass.). The Catamounts responded the next day with a 3-2 win at Conte Forum on the back of a 30-save effort from senior netminder Mike Spillane (Bow, N.H.). UVM's win at Boston College on Sunday was its first at Kelley Rink since Nov. 11, 1994.

UMass-Lowell outscored Alabama-Huntsville by an 7-1 score in two wins down south. Freshman forward Colin Wright (Burlington, Ont.) had two goals on the weekend for the River Hawks, including the game-winner on Friday night. Senior goalie Carter Hutton (Thunder Bay, Ont.) made 19 save in his eighth career shutout on Saturday, tying Cam McCormick for the all-time UMass Lowell record.
